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
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Deputy Chief Minister's Message



MAJOR ACHIEVEMENTS OF BJP IN NAGALAND

- Sanctioned more than 55,000 houses with an investment of ₹1,850 crores under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana.



FARMER WELFARE

- We will provide interest-free loans to FPOs, Cooperatives and SHGs for setting up agro-processing units.
- We will ensure 100% coverage of the Kisan Credit Card Scheme to provide collateral-free agriculture loans to interested farmers.
- We will set up a State Millet Mission with a corpus of ₹10 crores to promote the production and processing of millets and provide market linkages.



ROBUST AGRI INFRASTRUCTURE

- We will launch the Agri-Infrastructure Mission with an investment of ₹500 crores to develop a holistic agri-infrastructure of collection and primary processing centres.
- We will ensure the speedy completion and operationalisation of all under-progress irrigation projects to expand access to irrigation.
- We will establish seed banks in every block to provide high-yielding seeds along with soil and seed testing provisions.







- We will expedite the operationalisation of Special Economic Zones in Dimapur.

- We will work with the Central Government for the development of the Tizu-Zungki river as an Inland Water Corridor.
- We will connect each town and district with a 4G connection by 2024.
- We will ensure that every village has access to Banking facilities in the state.



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- We will ensure the timely completion and commencement of the Mon Medical College.
- We will, in conjunction with the Central Government, construct Kendriya Vidyalayas in Mon, Kiphire and Noklak and Sainik Schools in Tuensang and Longleng.
- We will fast-track the construction of Government Polytechnics in Kiphire.
- We will set up a Rural Self Employment Training Institute in Mon to provide self-employment opportunities to the local youth.
- We will work in conjunction with the Central Government for the holistic development of Border Villages on the Indo-Myanmar Border.
- We will set up Handloom and Handicraft clusters in each district of Eastern Nagaland for the promotion and better marketability of Handloom and Handicraft Products of the region.



WELFARE FOR ALL

- We will provide free rice and wheat to all eligible PDS beneficiaries every month.
- We will provide 5 kg of black chickpeas and 1 litre of mustard oil per family quarterly, at a subsidized rate to all families benefiting from the PDS system.
- We will ensure last-mile delivery of the goods covered under PDS through mobile delivery units delivering ration and other goods in remote areas.
- We will increase the existing pension for senior citizens to ₹1,000 per month and ensure there are no delays in their disbursements.
- We will provide free dialysis services and subsidize the treatment of cardiac diseases and cataract treatment for citizens over the age of 75.
- We will increase the existing pension for specially-abled (Divyangs) to ₹1,000 per month and ensure there are no delays in their disbursements.
- We will provide free health insurance to all eligible specially-abled (Divyangs).
- We will provide a 50% subsidy for assistive devices such as wheelchairs, prosthetic devices, orthotic devices, hearing aids etc.

 We will ensure that all Government buildings and schools are made accessible for specially-abled (Divyangs) under the Sugamya Bharat Abhiyan.




- We will provide health insurance cards to provide cashless medical facilities for all government employees.
- We will construct, upgrade and repair housing facilities for Government Employees including Police personnel.
- We will fill all vacant teaching posts in Government educational institutions in a phased manner.



- We will ensure that all unorganised workers are registered on the e-Shram portal.
- We will ensure that there is a periodic revision of minimum wages for all workers in the unorganised sector.
- We will introduce the Shram Shakti Scheme under which we will create a corpus of ₹100 crores and provide a collateral-free credit card with a limit of up to ₹50,000 for unorganised workers.
- We will provide free health insurance and social security insurance to all unorganised workers.


