

We will power Odisha into a top-performing economy and create over 3.5 lakh jobs by 2029 through :

- Developing an industrial corridor connecting Rourkela, Sambalpur, Paradeep and Dhamra by June 2027.
- Introducing the "PROSPER-Odisha (Promoting Regional Opportunities and Sustaining Entrepreneurial Resilience)" scheme to boost the MSME sector



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- Setting up state-of-the-art IT Park in 4 cities, namely Bhubaneswar, Rourkela, Berhampur and Balasore
- Laying special focus on the automobile, EV, semiconductor and IT/ITES industry through the 'Make in Odisha' scheme

We will provide legal, medical and engineering courses in Odia.



We will ensure recruitment to 1.5 lakh vacant government posts in a fair and transparent manner. Recruitment for 65,000 posts will be completed in 2 years. We will fill the vacancies for OBC and EWS on a priority basis.



We will launch the Kendu Patra Tolali Kalyana Jojana under which:

- Kendu Patra will be procured at ₹2 per kerry
- A bonus of 35% to Kendu Patra Pluckers and 10% to Kendu Patra Binders will be given







We will ensure the complete implementation of PM Awas Jojana, under which 15 lakh houses will be built, and of Jal Jeevan Mission providing water connections for 26 lakh households and 40,000 public places of Odisha.

We promise to undo the injustice done to Hindu devotees by the Government's mismanagement of the Puri Temple. For this,

- We will expedite the investigation of the missing key to the Ratna Bhandar of Shri Jagannath Mandir
- We will ensure that the mathas evicted during the Puri Parikrama project are fairly compensated and re-established
- We will restore the auditing process of Ratna Bhandar's inventory and publish the report
- We will open all four gates of Shri Jagannath Mandir for devotees



We will improve the livelihood of weavers and promote the textile industry in the state by:

- Setting up 3 Integrated Textile Parks in Western Odisha, generating over 51,000 jobs
- Launching the 'Bunakara Samman Nidhi' for weavers and handloom workers in the state, through which we will provide monthly financial assistance of ₹3,000 for all the beneficiaries between 40 and 60 years of age and ₹3,500 for all beneficiaries above 60 years of age







We will provide the labourers in the unorganised sector with an insurance cover of ₹5 lakhs and undertake a large-scale registration drive to enrol unorganised workers through the e-Shram initiative of the Central Government.



We will implement Ayushman Bharat—Pradhan Mantri Jan Aarogya Jojana (AB-PMJAY) within 100 days of coming to power, thereby ensuring that the country's largest universal health insurance is made available to all Odisha residents who have income lower than ₹8 lakh/ per annum.



We will provide ₹5,000 annually to all tribal students as Madho Singh Haath-Kharcha to encourage them to attend schools and reduce dropout rates.



We will launch the 'Mukhyamantri Sahayata Jojana' to provide pension of ₹3,000 per month for all elderly, divyang, widows, and destitute in the state. Further, we will provide a pension of ₹3,500 for elderly above 80 years and divyang with 80% disability.







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We will launch 'Mission Swasthya Odisha', under which :

- We will strengthen the health infrastructure by installing 36,000 beds in the CHCs & PHCs
- We will also modernise every CHC by 2027 with ICUs, dialysis units and operation theatres and upgrade 100 CHCs into Sub-Divisional Hospitals
- We will establish a nursing college, a medical college, and a super-speciality hospital in every district

We will make Odisha the state with the third-largest tourist footfall, which will contribute to the development of the tourist economy and generate employment opportunities.



We will implement the PM-Surya Ghar : Muft Bijli Jojana across urban and rural households of Odisha.

Agriculture, Pisciculture and Animal Husbandry



Modi Government's Achievements



Under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi, 35.11 lakh farmer-beneficiaries in Odisha have received ₹9202.52 crore.



From 2016-23, the area covered under micro-irrigation has increased in Odisha and the total area covered under the **Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY)** is **94,722 hectares**.



Under **PMKSY-AIBP**, over **₹1,200 crore** has been released by the Modi Government for the irrigation projects in Odisha.



Under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY), 37,999 beneficiaries have received ₹197.91 crore.



The Modi Government has created 447 Farmer Producer Organisations (FPOs) in Odisha.

- In 2023, there were just 36 functioning cold storage units across Odisha as compared to BJD's **promise to construct 1,000 new cold storage units**.
- 60% of bank loans under the KALIA Scheme have been diverted to non-agricultural purposes leading to a ₹800 crore scam.
- Large-scale irrigation projects like the Lower Suktel, Telengi, Mahendratanaya, Vamsadhara, Aung, Upper Lanth, Lower Lanth, and Reth were delayed or left unfinished despite being commissioned decades ago.

Our Promises

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- 1. We will start the **Samrudh Krushak Niti,** under which:
 - The rate of paddy procurement would be ₹3,100 per quintal
 - Payment will be transferred to farmers within 48 hours through DBT
 - Procurement will be done through electronic weighing machines in all mandis, eliminating the present practice of katni-chhatni
- 2. We will ensure the **tripling of irrigated agricultural land** by expediting stalled projects and complete saturation of irrigation schemes by 2029.
- 3. We will vastly increase the income of farmers by :
 - Providing 80-85% subsidy on mechanised farming equipment and tools
 - Developing cold storage facilities, processing units, and efficient supply chain networks to reduce post-harvest losses and increase the value of agricultural products
 - Organising training programs, workshops, and demonstrations to enhance farmers' skills in modern farming techniques, value addition
- 4. We will set up ₹3,000 crore Krushi Sangrakhyana Kosha to set up cold storage facilities, and agro-processing units in all blocks and establish two export-specific pack houses in Odisha.



- 5. We will upgrade mandis through the Basudha Kendra Jojana, under which :
 - We will build mandis in each block and revamp the existing mandis with granaries, farmers' rest shed, and warehouse, connecting all mandis to e-NAM across Odisha
 - We will provide a storage facility in every Gram Panchayat for Agricultural and Minor Forest Produce and enable geo-tagging of warehouses
 - The procurement list will be expanded to include oilseeds (groundnut, mustard, coconut and sunflower), pulses, millets and vegetables
- 6. We will promote women landless farmers to enroll in Primary Agricultural Credit Societies (PACS) and Large Area Multipurpose Societies (LAMPS).
- 7. We will launch "Krushi Samruddhi Kendras" in every block and the "Krushi Samruddhi" helpline to provide agriculture-related assistance regarding schemes, financial services, inputs, crop planning and procurement for the farmers.
- 8. We will launch the 'Krushi Vidya Nidhi Scheme' to provide scholarships up to ₹2,00,000 to the children of small and marginal farmers and agricultural labourers studying in Government institutions till post-graduation.

- We will significantly boost cotton production and streamline cotton procurement processes through local mandis to strengthen Odisha's cotton industry.
- **10.** We will set up **mini-banks** in every gram panchayat for all cooperatives, ensuring universal access to essential banking services.
- 11. We will ensure 100% coverage under PMFBY to all the farmers of the state and extend the benefit to the crops damaged by wild animals.
- 12. We will launch the "Odisha Balabhadra Jaivik Chasa Mission" to promote organic farming under which:
 - We will increase the area under organic farming in the state
 - We will eliminate crop threats from pests by effectively implementing PM-PRANAM
- 13. We will introduce a "New Price Policy For Sugarcane" for sugarcane farmers and reopen the closed sugarcane mills.
- 14. We will launch the Shree Anna Abhiyan to enhance millet production and consumption, making Odisha the 'millet hub of the nation' by:
 - > Promoting millet cultivation in tribal regions
 - Creating a robust supply chain, first within the state and then by doubling exports and production
 - Providing 40% subsidy for setting up millet processing plants
 - We will aim to encourage millet consumption by introducing it in all Government canteens, schools and institutions, combatting malnourishment effectively

- 15. We will set up a corpus fund of ₹500 crore to enhance the production and productivity of neglected crops, such as jute and groundnuts, aimed at crop diversification and augmenting farmer incomes.
- 16. We will ensure that PM KUSUM is fully implemented in the state, empowering farmers with renewable energy solutions for micro-irrigation.
- 17. We will undertake **10 new irrigation projects** in the districts of Balangir, Kalahandi, Bargarh, and Nuapada, which will be completed within one year.
- 18. We will establish an Agriculture University in Sambalpur.

B. Pisciculture

- 1. We will launch the **"Odisha Matsya Mission"** to increase fish production from 1,250 MT to 5,000 MT/ year by 2030 through :
 - > Providing a subsidy of 25% for all fish farms
 - Providing a subsidy of 35% for new farms
 - Providing a subsidy of 50% for bio-bags and caged farming
- We will provide an annual lean period allowance of ₹10,000 to every fisherman as a sustenance support during the ban period on fishing.
- 3. We will revolutionise the fishing industry by bringing the "New Fisheries Policy" which will include:
 - Upgrading fishing harbours and landing centres with modern amenities and facilities
 - Providing a 40% subsidy for cold warehouses and processing houses for fisheries
 - Stringent policies and monitoring regulations to control water pollution
- **4.** We will incentivise the setting up of **prawn farms** along the inland fishery belts and in coastal districts of Odisha.
- 5. We will streamline the procurement at fish landing centres based on classification and rates set by Fish Cooperatives.
- 6. We will earmark a corpus fund of ₹2,000 crore for contingency and disaster response for fish farmers.



C. Animal Husbandry

- 1. We will provide **mobile veterinary clinics in every block of Odisha** to protect the livestock of the state.
- 2. We will launch the **'Dughdha Banya Mission'** to increase the milk production capacity to 100 Lakh Tons by 2027 by providing:
 - 60% subsidy in setting up livestock farms, and 70% subsidy for SC/ST
 - ► 50% subsidy for fodder cultivation
 - ► 50% subsidy for feed units
- 3. We will launch the **"Ksheer Dhara Mission"** to completely restructure OMFED, under which we will:
 - Create an Apex Dairy Institute in the state with support from the Central Dairy Institute
 - Set up a 'Ksheer Dhara Collection Centre' in every village and a Milk Chilling Centre in every sub-division to solve the difficulties faced by dairy farmers
 - > Ensure a fixed minimum purchase price for milk collection
- 4. We will implement the **Anti-Cow-Slaughter Act** to stop the illegal slaughter and trade of cows.
- 5. We will launch the **Govansha Surakhya Jojana**, under which we will establish a Government-aided goshala in every block.
- 6. We will launch the transformative **Prani Sampada Mission** to achieve the ambitious goals of producing 540 lakh tons of poultry, 2 lakh metric tons of goat meat, and a staggering 11,000 crore eggs by the year 2027. This mission will be bolstered by:
 - Providing 40% subsidy to set up poultry farms, goateries, and piggeries
 - Extending 50% subsidy to all cluster farming operations undertaken through Farmer Producer Organisations (FPOs) and by women farmers
 - Offering 60% subsidy to SC/ST communities
- 7. We will promote **Odisha's indigenous cow and goat breeds (Ramba)** by providing incentives for their rearing, evaluation, and nutrition.

Education



Modi Government's Achievements



From 2018-23, the Modi Government released over ₹7,800 crore under Samagra Siksha Programme.



Under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana, over 4.42 lakh youth have been certified.



The permanent campus of **IIT-Bhubaneswar was built** at a cost of **₹1,660 crore and inaugurated** in 2018.



The permanent campus of **IIM Sambalpur** built at a cost of **₹401 crore**, was inaugurated in February 2024.

- Odisha has slipped from **10th rank in 2020-21 to 24th rank in 2021-22** in terms of providing school education.
- Under the BJD rule, Government-autonomous degree colleges were found operating without AICTE approval.
- As of July 2023, more than **50% of teaching positions** are **vacant** in several state universities.
- Odisha's universities saw a **consistent decline in NIRF rankings**, with only **4** making the top 100 since 2019.

Our Promises

- We will formulate and enact a state-level education policy, aligning with the National Education Policy 2020 (NEP-2020), within three months of assuming office, ensuring swift progress towards holistic educational reforms.
- 2. We will provide legal, medical and engineering courses in Odia.
- 3. We will launch the Digital Education Empowerment Program (DEEP) to provide advanced digital learning infrastructure under which :
 - We will set up state-of-the-art computer laboratories in all Government schools
 - We aim to enhance educational opportunities by introducing STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) education initiatives in collaboration with the tech industry
 - In alignment with the National Education Policy of 2020, we promise to commence coding classes in Odisha schools, beginning from the sixth grade
- 4. We will provide tablets to each and every student from classes 9 to 12 at Government schools
- We will establish counselling centres in every school and make career counselling mandatory for the students of the state from class 9.
- 6. We will launch '**Praveshika Jojana'** to ensure that every child in pre-primary and primary school will have achieved foundational literacy and numeracy by 2030. Under this Jojana :
 - ► We will upgrade all 74,157 existing Anganwadis to the new-generation 'Saksham Anganwadis'
 - We will upskill all qualified Anganwadi workers to become Academic Resource Persons (ARPs), enabling them to teach preschool students



7. We promise to revamp the existing capacity-building mechanism for school teachers. This program shall include :

- Establishing the Odisha Capacity Building Commission for School Teachers (OCBCST), headed by the Minister of Education, to coordinate the preparation and implementation of capacity-building plans and supervise the training institutions
- Formulating a Competency Framework to undertake service matters such as confirmation after the probation period, deployment, work assignment, etc
- Creating a Digital Platform to streamline training programs, deliver curated, role-specific content, and ensure accountability by making provision for regular tests for school teachers
- 8. We will revolutionise the learning experience by introducing AI teachers, "Vidya", in every Government School in Odisha.
- We will establish a uniform pay grade system for teachers at all levels, upholding our principle of 'Equal Work, Equal Pay' throughout schools, colleges and universities.

- Within the first six months of taking office, we will reopen all 8,000 primary and upper primary schools that were closed under the previous Government's regime.

Under **Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan**, over **₹370 crore** has been released for the improvement of State Universities.



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Shri Narendra Modi Ji laid the foundation stone of the Indian Institute of Science Education and Research (IISER), Berhampur, established at around ₹1,600 crore.

- Even after **17 years of its declaration in 2000**, the State Government has failed to deliver on its Youth Policy.
- According to the Ministry of Social Justice, **21 lakh people** in Odisha suffer from **alcoholism**, while **1.9 lakh people** suffer from **cannabis-related problems**.

Our Promises

- We will provide interest-free loans up to ₹10 lakh with a 50% subsidy to the youth in the state under "Udyam Kranti Jojana".
- We will provide a cost subsidy on electric twowheelers for women who are enrolled in all Government colleges under the 'Mission Pankh'.
- 3. We will introduce the **"ODISEY (Odisha Development Initiative for Science and Engineering for Youth) Jojana"**, offering Robotics and AI learning opportunities in all State Government schools, through lab facilities, courses and nationwide competitions.
- 4. We will introduce the **academic curriculum of JEE/NEET** and other competitive exams in every Government and Government Aided school for all aspirants.
- 5. We will launch the **Sports Policy 2024**, which focuses on providing infrastructure for players starting from the village level, especially traditional sports, and creating a support ecosystem. Under this policy, we will:
 - Build one astroturf-based Open Air Gymnasium and one Sports Nursery for training athletes between 8 to 17 years of age, each at every block
 - Establish five academies in every district catering to the traditional sports prevalent in the districts, including Khokho, Gudu, Kabaddi, and Archery
 - Establish District-level Sports Academies, catering to popular sports of each district, to provide professional coaching and guidance to aspiring talents



- 6. We will establish 4 state-of-the-art Olympic Training Academies in four zones of Odisha to impart world-class training to our athletes to help them compete on the international stage.
- 7. We will launch the **'Ignite Odisha'** scheme to empower and support the 'digital influencers', content creators and folk artists of the state by setting up 50 art studios.
- 8. We will launch 'Odisha Khel Ratna Khoj Abhiyaan' and transform Odisha into the epicentre of sporting activity by :
 - Establishing the state's first Sports University in Bhubaneswar
 - Introduce a talent spotting program that will identify budding talents every year to help them achieve their potential in sports through an annual scholarship of ₹75,000

- 9. We will establish a state-of-the-art Esports arena cum training centre equipped with high-end technology and a dedicated coaching staff.

Economy andIndustries



Modi Government's Achievements

In Odisha, **5,065 domestic companies** availed of the benefits of making a fresh start after being a defaulter under the Companies Fresh Start Scheme, 2020.



Under the National Industrial Corridor Program, **Paradip-Kendrapada-Dhamra-Subarnarekha** and **Gopalpur-Bhubaneshwar-Kalinganagar** are the two industrial corridor projects.



Under the Emergency Credit Line Guarantee Scheme (ECLGS), **9,27,249** guarantees worth **₹5,462.17 crore** were given.



Under the National Informatics Centre (NIC), 31 NICs have been established in Odisha.

- Odisha was ranked 29th under the Ease of Doing Business (2020) rankings in India.
- Odisha ranked 6th out of 8 coastal States under the Export Preparedness Index (EPI) (2022).
- Under the Indian Innovation Index, **Odisha ranked 16th** out of 16 major states, scoring just **11.42 out of 20**.

Our Promises

- We will launch the Mega City Development Mission and development of satellite cities aimed at the creation of three Mega Cities to ensure rapid development and streamlined governance in Odisha encompassing :
 - South Eastern regions of Koraput, Jeypore and Nabarangpur

Modi Government's Achievements



Under the National Health Mission (NHM), over ₹10,000 crore have been released for Odisha.



The Modi Government had established **488 operational PM Bharatiya Jan Aushadhi Kendras** for providing affordable medicines.



Under Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY), three new Government Medical Colleges have been approved for upgradation with the allocation of ₹820 crore.



Under Poshan Abhiyan, **around 41 lakh** children, adolescent girls, and pregnant/lactating women have been provided nutrition with an expenditure of **₹825.19 crore**.

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- We will implement Ayushman Bharat—Pradhan Mantri Jan Aarogya Jojana (AB-PMJAY) within 100 days of coming to power, thereby ensuring that the country's largest universal health insurance is made available to all Odisha residents who have income lower than ₹8 lakh/ per annum.
- We will ensure the comprehensive development of public healthcare infrastructure in Odisha through 'Mission Swasthya Odisha', under which:
 - Establishing a nursing college, a medical college, and a super-speciality hospital in every district
 - Upgrading every existing 6,688 Sub Centres and 1,226 Primary Health Centres into Arogya Mandirs
 - All Arogya Mandirs will have PM Jan Aushadhi Kendra to provide affordable medicines to people


Charges Against BJD Government

Environment Forest and Natural Resources



Modi Government's Achievements

Total funds worth **₹347.27** crore have been released to the **Odisha Forest Department**, and **₹**901.03 crore approved for **Annual Plan of Operation (APO)**.

According to the India State Forest Report (ISFR) Report 2021, the forest cover in Odisha has grown by 1.04 % compared to 2019.


The Central Government launched the **Green India Mission** in 2015-16, and accordingly, **71.31 lakh** trees have been planted in Odisha.

Under the Nagar Van Yojana, 40 projects have been approved for the state of Odisha, with ₹20.34 crore funds.

Under the National Clean Air Programme (NCAP), MoEF&CC conducted 3 regional workshops and a National Conference on VAYU in Odisha.

- A whopping 18.5 million trees have been felled for the widening of roads in Odisha.
- **Poachers and timber mafia** have been given a free hand over the rich green cover of the state.
- In the tribal-dominated districts, over **1,600 sq km of forest cover** was lost to reckless mining activities between 2001 and 2019.
- Rampant mining has led to the diversion of 10,451.39 hectares of forest land over 38 years in Keonjhar district – the highest loss of green cover in Odisha.
- Local villagers of Kalahandi and Rayagada districts of Odisha have expressed fear of environmental degradation and loss of livelihood due to the proposed Sijimali Bauxite Mines.

- 1. We promise to launch an **afforestation drive aiming to plant 20,000 ha** of tree cover every year, including compensatory afforestation by the Central Government Departments.
- 2. We will introduce Jala Sanrakhyana Niti for comprehensive watershed management by constructing and maintaining check dams, anicuts and barrages, improving inland waterways and periodic desilting and dredging of dams.
- 3. We will implement the Swachh-Sundar Odisha scheme to make every urban city in Odisha the cleanest in India, integrating waste management initiatives for sustainable cleanliness.
- 4. We commit to implementing strict legislative actions to address the increasing issue of elephant poaching in the state.
- 5. We will form a comprehensive Flood Control and Management Policy under which we will :
 - Expedite all the projects of constructing barrages and check dams to manage the shifting course of the Baitarani River
 - Undertake holistic flood management in the flood-prone districts of Sambalpur, Sundargarh, Deogarh, Angul, Dhenkanal, Cuttack, Jajpur, Kendrapara, Mayurbhanj, Bhadrak, Balasore, Keonjhar, Khordha, and Jagatsinghpur



- 6. We will provide zero-premium 100% coverage insurance against home damage caused by wild elephants and an ex-gratia amount increase from ₹6,00,000 to ₹10,00,000 upon death due to human-elephant conflict.
- 7. We will formulate a **State Climate Justice Masterplan** for long-term solutions to Climate Change under which :
 - ► We will increase the installed capacity for renewable energy generation to 5,000 MW by 2030
 - ► We will increase the share of renewable energy generation to 25% of the total electricity generation by 2027

- Employing automated cleaning equipment 'Ro-Boat' along with unconventional methods
- > Developing inland water transport in the river
- Reviewing the Rule Curve for better flood management
- **9.** We will establish **Air Pollution Monitoring Stations** in 7 cities and launch the Sabhuja Odisha App to ensure the effective and coordinated implementation of pollution control measures.
- **10.** We will undertake **coastal afforestation to develop climate resilience** along the 480 km coastline. Additionally, we will increase the natural protection wall of mangrove cover on the cyclone-vulnerable coast by 25 sq. km by 2028.
- 11. We will strengthen the existing **Integrated Coastal Zone Management Project (ICZMP)** by :
 - Increasing the number of Multipurpose Cyclone Shelters from 14 to 24
 - Augmenting the capacity of MCS management and maintenance



- Lack of infrastructure and delayed construction projects in Government-run educational institutions in Odisha have deteriorated the quality of education and accessibility for students
- Despite a substantial allocation of ₹2,150 crore for constructing 4 lakh houses under the 'Mo Ghara' scheme, only a meagre 4,666 beneficiaries have obtained bank approvals.
- The Odisha High Court had served a notice to the Odisha Government following a petition contesting the implementation process of the Ama Odisha, Nabin Odisha scheme.
- Mere **3.5% of households** in Odisha had access to tap water in 2019.

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- 1. We will ensure world-class road connectivity across Odisha by constructing 75,000 km of rural and state highway roads connecting all Gram Panchayats, the District Headquarters, and the State Capital.
- 2. We will ensure a 24x7 power supply, smart metering and relief from irregular electricity bills across the state.

The Modi Government designated 3 wetlands as Ramsar sites in Odisha.

21 Railway Stations in Odisha being redeveloped at ₹900 crore.

Under the Capacity Building for Service Providers (CBSP) an amount of ₹75,445.40 crore was released to Heritage Charitable Trust, Odisha.

Charges Against BJD Government

- In tourism, Odisha ranks 21st among 37 States/UTs, with only 7.89 crore tourists visiting the State in 2022
- The connectivity to popular tourist destinations remains abysmal, with corruption hindering development.

Under the AMRUT scheme, 189 projects have been completed at a cost of ₹785.23 crore.

Under the **National Smart Cities Mission**, as of February 2024, **89 projects** have been completed at the cost of **₹3,177 crore**.

- The BJD Government is falling short of **514 million litres per day (MLD) in sewage generation and treatment** and legacy **waste of 37 lakh metric tonnes (MT)**.
- The BJD Government had identified 20 slums as Biju Adarsh Colonies but three years since the launch, the beneficiaries are yet to reap the benefits.



- 2. We will provide solar panels to urban households in Odisha through the PM-Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Jojana.
- 3. We will eradicate the 'Mountains of Trash' by making the use of up to 8% of plastic waste compulsory in road construction under the 'Rags To Roads' scheme.
- 4. We guarantee a proper standard of living for slum dwellers by implementing a slum rehabilitation and management policy.
- 5. We will establish and facilitate 24/7 convenience as well as essential stores/markets in Bhubaneswar, Cuttack and Rourkela within 6 months of coming into power and replicate the model in every urban city within 5 years.

- 3. We will start Mission Mahapuskarani by undertaking a state-wide drive to rejuvenate all 19,630 ponds and lakes.
- 4. We will set up solar-powered street lights in all Gram Panchayats of Odisha.

- 5. We will start the Bikasit Gaon, Bikasit Odisha scheme under which we will allocate untied funds worth ₹1 crore under 'Special Development Assistance' to encourage them to develop rural infrastructure to global standards.


A. Northern Odisha

- 1. We will build a 600-bed multispeciality hospital in Keonjhar.
- 2. We will expedite the work on the **Nilagiri-Betnoti Railway Project** connecting Balasore to Mayurbhanj.
- 3. We will establish a **Fast Track Court in Mayurbhanj** to speed up the cases of atrocities against tribal population.
- 4. We will introduce the **Mayurbhanj Art and Sculpture Promotion Policy 2024** for the promotion of the local artforms like **Dhokra** and folk dance forms like **Chhau Nritya** with special emphasis on marketing and innovation.
