


- Proprietary Rights to women have been guaranteed by the Modi Government. Various women-centric legislations such as Prevention of Domestic Violence Act, POCSO are now applicable in J&K ensuring protection to women.
- West Pakistan refugees have gained full citizenship rights, ending decades of oppressive treatment. Social Justice has now also been ensured in J&K with assured reservation for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes.
- The Jammu and Kashmir Reorganisation (Second Amendment) Act, 2023 was enacted providing reservation of one-third of all elected seats in the Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Assembly for women, showcasing BJP's commitment to Women's rights and welfare.
- Several infrastructural projects including the Chenab Railway Bridge (cost ₹14,000 crore), Banihal Qazigund Road Tunnel (cost ₹3,100 crore) and the Delhi-Katra Greenfield Expressway (cost ₹40,000 crore) have transformed the infrastructural landscape of Jammu and Kashmir.
- India's second ever Vande Bharat was launched between Delhi and Katra. Further, another Vande Bharat train was launched on the same route to provide seamless connectivity to the people.
- Income of the farmers has increased substantially due to initiatives like Lavender Farming under 'Aroma Mission' undertaken by the Modi Government.
- The Jammu and Kashmir Official Languages Act, 2020, recognized Kashmiri, Dogri, and Hindi as official languages of Jammu and Kashmir.



BJP's MAJOR ACHIEVEMENTS IN JAMMU & KASHMIR







By wiping out terrorism and separatism, we will make Jammu and Kashmir a leader in development and progress in the nation.

To further propel Prime Minister Narendra Modi's vision for women-led development in Jammu and Kashmir, we will prioritise enhancing women's financial security and self-reliance by:

- Implementing 'Maa Samman Yojana' to provide ₹ 18,000 per year to the senior most woman in every household in Jammu & Kashmir
- Providing assistance through the state government for Women SHGs on the issue of interest on bank loans
- Providing 2 free LPG cylinders every year to the Pradhan Mantri Ujjawala Yojana beneficiaries.

Through Pandit Prem Nath Dogra Rozgar Yojana (PPNDRY), we will create 5 lakh employment opportunities in Jammu & Kashmir.

We will provide ₹ 3,000 yearly through DBT as travel allowance to college students under the 'Pragati Shiksha Yojana'.

We will enable the youth of Jammu & Kashmir preparing for competitive exams like JKPSC and UPSC by:

- Ensuring fair and just recruitment processes, with timely interviews
- Providing a reimbursement of coaching fees to the tune of ₹ 10,000 for 2 years
- Reimbursing the travel costs to examination centres and one-time application fee.





We will provide tablets/laptops to students studying in higher secondary classes in remote areas.



We will promote and develop the economy in Jammu-Kashmir, with specific emphasis on:

- Setting up three regional development boards to monitor saturation of government schemes and craft programmes to meet the aspirations of the Jammu region
- Tourism industry development at Doda, Kishtwar, Ramban, Rajouri, Poonch and upper reaches of Udhampur, Kathua
- Developing Dal Lake in Srinagar city as a world-class tourist destination and promoting water sports
- Setting up an Amusement Park in Tattoo Ground in Srinagar
- Setting up an IT hub as a Special Economic Zone (SEZ) at Jammu city
- Develop Gulmarg and Pahalgam in the Kashmir Valley as modern tourist towns and enhance the necessary infrastructure
- Establishing pharmaceutical park in Udhampur and an AYUSH Herbal park in Kishtwar
- Developing the Tawi Riverfront similar to the Sabarmati Riverfront in Ahmedabad, Gujarat
- Creating a separate lake development authority for Ranjit Sagar Dam thereby promoting tourism.



To support existing businesses and small traders the following will be done:

- A new policy will be drafted to address the issues facing 7,000 existing MSME units in Jammu and Kashmir so that access to land and public utilities will be addressed
- Issues around regularisation of lease deeds of small traders and shopkeepers that are currently operating in existing markets and commercial spaces will be done in a time-bound manner
- Initiate steps to resolve the problems of MSME units and workers.

We will ensure free-allotment of 5 Marlas for landless beneficiaries through Atal Awas Yojana.

We will address issues with utilities and other public services in Jammu Kashmir by providing:

- A scheme for relief from outstanding bills of electricity and water for all consumers
- Drinking water through 'Har Ghar Nal Se Jal'
- Free electricity through PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana, with an additional subsidy of ₹10,000 to households for solar instrument installation.

We will triple the old age, widow and disability pensions from ₹ 1,000 to ₹ 3,000, guaranteeing a life of dignity for the vulnerable groups.

12

We will ensure affordable healthcare for all by increasing the coverage of Ayushman Bharat Sehat Scheme by an additional ₹ 2 lakhs from ₹ 5 lakhs.

13

We will add 1,000 new seats to existing and upcoming government medical colleges.

14

We will provide ₹10,000 under PM Kisan Samman Nidhi, comprising the existing ₹6,000 along with an additional ₹4,000, thereby ensuring the wellbeing of farmers in Jammu & Kashmir.



15

We will implement reduced electricity tariffs, lowered by up to 50%, for agricultural activities, making it more affordable for farmers to operate irrigation pumps and other machinery.

We will implement reforms for government employees which will:

- Ensure reservation in promotion for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled
 Tribes within government services
- Create a transfer policy for all the employees specifically for Scheduled Caste and other employees working in Kashmir Valley.

We will give a 20% quota to Agniveers in J&K government jobs and police recruitment, and will follow the Jammu-Kashmir reservation policy without affecting the general quota.

We will address the grievances of long-serving adhoc/contractual/daily wage employees. Additionally, we will provide targeted additional support to address the grievances of crucial community workers such as Anganwadi Workers, ASHAs, NHM workers, Rehbar-e-Khel employees (ReK), Community Information Centre (CIC) operators, Home Guards and National Youth Corps (NYCs).

19

We will build 10,000 km of new rural roads to ensure that no village is left behind. Further, we will complete projects like Sadhna Pass Tunnel, Katra-Banihal Railway Tunnel under the 'Har Tunnel Tez Pahal' Yojana for seamless connectivity in Jammu & Kashmir.

We will expedite the metro services in Jammu and Srinagar to improve urban connectivity and enhance mobility.

We will undertake the reconstruction of Hindu temples and shrines under Rishi Kashyapa Pilgrimage Rejuvenation Drive. We will restore 100 ruined temples and further develop existing temples, including the Shankaracharya Temple (Jyeshteshwara Temple), Raghunath Temple, and Marthanda Sun Temple, with the active participation of religious and spiritual organisations.

We will undertake a concerted drive to address illegal Rohingya and Bangladeshi settlements in Jammu & Kashmir.

To ensure the safe return and rehabilitation of the Kashmiri Pandit community, we will launch the Tika Lal Taploo Visthapit Samaj Punarvas Yojana (TLTVSPY). We will also expedite the rehabilitation of West Pakistan refugees, POJK refugees and internally neglected communities like Valmiki and Gorkhas. We will ensure that the displaced persons of Jammu division get all the due benefits, security and protection that the displaced persons from Kashmir are given.


Recognising the Struggles of Jammu Region:

A Concerted Push to Fast-track Development

- he region of Jammu had to bear the brunt of violence and terrorism thus affecting the people's right to life, freedom and livelihood. It is therefore incumbent to fast-track the development of the region through the following measures:
- We will set-up three regional development boards in Jammu to monitor that the aspirations of the districts of the Jammu region are developed with local community participation based on their strengths.
- The regional development boards will:
 - Gauge the current levels of development of its region based on pre-defined measurable indicators
 - Provide an action plan for development including saturation of Union and state level schemes
 - Estimate the effort in terms of personnel and expenditure to realise the action plan
 - Assess the progress made and the impact of the development efforts.
- > We will promote and develop the economy in Jammu division, with specific emphasis on:
 - Tourism industry development at Doda, Kishtwar, Ramban, Rajouri, Poonch and upper reaches of Udhampur, Kathua
 - Promoting Border Tourism at International Border and Line of Control
 - Setting up an IT hub as a Special Economic Zone (SEZ) at Jammu city
 - Establishing pharmaceutical park in Udhampur and an AYUSH Herbal park in Kishtwar



- Expedite the safe and sustainable mining of 5.9 Million Tonnes of Lithium deposits that were recently discovered in the Salal-Haimana area of the Reasi district and leverage the royalties accrued to the District Mineral Fund to develop the region.
- Develop the Tawi River front in the middle of the Jammu city along the lines of Gujarat's Sabarmati River Front such that it contains promenades and pedestrian spaces, parks, open air fitness centres, sports facilities, and biodiversity parks. All effluents and other discharges will be treated in Sewage Treatment plants (STPs) before being discharged.
- We will ensure the development of an international airport in Jammu, to enhance connectivity and attract international tourists.
- We will rename SKUAST University, Jammu to Baba Jitto University of Agricultural Sciences and Technology, and upgrade it to Central Agricultural University thereby ensuring quality education for the youth in Jammu & Kashmir.
- > We will revamp and expand the cargo handling capacity at Jammu Airport.
- We will ensure to upgrade the Akashvani and DD Kendra Jammu with proper set-up and equipment to disseminate authenticated information and to preserve local culture.
- We will establish a Sports Authority of India (SAI) Complex in Jammu City.
- We will ensure that the cultural and civilisation ethos of Jammu region is protected by:
 - Creating a dharmic spiritual circuit and ensure development of amenities, and facilities at the Vaishno Devi shrine, Raghunath Temple, Peer Kho Cave temple, Shivkhori and Machail Mata Temple
 - Marketing traditional art forms such as Basohlipainting that have recently obtained the geographical indication tag in March 2023
 - Apart from popular Hindu festivals of Lohri, Maha Shivratri, Basant Panchami, we
 will also provide assistance for conducting local festivals such as the eight day long
 Rath Kharda Mela in Samba the celebration of the five-day period of Tulsi Puja in the
 run-up to Kartika Purnima as Panj Bhikham (Bhishma Panchak).






Security-Terror-Free Jammu & Kashmir

This has led to organised stone pelting incidents and organised hartals reducing from 1,328 and 52 respectively in 2018 to "0" by 2023.

- We will engage deeply with communities and enforce strict legal and administrative measures to create a stable and secure environment for all.
- We will ensure all Village Defence Guards receive their rightful honorarium, boost existing honoraria, equip them with automatic weapons, and codify their service conditions to strengthen our fight against terrorism.
- We recognise the important role played by SPOs in Jammu and Kashmir Police in fighting terrorism and we are aware of the problems faced by them. We are committed to address their problems in a holistic manner.

- We will make the Monthly Risk Allowance (MRA) for all ranks of the JK Police at par with ranks of Army/Paramilitary forces, recognising their efforts in combating terrorism in the region for the past 30 years.
- We will take comprehensive steps for the development and upliftment of border dwellers in Jammu and Kashmir, with a focus on improving connectivity, livelihoods, resolving crossborder land ownership issues and promoting border tourism.
- We will increase the number of community bunkers and shelters to ensure safety during crossborder tension, ensure safety during cross-border tensions. Further ensure that cross-border shelling remains negligible and strengthen early warning systems to alert residents about potential security threats.



women police officers to ensure sensitivity and responsiveness to their needs.

- We aim to create 50,000 lakhpati Didis in Jammu & Kashmir. For this, we will strengthen and expand Women's Self-Help Groups (SHGs) by providing access to credit, training in financial management, and market linkages.
- We will launch the BITES Scheme (Breakfast Initiative Through Empowered SHGs) to provide hot breakfast to students enrolled between Class I and VIII through the collaborative participation of the Self-Help Groups.
- We will provide targeted skill development programs aligned with local economic activities, such as handicrafts, agriculture, and tourism. These programs will focus on building entrepreneurial skills to enable women to become self-reliant.
- We will improve access to microfinance entrepreneurs for women simplifying the loan application process and providing low-interest along with mentorship, loans, networking opportunities, and financial support through entrepreneurship programs and startup incubators in J&K.
- We will launch comprehensive education and awareness programs, including girls' education campaigns, to promote girls education and ensure their access to quality learning opportunities.

Over the past five years, our efforts have led to significant milestones, including the doubling of vegetable, oilseed, mushroom production, and a threefold increase in trout production.

- We will provide ₹4,000 under PM Kisan Samman Nidhi over and above the existing ₹6,000, bringing it to a total of ₹10,000, thereby ensuring the wellbeing of farmers in Jammu & Kashmir.
- We will implement reduced electricity tariffs, lowered by up to 50%, for agricultural activities, making it more affordable for farmers to operate irrigation pumps and other machinery.

- fair income for our farmers.
- We will enhance the horticultural product processing and marketing cooperative in Jammu & Kashmir, along the lines of the successful Himachal Pradesh Horticultural Produce Marketing And Processing Corporation which will empower local farmers, enhance their income and ensure the growth of the horticulture industry.
- We will promote diverse agricultural including practices, horticulture, floriculture with exotic flowers, beekeeping, fish farming, and integrated farming, using modern techniques and smart marketing in J&K.
- We will focus on cultivation of highvalue crops like apple, saffron, walnut, almond and Kandi-specific fruits like litchi, mango and dragon fruit by employing advanced cultivation and

pest control methods and enhancing their export potential.

- We will develop cold storages, provide facilities for market linkage through rural Mandis and ensure export markets to enhance the quality and reach of J&K's agricultural products.
- We will increase subsidies for farming equipment and fertilisers thereby ensuring financial support for farmers.
- We will comprehensively address the issues faced by the poor farmers regarding the falling of khair trees in Jammu & Kashmir including rigidity of time frame and demand for the inclusion of more villages in the 10 year felling programmes.
- We will increase organic farming, especially for crops with high export potential, by providing certification assistance, organic inputs, and training in organic farming practices.
- We will modernise the irrigation system by promoting drip and sprinkler techniques and providing subsidies to farmers to adopt them.
- We will develop digital platforms that leverage technology and innovation, enabling farmers to access real-time information on weather, market prices, and best practices.
- We will promote the establishment of agri-tech startups in the region, focusing on innovations such as AI-based crop monitoring, blockchain for supply chain transparency, and IoT-based smart farming solutions.
- We will facilitate easy access to credit at

low-interest rates for farmers, with special loan schemes for small and marginal farmers to invest in modern farming practices.

- We will establish farmer cooperatives to enhance collective bargaining and secure fair prices, and to set up processing units for value addition, including packaging, branding, and quality control.
- We will identify high-export-potential crops and develop strategies to promote them in the global marketplace.
- We will launch a scheme to increase the number of Farmer Producer Organisations (FPOs) in Jammu & Kashmir to 600, to strengthen agricultural collaboration and to provide holistic support to the farmers.
- We will establish meat and milk processing industries in Poonch, Rajouri, Baramulla, Doda and Budgam to enhance the local agricultural economy and create valueadded products.
- We will take strong measures to protect local apple producers from the impact of imported apples, by obtaining a GI tag for Kashmiri apples.
- Through the National Saffron Mission, we will promote the adoption of modern farming techniques, such as precision agriculture, to enhance saffron yield and quality. We will also capitalise on the newly obtained GI tag to globally market Kashmiri Saffron and uniquely promote Kishtwar Saffron. Additionally, we will tackle environmental issues like dust from cement factories and rodent infestations.






- We will ensure rehabilitation of displaced persons on a priority basis by formulating a policy for the same.
- We will enhance the 'minimum wage' in Jammu & Kashmir and ensure that the workers get full benefits of various labour laws in force. We will ensure fair wages, job security and the right to a safe working place with basic amenities and appropriate working hours for all daily wage and contractual workers.
- We will introduce Sri Maharaja Hari Singh Bima Yojana (SMHSBY) to provide free personal accidental insurance to every resident of Jammu Kashmir.
- we will ensure that housing policies are inclusive by prioritising vulnerable groups such as low-income families, single women, elderly, and differently-abled individuals.
- we will double the assistance provided under the State Marriage Assistance Scheme (SMAS) to facilitate families of poor girls to sustain the marriage costs.
- We will address the issues related to bifurcations of Ration Cards. We will ensure reconstruction of family Ration Cards which reflect the present status of the family.

- We will develop housing colonies with integrated community services, such as schools, healthcare centres, and public transport, to ensure a holistic living experience for all residents.
- We will increase rural housing by providing subsidies and technical assistance. We will also implement policies to regularise colonies, bringing them within the legal framework and ensuring property rights, infrastructure and services.
- We will ensure vesting of proprietary rights to residents of custodian houses in municipal limits. This is our commitment and resolving it will promote social stability and encourage investments in these areas.
- We will provide additional support to refugees who were granted rights post abrogation of Article 370. This will be done by enhancing their living conditions, improving access to services, and facilitating

The NDA Government under Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi Ji's leadership has made robust investments in public health infrastructure, spending over ₹7,000 crore on more than 4,000 health facilities, including 3,104 Health and Wellness Centers. The Ayushman Bharat Scheme has been implemented in J&K as Sehat-PMJAY with 19.02 lakh families benefited, 251 hospitals empanelled, and 12.90 lakh treatments worth ₹ 2,285 crore provided.

- We will ensure affordable healthcare for all by increasing the coverage of Ayushman Bharat Sehat Scheme from ₹5 lakhs to ₹7 lakhs and also integrate the remaining healthcare institutions under Ayushman Bharat Sehat Scheme, thereby, reducing the red tapes and formalities attached to it.
- We will establish 100 Ayushman Arogya Mandir in Jammu & Kashmir ensuring the well being of every resident.
- We will improve working conditions for doctors by doubling hospital infrastructure and ensuring they have

- We will recruit more doctors and paramedical staff in all district and sub-district hospitals.
- We will establish dedicated Maternal Healthcare Centers in every block of Jammu & Kashmir, ensuring comprehensive care and eliminating long travel and inadequate services for pregnant women.

 - All PHCs have diagnostic facilities

ammu & Kashmir's natural beauty and rich cultural heritage have always been its greatest assets. Recognising this, the NDA Government of India has made efforts to revitalise the tourism sector, making the region a prime destination once again. Just in 2023-24, the Amarnath Yatra witnessed more than 5.1 lakh yatris, while the Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine attracted more than 93 lakh devotees.

- We will promote and develop places such as Doda, Kishtwar, Ramban, Rajouri, Poonch and upper reaches of Udhampur, Kathua in Jammu Division as a distinct tourist destination by highlighting its cultural heritage, historical sites, and scenic beauty.
- We will promote Border Tourism in the Jammu region along the International Border and Line of Control.

- We will complete the riverfront projects (like Tawi Project) and begin the second phase to enhance the aesthetic appeal and recreational opportunities like river rafting, waterfront dining, walking trails, and cultural festivals along J&K's rivers.
- We will promote Tourism in Kashmir by:
 - Developing Dal Lake as a worldclass tourist destination and promote water sports

- We will ensure to upgrade the Akashvani and DD Kendra Jammu with proper set-up and equipment to disseminate authenticated information and to preserve local cultures.

 Street in important cities
 - Conducting a bi-annual food festival, one in Jammu and one in Srinagar

Modi Ji's leadership a New Industrial Policy has been implemented and ₹1,26,582 crore worth of investment proposals have been received and ₹6,624 crore investments have been realised generating employment for 5.5 lakh individuals. For the first time ever, multiple ₹500 crore + investment units have been set up under the New Industrial Policy.

 - Issues around regularisation of lease deeds of small traders and shopkeepers that are currently operating in existing markets and commercial spaces will be done in a time-bound manner.





- Initiate steps to resolve the problems of MSME units and workers.
- We will explore opportunities to establish heavy industries in the public and private sectors, bringing in significant investment and creating high-value jobs for the people of J&K. Further, we will establish industrial hubs in Udhampur, Kathua, Samba, Ganderbal and Budgam for boosting regional economies.
- We will offer access to easy loans and grants through credit guarantee schemes to fuel the growth of Micro,


- Small, and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs).
- we will initiate comprehensive, scientific exploration and transparent excavation of lithium reserves in Reasi, using modern technology to ensure sustainable mining practices. The revenue generated will be invested in upgrading infrastructure and in projects that directly benefit local communities through employment.
- We will develop an EV manufacturing corridor to strengthen the region's position in the growing electric vehicle market and support industrial growth.
- We will set up Trade Centres in all districts of J&K, facilitating commerce and boosting economic activity across the region.
- We will set up dedicated tribunals including Debt Recovery Tribunal and Income Tax Tribunal to expedite the resolution of financial and legal disputes, creating a business-friendly



environment that promotes faster economic growth.

- We will facilitate the adoption of state-of-the-art technologies and automation processes for enhancing productivity and competitiveness of our local industries.
- We will prioritise local entrepreneurs in industrial estates, offering incentives for setting up units that utilise local resources and talent, fostering a self-reliant economy.
- We will create strategically located Special Economic Zones (SEZs) to attract both domestic and international investments for generating employment opportunities, and boosting exports, driving economic growth.
- We are committed to ensuring the affordability and availability of essential construction materials like sand, stones, and gravel, especially for PMAY beneficiaries.

Investing In Education And Skill Development



National Education Policy (NEP) in 2022 has ensured that in Jammu & Kashmir the school going children of the region can now have access to free and high quality education. Apart from AIIMS, IIT, IIM and 7 new medical colleges, the NDA Government has established 51 new degree colleges in Jammu & Kashmir, since 2019.

- We will enable the youth of Jammu & Kashmir preparing for competitive exams like JKPSC and UPSC through:
 - Ensuring fair and just recruitment processes, with timely interviews
 - Providing a reimbursement of coaching fees to the tune of ₹10,000 for 2 years
 - Reimbursing the travel costs to examination centres and one-time application fee.

- We will provide tablets/laptops to students studying in higher secondary classes in remote areas.
- We will add 1,000 new seats to existing and upcoming government medical colleges.
- We will invest in the modernisation of more than 23,000 government schools and colleges, ensuring that they are equipped with the latest technology, online learning platforms, free WiFi and resources.
- We will launch 'Mission Pravesh' to ensure that every child in pre-primary and primary school will have achieved foundational literacy and numeracy by 2030, under which:
 - We will upgrade all 28,178 existing Anganwadis to the newgeneration 'Saksham Anganwadis'
 - We will upskill all qualified Anganwadi workers to become Academic Resource Persons



(ARPs), enabling them to teach preschool students.

- We will roll out extensive skill development programs to meet the demand for local skilled labour in the private sector, aligned with industry needs, ensuring that the youth are equipped with the skills required by local and global employers.
- We will expand existing scholarship schemes for SC/ST/OBC students to cover a wider range of educational levels, from primary to higher education, including professional courses.
- We will set up 10 Government Degree Colleges in Jammu & Kashmir, 4 of which would be exclusively women's colleges.
- We will initiate programs for rapid upskilling of teachers in Jammu & Kashmir.
- We will undertake focused interventions for girls and EWS students by providing them scholarships, free transportation and hostel facilities especially at higher secondary and college levels.
- We will conduct immediate safety audits of all schools to identify and rectify safety concerns such as

inadequate fencing, and poor sanitation especially for girls.

- We will introduce mindfulness practices, such as meditation and yoga in the school curriculum to help students manage stress, to improve focus and to improve quality of life.
- We will provide scholarships at school and graduate levels for meritorious students, differently abled students and students from the socially-backward classes and economically weaker sections.
- We will establish a National Law University, a National Institute of Technology, regional ITIs, and a sportsinstitute modelled after the National Institute of Sports (NIS).
- We will establish a Tribal University in Rajouri-Poonch region and a Sharda University in Kashmir.
- We will rename SKUAST University, Jammu to Baba Jitto University of Agricultural Sciences and Technology, and upgrade it to Central Agricultural University thereby ensuring quality education for the youth in Jammu & Kashmir.
- We will enact a Private Universities

development, J&K became the first State/UT to devise a comprehensive District Good Governance Index (DGGI) where assessments are made and district-wise rankings are published across 10 sectors & 58 parameters. A system of 100% physical verification & geo-tagging of works with pre & post execution photographs has been constituted in J&K.

The BJP will further ensure the following:

- We will provide targeted additional support to address the grievances of crucial community workers such as Anganwadi Workers, ASHAs, NHM workers, Rehbar-e-Khel employees (ReK), Community Information Centre (CIC) operators, Home Guards and National Youth Corps (NYCs).
- We will address the grievances of long-serving adhoc/contractual/daily wage employees.
- We will conduct a free and fair census,

unlike yesteryears, thereby ensuring proper decision making, focusing on inclusive development, with targeted interventions for marginalised communities.

- We will implement reforms for government employees which will ensure:
 - Reservation in promotion for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes within government services
 - Create a transfer policy for all the employeesspecifically for Scheduled Caste and other employees working in Kashmir Valley.
- We will adopt the new Unified Pension Scheme (UPS) for J&K Government employees, which will offer assured pension, assured family pension, and assured minimum pension.
- We will launch a comprehensive strategy for combating the drug menace in Jammu & Kashmir by:
 - Strengthening law enforcement and security measures by specialised task force



- Increased surveillance coordination with central agencies to enhance intelligence sharing, operational support, and capacity building, and
- Strengthening legal framework and policy implementation.
- We will establish an Anti-Corruption Taskforce and create a web-portal for redressal of corruption complaints directly monitored by the Chief Minister's office.
- We will oversee and monitor all matters related to safeguarding the provisions for marginalised communities in Jammu & Kashmir by strengthening/establishing the following commissions:
 - Mahila Commission
 - Minority Commission which will include minorities of Jammu and Kashmir such as Hindus, Sikhs, Christians, Buddhists
 - SC Commission
 - ST Commission
 - OBC Commission
 - Safai Karamchari Commission.
- We will constitute a District Reorganisation Committee and make provision for the reorganisation of the district as per administrative convenience and requirement.
- We will ensure proper buildings, chambers, and reconciliation centres for lawyers, enhancing their working conditions.
- We will ensure every Government office is fully digitised, up to block levels, in Jammu & Kashmir.
- We will improve working conditions for

doctors by doubling hospital infrastructure, provide protection and safety particularly to female doctors and paramedical staff and ensure that they have the resources needed to provide quality healthcare.

- To ensure timely justice and to improve the overall efficiency of legal system, we will:
 - Recommend increasing the strength of judges Jammu & Kashmir High Court
 - Double the strength of lower judiciary including district and sub-district courts through recruitment of judges, magistrates and support staff
 - Construct new judicial complexes at the district, sub-district, and munsiff levels with modern facilities and adequate space particularly in areas where such infrastructure is lacking.
- We will establish an Integrated Common Tribunal Complex which will house all specialised courts and tribunals such as Administrative Tribunal, National Company Law Tribunal and others to enhance access to justice, reduce the burden on regular courts, and to ensure expert handling of specialised legal matters.
- We will recommend and pursue revisiting the Indus Water Treaty which is a wrong, forced on people of J&K and was one among the many Nehruvian blunders against the people of J&K.
- We will establish a Special Task Force to address the issues of illegal mining and bovine smuggling in Jammu & Kashmir.






Community to protect, safeguard, and defend the rights of the displaced Kashmiri Pandits.

To ensure a dignified living of Kashmir displaced Hindu and Sikh communities during their forced temporary stay outside Kashmir, the monthly sustenance paid to the distressed section in the shape of monthly cash will be reasonably enhanced.

We will ensure that the displaced persons of Jammu division get all the due benefits, security and protection that the displaced persons from Kashmir are given.



Environment And Natural Resources Management



The NDA Government has given a major thrust to forest protection and about 80% forest demarcation records of J&K have been updated and digitised. Further, 41,120 kanals of encroached lands have been cleared. Through the Har Gaon Hariyali programme, 4,290 Gram Panchayats, 80 ULBs and 6,850 villages of Jammu and Kashmir were covered for collective plantation efforts of Forest officials, PRIs and locals at District, Block & Village levels. This has positioned J&K among the top 10 States/UTs with a significant net increase in forest and tree cover.

The BJP will further ensure the following:

- We will implement smart technology in housing projects by incorporating solar energy, rainwater harvesting, and waste management systems, creating sustainable and eco-friendly living environments.
- We will develop and encourage extensive rainwater collection systems, along with constructing and managing water reservoirs, canals, and other critical infrastructure for effective water management.

- We will encourage the cultivation and processing of medicinal and herbal plants, leveraging J&K's rich biodiversity. This initiative aims to create new industries, generate income, and conserve our natural heritage.
- We will develop wind farms in suitable areas of Jammu & Kashmir while capitalising on its massive wind energy potential.
- We will expand the Amrit Sarovar Mission to rejuvenate the lakes in Jammu & Kashmir and construct canals around them to enhance irrigation.
- We will formulate the Van Sanrakshan Scheme and decentralised action plan for forest development and conservation in all districts.
- We promise to conserve wildlife by:
 - Enhancing wildlife conservation in Jammu & Kashmir with advanced research and strengthened antipoaching measures
 - Creating specialised wildlife corridors to reduce human-wildlife interaction.
