



We will ensure 100% coverage of the Kisan Credit Card Scheme to provide short-term agriculture loans to interested farmers.

- We establish will 50 crop-specific Farmer **Organizations** Producer (FPOs) to empower and with farmers encourage improved market access. under the **Central Sector** Scheme.
- We will launch the Mukhya Mantri Farmers' Children Scholarship Program to provide financial support for the graduate and

postgraduate education of children from small and marginal farming families.

Agri Infrastructure

- We will launch the Sikkim Agri-Infra Mission with a corpus of INR 500 Crores to revamp the agricultural infrastructure of Sikkim by:
 - Constructing agri-link roads to facilitate seamless procurement, transportation, and export of agricultural products.
 - Setting up Cold Storage Units in every block.
 - Establishing state-of-the-art Agriculture Markets (APMC) in every district to streamline the marketing of produce.
- Catering to the acute shortage of seed banks in Sikkim, we will establish Community Seed Banks in every block to provide high-yielding organic seeds to the farmers and conserve the local seeds.
- We will establish soil testing laboratories in every district, ensuring farmers can access these facilities easily and conveniently.

We will construct water storage tanks in every village under the Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH).

We will launch the Sikkim Surakshit Khet Yojana to provide subsidies for the installation of solar fencing for agricultural lands.



Cash Crop

- We will offer a Minimum Support Price (MSP) for large cardamom, ginger, turmeric and buckwheat.
- We will construct an Auction Centre in Gangtok for long-lasting crops such as tea, cardamom, turmeric and ginger.
- Under the PM Formalisation of Micro Food Processing Enterprises Scheme, we will provide financial assistance to establish processing units for ginger, turmeric, chilli, and large cardamom.
- We will implement Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana in Sikkim to ensure time-bound disbursal of insurance against crop damage.

We will initiate the Sikkim Buckwheat Promotion Mission to distribute high-yield seeds to farmers and expand cultivation by 2,000 hectares.

Natural Sikkim

Pisciculture

Promoting Allied Activities

We will establish Automatic Milk Processing Plants in every district under the Central Government's Dairy Processing and Infrastructure Development Fund (DIDF).

We will work towards increasing the procurement price of milk produced by members of registered cooperatives under Sikkim Milk Union. Under the National Beekeeping and Honev Mission (NBHM), we will offer beekeeping units and training to women from small marginal and farm households promote to organic honey production.

- We will support the establishment of **Poultry Farms under the National Livestock Mission** to promote self-sufficiency in egg and meat production.
- Under the National Livestock Mission, we will establish Fodder Banks and train farmers to adopt hay-making and silage-making skills to ensure fodder availability during lean periods.
- We will establish feed and fodder manufacturing units to ensure affordable access to livestock feed under the GOBARdhan scheme.
- Under the National Animal Disease Control Programme, we will ensure 100% vaccination of livestock against all major diseases including Lumpy Virus.

- We will develop a **50 bedded Cancer Hospital and Research Centre** with state-of-the-art infrastructure in Sikkim.
- We will ensure timely completion of District Hospitals in Pakyong and Soreng.
- We will upgrade every District Hospital into a multispeciality Hospital with state-of-the-art infrastructures including ICU, NICU, CT Scan, MRI, X-Ray, Endoscopy etc.

for up to 90% lower prices than that of branded medicines in the open market.

- We will ensure availability of free essential medicines and diagnostic services at all government healthcare facilities.
- We will acquire a fleet of ambulances, ensuring the availability of one Basic Life Support (BLS) ambulance for each Primary Health Sub-Centres (PHSCs) and two Advanced Life Support (ALS) ambulances for every District Hospital.
- We will introduce Helicopter Ambulance Service and connect every district with it in consultation with the respective District Magistrates.
 - We will use hi-tech drones to deliver life-saving drugs and essential medical supplies to remote rural areas.



 - Ensuring fees of INR 5,000 for 5 years towards National Permit for trucks.
 - Waiving off the road tax charged as per the cost of the vehicle for 15 years.

Public Transportation and Traffic Management

- We will expand the SNT bus fleet by acquiring new buses including luxury buses to boost rural and inter-state bus connectivity.
- We will invest INR 50 Crores to upgrade the SNT Bus Station in Gangtok with state-of-the-art infrastructure and amenities.
- We will facilitate the construction of inner and outer ring roads in Gangtok and other district headquarters to ensure effective traffic management.
- We will launch an Integrated Traffic Management System in major urban areas to improve traffic flow and reduce congestion through smart technology.
- We will create a Smart Parking System across all the congested spaces in major urban areas in Sikkim by constructing new multi-parking spaces.
- We will work towards establishing foot over bridges (FOBs) at busy intersections in all district headquarters to ease the living of residents and reduce traffic congestion.

- We will introduce a fleet of 50 e-Buses under the Faster Adoption and Manufacturing of Electric Vehicles in India (FAME Phase II) Scheme to connect towns and villages maior with urban areas. ensurina last-mile connectivity in an eco-friendly and sustainable manner.
- We will set up Electric Vehicle Charging Stations for faster adoption and a smooth transition to electric vehicles in each district within the next five years.

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Urban Development

- We will, in collaboration with the Central Government, expedite and complete all projects under the Gangtok and Namchi Smart Cities Mission by undertaking:
 - Improvement & Retrofitting of Pedestrian Sidewalks.
 - Construction of Multi-Level Car Parking.
 - Installation of Public Toilets in Gangtok and Namchi.

- We aim to develop Gangtok as India's first Green Hydrogen smart city.
- We will expedite the construction and upgradation of **Sewage Treatment Plants** in every district using scientific methods.
- We will construct **public toilets** across all urban areas under the **Swacch Bharat Mission - Urban**.
- We will set up a Dump Remediation Plant at Lower Martam, Gangtok and transform the garbage dumping area into a Green Park.
- We will set up Solid Waste processing facilities in every district to ensure 100% Waste Processing and effective solid waste management.
- We will ensure clean and garbage-free jhoras and drains across all major towns and urban areas.
- We will initiate the **Connect Sikkim Mission** in collaboration with the **Digital India Initiative** to achieve 100% internet penetration and boost digital accessibility by:
 - Launching 5G services and high-speed internet in major urban and rural areas.
 - Oreating free public WiFi hotspots.

We will work towards converting overhead and hanging electric cables to underground in cables major Gangtok and other urban areas in a phased manner.

Rural Development

- We will collaborate with the Central Government under the Vibrant Villages Programme to ensure the holistic infrastructural development of border villages.
- We will ensure proper connectivity of every village to an all-weather pucca road.
- We will establish Multipurpose Community Halls in every Gram Panchayat to organise community events.
- Under the Bharat Net Project, we will ensure 100% coverage of high-speed broadband internet connectivity in all Gram Panchayats.
- We will ensure the integration of GIS data into the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana to facilitate the mapping of development activities across all blocks.

Basic Amenities

- We will ensure affordable housing to all eligible beneficiaries under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana Gramin and Urban by 2025.
- We will ensure 100% tap water connections in all households and review all ongoing projects under the Jal Jeevan Mission.
- We will work towards providing adequate water supply including clean drinking water in Gangtok and other water stressed areas.
- Under the PM Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana, we will encourage households to install rooftop solar electricity units by providing up to 300 units of free electricity every month.
- We will invest INR 100 Crores to promote the adoption and usage of Rooftop Rainwater Harvesting Systems in all urban and rural areas.
- We will collaborate with the Central Government to explore the feasibility of providing Piped Natural Gas (PNG) connections.





- We will explore the feasibility of constructing protective retaining walls on river banks to ensure safety of citizens during natural disasters like flash floods.




Forest and Environment

- We will set up Pro-bono Legal Clinics in every district to provide free legal counselling and advisory services to marginalised sections.

















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
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
