'TODAY THERE IS A WAVE OF DEVELOPMENT AND TRUST IN ASSAM'

P rime Minister Shri Narendra Modi on March 18, 2021 addressed a massive public meeting at Karimganj in Assam. He said, "Today, there is a wave of development, a wave of confidence in Assam. Today, Assam believes in peace, trusts in prosperity. Today, there is only one issue in Assam - development, continuous development and development of all."

"In 2016, when I came here, I was shocked to know that Congress governments ran Divisional Commissioner for Barak Valley from Guwahati. NDA government has overcome this injustice," PM Shri Modi added.

Hitting out at the Congress-led government, he said, "Congress governments and their policies have damaged Assam socially, culturally, geographically and politically, in every way. Decades ago, this entire region was one that had better connectivity. However, Congress' corruption and vote-bank-based governance made Assam one of the most disconnected states in India."

Addressing the massive rally, PM Shri Modi asked, "Who completed the construction of India's longest bridge- Bhupen Hazarika Setu, stuck for years? It was BJP government. Who is constructing even bigger Dhubri-Phulbari Bridge to connect Assam

with Meghalaya? It is BJP government. Who gave the country's longest river ropeway to Assam? It is the BJP government."

The Prime Minister's speech focused on the BJP's development work in the state, the PM stated, "NDA government's work in Assam is praised by tourists as well. The widening of railway tracks was done on mission mode, and big trains are also reaching here. The number of trains has doubled reaching this region in the last few years. We are trying to develop a multimodal logistic park in Silchar to transform this region into a hub of import-export. This will provide a lot of employment opportunities to the youth and economic opportunities to the farmers."

He asserted, "Thousands of rupees are being given to pregnant women working in tea plantation, so that they can take care of themselves and children's health. Recently, the central government has made a special provision of Rs 1000 crore for the associates working in the tea garden in the union budget. here are many possibilities of fisheries in Barak Valley."

"Our double engine government is giving a lot of encouragement to the fisheries business. Therefore, a separate Ministry of Fisheries has been created at the Center," he added.

LIVE UP TO 'SONAR BANGLA' DREAM

Addressing a massive gathering on March 18, 2021 at Purulia in West Bengal, PM Shri Narendra Modi said, "This land is a witness to Lord Ram and Goddess Sita's exile. This land has Sitakund. It is also said that when goddess Sita was thirsty, Lord Ram got water from the ground by hitting it with an arrow. It is an irony that Purulia faces water crisis today."

He said, "Left Front and TMC governments have not done enough for irrigation in Purulia. These people have given Purulia a life riddled with water crisis. They have given Purulia, migration. They have given the poor of Purulia, discriminatory governance. BJP government in Bengal will address issues of water and connectivity in Purulia on priority."

"I know the problems faced in rearing livestock due to less water. TMC government was busy in its 'khel' by leaving farming on its own. First the Left government and then TMC government didn't let industries develop here. Purulia ranks among the backward regions due to lackadaisical attitude of TMC government," he added.



Playing on Mamata Banerjee's slogan – 'Khela Hobe', Prime Minister Shri Modi, in Purulia, said, "Didi bole 'khela hobe', BJP bole 'chaakri hobe'. Didi bole khela hobe, BJP bole 'vikas hobe'. Didi bole 'khela hobe', BJP bole 'shiksha hobe'.... 'Khela shesh hobe, vikas aarambh hobe'."

Launching an attack against the TMC government, he asserted, "West Bengal can only develop when all sectors come together. Mamata didi, however, never brought together the dalits, tribals, SCs/STs and other such classes. Centre has stressed on education, health and income generation of tribal people."

Continuing the attack at Mamata Government, Prime Minister Shri Modi remarked, "The central

government's policy of the BJP is DBT- i.e. 'Direct Benefit Transfer' while TMC means 'transfer my commission'. TMC extortionists do not even spare ration for the poor that Centre provides. TMC has created a new breed of Maoists in Bengal who loot public money. Countdown has begun for the exit of TMC. The violence, mafia raj, atrocities will not be allowed now."

"I can assure you, action will be taken against every criminal after BJP forms government on May 02. We will have to live up to the 'Sonar Bangla' dream of Gurudev Rabindranath Tagore, Netaji and Vivekananda. On May 2 Didi jachhe, asol paribarton asche," PM Shri Modi said while urging to vote for the BJP in upcoming assembly elections. ■

The PM took a swipe at the Congress-Left alliance and stated, "Today the Congress has become so weak that it can go to any extent, can join hands with anyone. The whole country is seeing this strange situation today. In Kerala Left and Congress are wrestling against each other and in West Bengal Congress is doing Lal Salam with Communists."

Talking about the development in the North-east region, PM Shri Narendra Modi asserted, "For the BJP government, country's interest has always been

paramount, development of the country has been the priority. For decades, the BJP governments have been improving the way Northeast was ignored in development. We are making the Northeast the main center of development for the country."

"Your vote this time is to be vocal to the local talent of Assam, to local art, to local goods. This time your vote is to make Assam - Aatmanirbhar," he said while urging the people of Assam to vote for BJP once again. ■

BJP NATIONAL PRESIDENT'S RALLIES IN ASSAM

DHAKUAKHANA RALLY

Addressing a huge public rally in Dhakuakhana, Assam BJP National President Shri JP Nadda on 15 March, 2021 said the Congress can provide only “corruption guarantee” wherever it comes to power though it has promised five-guarantees in the poll-bound state of Assam.

Many Congress leaders are now coming to Assam and talking about the five guarantees, Shri Nadda said at the election rally. “For 60 years, Congress leaders only indulged in corruption and so for the last five years, we had to fill up pot-holes, repair roads and convert double lane highways to four and six-lanes”, the BJP President said.

It is the BJP which has a mission and the “Congress is only interested in commission”, the BJP President said. He also accused the Congress of “latkana” (delaying), “atkana” (stalling) and “bhatkana” (misleading) but Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi believes in “jodna” (integrating).

“It is Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi who through his initiatives has joined Assam and the Northeast with Mainstream India”, Shri Nadda said.

Assam has moved ahead along the path of development due to the efforts of the Prime Minister which Shri Sarbananda Sonowal-led BJP government in Assam has executed in the state. “The people of the state has the responsibility of electing BJP candidate Nabakumar Doley from this seat on March 27 and we assure you that the government will complete all pending works in the next five years”, he said.

PROVIDE 'CORRUPTION COMES TO POWER: JP NADDA

BJP NATIONAL PRESIDENT SHRI JP NADDA HELD SEVERAL PUBLIC RALLIES FOR THE UPCOMING ASSAM ASSEMBLY ELECTIONS. HE REACHED LILABARI AIRPORT IN ASSAM AND ADDRESSED A PUBLIC RALLY AT HS FIELD, JAMUGURIHAT SOOTEA. SHRI NADDA ADDRESSED THE THIRD RALLY AT HS FIELD. The BJP President asked people attending the rally whether they wanted a guarantee of scams or a guarantee of development. Shri Nadda said, as he reiterated Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi's mission of a 'Congress Mukta Bharat' (Congress-free India), the BJP was moving forward with this mission adding one or two states were left and they would be covered soon.

BORBHAGIYA RALLY

'WHILE CONGRESS PRACTICED ONLY CORRUPTION, THE BJP DID DEVELOPMENT WORK'

BJP National President Shri JP Nadda lashed out against the alliance between the Congress and the AIUDF, a party led by Badruddin Ajmal. "In 2006, Tarun Gogoi used to say 'Who is Badruddin?' And today, what is Congress saying, 'My brother', 'My



friend',” said Shri Nadda. His reference was to an oft-quoted comment by former Assam CM Gogoi, “Who’s Badruddin?”

“Kerala is also going to polls at the same time. There the Congress is fighting against the Communists. In West Bengal too elections are happening, but here they are embracing the CPI(M). And in Assam they are embracing the AIUDF... waah re waah milan, satta bhi doston kya cheez hoti hai, niyat ko bhi paar kar jaati hai,” he said.



He said while the Congress practiced only corruption, the BJP did development work. He said Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has united Assam and the Northeast with the rest of the country. ■

'POLITICS OF APPEASEMENT REACHED TO A NEW LEVEL IN WEST BENGAL'

Bhartiya Janata Party National President Shri Jagat Prakash Nadda addressed a huge rally and flagged off Babasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar Samman Yatra in Kotulpur, West Bengal on March 16, 2021 and urged the people of West Bengal to uproot the Trinamool Congress government, which is doing politics of corruption, appeasement and violence. He called for the formation of a Bharatiya Janata Party government with an absolute majority. Earlier in the day, National President held a grand road show from Kumari Talkies Cinema Hall to Bishnupur Bus Stand in Bishnupur (West Bengal). Pointing out the huge crowd at the road show, the BJP President said that change is certain in West Bengal.

In his address Shri Nadda said that Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi's affection for West Bengal is not hidden from anyone. He has opened the treasury of the country for the development of West Bengal, but Mamata Banerjee's Trinamool government does not allow central schemes to be implemented in the state. The Prime Minister has made a meaningful effort to bring positive changes in the lives of the villages, poor and farmers of the country which is visible on the ground, be it Swachh Bharat Yojana, Jan Dhan Yojana, Saubhagya Yojana, social security schemes, Ayushman Bharat or Prime Minister Kisan Samman Nidhi. But, I am pained to tell you that the poor of West



Bengal are still deprived of taking advantage of the Ayushman Bharat scheme, the farmers here have not been able to get the benefit of the Kisan Samman Nidhi because the anti-farmer Mamta Banerjee government is standing in the way of these schemes.

National President said that around 130 Bharatiya Janata Party workers in West Bengal were victims of the Trinamool Congress political violence under Mamata Didi's rule. Did our workers not have mothers, wives and daughters? Have you ever worried about those mothers? The people of West Bengal are going to take account of your misadventure. Instead of 'Maa, Mati, Manush', you started the politics of dictatorship, manipulation and appeasement. Mamta Didi stopped the immersion of Durga Puja, the cultural heritage of West Bengal, and did not allow Saraswati Puja for five years. Mamata didi lifted the curfew in Muharram but imposed curfew on the day of foundation stone of the grand temple of Ramlala in Ayodhya. Mamta didi, now your

appeasement politics will not work. The people of West Bengal have turned against it.

Shri Nadda said that the politics of appeasement in West Bengal reached to such a level that a large number of minorities were also added to the OBC reservation, but Mamta Didi deprived the OBC of Mahisya and Teli cast from the benefit of reservation. But after forming BJP government in Bengal a commission will be formed and the Mahisas and Teli castes deprived of the benefits of reservation will also be included in this category.

He further added that the current government under which the atrocities on people belonging to the scheduled castes has increased alarmingly in last 10 years.

Hailing the people of West Bengal, Shri Nadda said that if you have to get rid of Tolabazi, appeasement and corruption and want a fear-free Bengal, then you must support BJP. The people of West Bengal should give a chance to Bharatiya Janata Party. ■

Ahead of West Bengal polls, PM Shri Narendra Modi on March 21, 2021 addressed a massive public meeting in Bankura, West Bengal. Impressed by the huge turnout at the rally, the PM said, "The picture of Bankura witness that people of Bengal have decided on May 2, 'Didi jacche, Ashol Poriborton ashche, Ashol Poriborton ashche'. BJP will bring the Ashol Poriborton in Bengal - to increase the pride of Bengal. Ashol Poriborton - to bring a government in Bengal that serves the poor and removes their problems."

Hitting out at Mamata Banerjee, PM Shri Modi said, "The game of Corruption - Cholbe naa, the game of

Slamming the Left, Congress and the TMC for taking Bengal backwards, he asserted, "Congress, Left and TMC are all to be blamed for development eluding Bengal. All there have wasted a lot of time of your previous generations. I can't let your futures be ruined. I call upon the first time voters to vote and make the dream of Sonar Bangla come true."

The PM slammed TMC government for not doing enough to reach piped water to people. He said, "Jal Jeevan Mission, Ayushman Bharat and other central

Taking a jibe at the TMC for his graffiti, PM said, "I have seen graffiti humiliating me made by Didi's partymen on walls wherein she is hitting my head with her foot and playing football. Didi, you can kick me. But I won't allow you to kick away the development of Bengal and people's dreams."

Addressing the massive gathering, the Prime Minister accused Mamata Didi for making hollow announcements in the last 10 years, he said, "Didi, you have only made empty promises in the last 10 years, where is the work you claim to have done? You keep saying 'Khela Hobe'

schemes will be taken up in priority once BJP government comes to power." "Terracota art from Bankura-Bishnupur region can play a major role in the Aatmanirbhar Bharat dream," he added.

Asserting that BJP works to schemes, TMC plays by scams, he stated, "All central schemes that were to be delivered through the state government have ended up in scams. Bengal farmers have been deprived of Rs 14,000 that was delivered to accounts of farmers all across India."

The PM remarked, "The more I question Didi, the angrier she gets. Now she says that she doesn't like my face. Didi, in democracy, it is the public service and not the face which is put to test. Under the NDA government, the Prime Minister said the NDA government saved the rhinos of the state that the earlier Congress-led government failed to do. The NDA government has put the rhino hunters in jails. We are working on both safety of animals as well as facilities for the people of Assam.

"All our sanctuaries, including Kaziranga, are our heritage, our responsibility towards the environment and also the means of livelihood. I am happy that the forest area in Assam has increased in the last 5 years," he added.

Listing developmental schemes undertaken in Assam, PM Shri Modi shared that in the last 5 years, Assam had witnessed a growth in forest cover. It increased the opportunities for tourism and economic activities. We wanted India to be included in one of the leading nations in natural, spiritual, cultural and heritage tourisms, and Assam has all of this.

"More than 90 years ago, the British had made a law and put Bamboo in the category of trees. This law prohibited the transportation and cutting of bamboo



grown on private land. Even after independence, this law existed for 70 years. Because of this, farmers, traders, bamboo industries had to face many problems. Our government understood your problems and changed this law. Its huge benefit has been to the people associated with the Bamboo Craft in Assam, to the farmers, to the entrepreneurs," PM Shri Modi shared.

UNDER CONGRESS THERE WAS DOUBLE NEGLIGENCE & DOUBLE CORRUPTION

"When Congress was in power at the Centre and in Assam, there was double negligence and double corruption."

Hitting out at the opposition, PM Shri Modi stated, "In Congress Raj, the question was how to increase the connectivity between the two sides of the Brahmaputra? Modern bridges are being built on the Brahmaputra during the period of NDA, old incomplete bridges are being completed."

- We will establish a task force that will look into removing the encroachments on the worshipping area of tribals. Every Namghar in the state will be given financial assistance of Rs 2.50 lakh to strengthen them.
- Under the mission, Sishu Unayan, every child will get education free of cost in state government education institutions. Besides, children from Class Eight and above will be given a bicycle.
- The BJP government in Assam will properly implement the NRC so that the citizenship rights of the people of Assam are ensured and illegal immigrants are dealt with sternly.
- To protect the political interests of Assam, we will conduct a delimitation exercise in the state. We will pride land to all the landless people in the state and will also empower them.

- A sports university will be established in the state.
- An anti-corruption helpline will be started under the CMO to end syndicate, counterfeiting and cut money.
- Special Task Force will be set up against coal mafia, sand mafia, water tanker mafia, job recruitment scam, communal violence, illegal arms smuggling, drug trade, forced land conversion, fake currency and cow smuggling.
- SIT will be set up to investigate all the mega scams, political killings and Rs. 25 lakh will be given for rehabilitation of victims of political violence.
- Will completely stop cross-border infiltration.
- Every family will be given Pucca houses. Free electricity will be provided for domestic consumption up to 200 units and ensured supply of 24x7 power will be ensured in homes.
- Saraswati and Durga Puja will be celebrated throughout the state without any fear or restriction.
- Annapurna Canteen will be set up in West Bengal to provide nutritious food for only five rupees three times a day.
- Under the subsidy ration, PDS beneficiaries will be provided rice or wheat at 1 per kg, pulses at Rs. 30 per kg, salt at Rs. 3 per kg and sugar at Rs. 5 per kg.
- The Citizenship Amendment Act. will be implemented.
- SC / ST caste certificate will be given without any corruption.
- The Seventh Pay Commission will be implemented in the first cabinet meeting itself.
- Free electricity will be supplied for use up to 200 units for domestic consumption and 24x7 power will be supplied to the houses in the city.
- 500 crores will be given to get the prestigious UNESCO Heritage City tag for Kolkata. 10 smog towers will be installed in the city to combat air pollution. 1,500 crore will be spent for the Clean Kolkata Mission.
- A fund of Rs. 500 crore will be created for flood prevention and its master plan for its management in Bengal. ■

50 LAKH JOBS IN BJP MANIFESTO FOR TAMIL NADU

- Legislative council will be set up to facilitate informed debates on topics by subject matter experts.
- Badugas will be added to the Scheduled Tribe category.
- All state highways will be converted into four-lane roads.
- Every district will have coaching centers for National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test (NEET), Joint Entrance Examination (JEE) and Common Law Admission Test (CLAT).
- Online skill Development University will be set up.
- A Circuit Bench of the Madras High Court will be established in Coimbatore.
- Law will be brought against forced religious conversions.
- Siddha Medicine University will be established in Palani.
- Thirukkural Mamalai Park will be established in Erode district.

Earlier, a day before the BJP also criticized the DMK of deceiving the people of Tamil Nadu had released a 'charge sheet' against the MK Stalin-led DMK party, listing out 100 reasons to reject the DMK-led combine in the April 06 assembly elections.

The BJP is contesting in 20 assembly seats as part of the AIADMK-led alliance in the state. It has also been allotted the Kanyakumari Lok Sabha seat where a by poll is being held. ■

17 STATES IMPLEMENT 'ONE NATION ONE RATION CARD'

Seventeen (17) States have successfully operationalised "One Nation One Ration Card system" with Uttarakhand being the latest State to complete the reform.

States completing 'One Nation One Ration Card' system reform are eligible for additional borrowing of 0.25 percent of Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP). Accordingly, these States have been granted additional borrowing permission of Rs. 37,600 crore by the Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance.

'One Nation One Ration Card' scheme is an

important citizen centric reform. Its implementation ensures availability of ration to beneficiaries under National Food Security Act (NFSA) and other welfare schemes, especially the migrant workers and their families, at any Fair Price Shop (FPS) across the country. Those 17 states which executed 'One Nation One Ration Card' System successfully are Andhra Pradesh, Goa, Gujarat, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Manipur, Odisha, Punjab, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, Tripura, Uttarakhand and Uttar Pradesh. ■

MAJOR REFORMS IMPLEMENTED TO BOOST DOMESTIC MANUFACTURING

The Government has implemented major reforms in the last one year to boost domestic manufacturing, industrial production and GDP growth. Production-Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme in 13 key sectors, under the aegis of AatmaNirbhar Bharat, have been announced for enhancing India's manufacturing capabilities and exports. PLI Schemes for medical devices; mobile phones; electronic components; pharmaceutical drugs; telecom and network equipment; and electronic technology products have been notified. Empowered Group of Secretaries (EGoS) and Project Development Cells (PDCs) have been set up in the Ministries/Departments to facilitate and promote investment.

A Single Window System involving clearances by Ministries / Departments and selected State Governments is on the anvil to provide end-to-end facilitation support. In the Union Budget 2021-

22 with a view to promote domestic manufacturing, announcements have been made on setting up seven Mega Investment Textiles Parks(MITRA) over the next 3 years with plug-and-play facilities, rationalization of customs duty structure across sectors and for a Scrapage Policy to phase out old and unfit commercial vehicles. The National Infrastructure Pipeline is expected to significantly boost infrastructure and spur growth impulses in the economy. Reduction in the compliance burden is an ongoing process to spur investment and enhance ease of doing business in India

To boost domestic manufacturing, Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade has taken a number of measures including setting up of world class infrastructure by developing nodes across various Industrial Corridors; formulation of National Master Plan on multimodal connectivity infrastructure;



implementation of Industrial development schemes for North-East States, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, and Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir to boost industrialization in the industrially backward and hilly States; for start ups, setting up a Fund of Funds and Seed Fund to build up a strong ecosystem for nurturing innovation and entrepreneurship; Development of industrial information system for improving availability of industrial land and amendment in Public Procurement Rules to enhance minimum local content.

This information was given by the Minister of State in the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Shri SomParkash, in a written reply in the Lok Sabha on March 10. ■

INDIA'S ARMS IMPORTS DECREASE BY OVER 33 PER CENT

India's arms imports have decreased by over 33 per cent between 2011–15 and 2016–20, the latest 'Trends in International Arms Transfers' report released on March 15 by Stockholm International Peace Research Institute (SIPRI) stated. According to the report, India's imports of US arms also fell by 46 per cent. At the same time, Russia's arms exports to India also came down by 53 per cent. In the last few years, India with the pledge of 'Atma Nirbhar Bharat'

has taken a series of measures to boost domestic defence industry with an aim to reduce dependence



on imported military platforms and hardware, Defence Minister Shri

Rajnath Singh in a statement on February 5, 2021 had announced at the Aero India 2021's Bandhan – partnership signing ceremony that India planned to bring down defence imports by \$2 billion by the end of 2022. He had said, the idea of cutting down on imports is to encourage domestic manufacture of defence related items. Between 2016 and 2019, 138 proposals worth over \$37 billion have been approved for domestic manufacturing and they will pay off now in lower imports. ■

INDIA EXPORTS 3000 HP CAPE GAUGE LOCOMOTIVE TO MOZAMBIQUE

The Union Minister of Railways, Commerce & Industry and Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution, Shri Piyush Goyal on March 10 flagged off 3000 HP Cape Gauge Locomotive indigenously developed by Banaras Locomotive Works, Varanasi via video conferencing along with Minister of Transport and Communications, Government of Mozambique, Shri Janfar Abdulai, Union Minister of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, Dr. Mahendra Nath Pandey and other dignitaries who were present at the event site.

The export of locomotives to Mozambique shall boost the Indo-African relationship and pilot the economic empowerment through export. Indian Railways is exporting first batch of 2 locomotives as part of total order of 6 locomotives of 3000 HP cape gauge locomotive and 90 stainless steel passenger coaches to Mozambique. These locomotives are developed indigenously by Banaras Locomotive Works under Make-in-India, they are being exported through Indian Railways' PSU, Rites Limited. In spirit of Atmanirbhar Bharat, these Cape Gauge Diesel Locos have been designed in India, Made in India

and financed by India.

Speaking on the occasion, Minister Shri Piyush Goyal said that under the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi ji's visionary leadership & his commitment to further strengthen African-Indian relations, we will work as Mozambique's trusted partner. TELEMEDICINE SERVICE COMPLETES 3 MILLION CONSULTATIONS

DAILY OVER 35,000 PATIENTS USE E-SANJEEVANI TO SEEK HEALTH SERVICES REMOTELY

Govt. of India's National Telemedicine Service – eSanjeevani has crossed another milestone by completing 3 million (30 lakh) consultations. Currently, the National Telemedicine Service is operational in 31 States/Union Territories and daily over 35,000 patients across the country are using this innovative digital medium – eSanjeevani, to seek health services.

The National Telemedicine Service, set up by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare comprises of two variants of eSanjeevani namely - doctor to doctor (eSanjeevani AB-HWC) telemedicine platform that is based on hub and spoke model and patient to doctor telemedicine platform (eSanjeevaniOPD) which provides outpatient services to the citizens in the confines of their homes. eSanjeevaniAB-HWC is being implemented at Health & Wellness Centres under Ayushman Bharat Scheme, and by December 2022 it will be made operational at 1,55,000 Health & Wellness Centres across India. It was rolled out in November 2019 and Andhra Pradesh was the first State to roll out eSanjeevaniAB-HWC services. Since its roll out over 1000 hubs and around 15000 spokes have been set up in various States. eSanjeevani AB-HWC has completed around 900,000 consultations.

eSanjeevaniOPD provides digital health services to the citizens through more than 250 online OPDs



set up on eSanjeevaniOPD. Over 220 of these onlineOPDs are specialist OPDs and the rest are general OPDs. eSanjeevaniOPD was rolled out on 13th of April 2020 during the first lockdown in the country when all the OPDs were closed. So far, over 21,00,000 patients have been served through eSanjeevaniOPD.

In a short span of time Govt. of India's National Telemedicine Service has started aiding the Indian healthcare delivery system by plugging the digital health divide that exists in urban and rural India. It is also addressing the shortage of doctors and specialists at ground level while reducing the burden on secondary and tertiary level hospitals. In line with the National Digital Health Mission eSanjeevani is also boosting digital health ecosystem in the country. ■

49.87 CRORE PEOPLE HAD HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE (EXCLUDING PERSONAL ACCIDENT & TRAVEL BUSINESS) IN FY 2019-20

Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI) has informed that the total number of lives covered under health insurance business (excluding Personal Accident & Travel Business) in Financial Year 2019-20 was 49.87 crore. This was stated by Shri Anurag Singh Thakur, Union Minister of State for Finance & Corporate Affairs, in a written reply to a question in Lok Sabha on March 15.

The Minister stated that IRDAI has further informed that the total number of lives covered under health insurance business (excluding Personal Accident & Travel Business) from 1.4.2020 to 30.9.2020 has been 30.22 crore (provisional data) as compared to 17.83 crore for the period from 1.4.2019 to 30.9.2019 showing a growth of 69.8%. In general, there has been no abnormal increase in health insurance premium during the pandemic, the Minister stated. ■

CABINET APPROVES CREATION OF PRADHAN MANTRI SWASTHYA SURAKSHA NIDHI

The Union Cabinet, chaired by the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi on March 13 approved the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Nidhi (PMSSN) as a single non-lapsable reserve fund for share of Health from the proceeds of Health and Education Cess levied under Section 136-b of Finance Act, 2007.

SALIENT FEATURES OF THE PMSSN

- A non-lapsable reserve fund for Health in the Public Account;
- Proceeds of share of health in the Health and Education Cess will be credited into PMSSN;
- Accruals into the PMSSN will be utilized for the flagship schemes of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare namely,
- Ayushman Bharat - Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY)
- Ayushman Bharat - Health and Wellness Centres (AB-HWCs)
- National Health Mission
- Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY)
- Emergency & disaster preparedness and responses during health emergencies
- Any future programme/scheme that targets to achieve progress towards SDGs and the targets set out in the National Health Policy (NHP) 2017.
- Administration and maintenance of the PMSSN is entrusted to Ministry of Health & Family Welfare.
- In any financial year, the expenditure on such schemes of the MoHFW would be initially incurred from the PMSSN and thereafter, from Gross Budgetary Support (GBS).

BENEFITS:

The major benefit will be enhanced access to universal & affordable health care through availability of earmarked resources, while ensuring that the amount does not lapse at the end of financial year. ■

RS PASSES MEDICAL TERMINATION OF PREGNANCY BILL, 2021 FOR SAFETY AND WELL-BEING OF WOMEN

The Rajya Sabha has approved the Medical Termination of Pregnancy (Amendment) Bill, 2021 to amend the Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act, 1971 on 16th March 2021. The Bill was approved in Lok Sabha on 17th March 2020.

Enhancing the upper gestation limit from 20 to 24 weeks for special categories of women which will be defined in the amendments to the MTP Rules and would include survivors of rape, victims of incest and other vulnerable women (like differently-abled women, minors) etc.

Opinion of only one provider will be required up to 20 weeks of gestation and of two providers for termination of pregnancy of 20-24 weeks of gestation.

Upper gestation limit not to apply in cases of substantial foetal abnormalities diagnosed by Medical Board. The composition, functions and other details of Medical Board to be prescribed subsequently in Rules under the Act.

The Medical Termination of Pregnancy (Amendment) Bill, 2021 is for expanding access of women to safe and legal abortion services on therapeutic, eugenic, humanitarian or social grounds. The amendments include substitution of certain sub-sections, insertion of certain new clauses under some sections in the existing Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act, 1971, with a view to increase upper gestation limit for termination of pregnancy under certain conditions and to strengthen access to comprehensive abortion care, under strict conditions, without compromising service and quality of safe abortion.

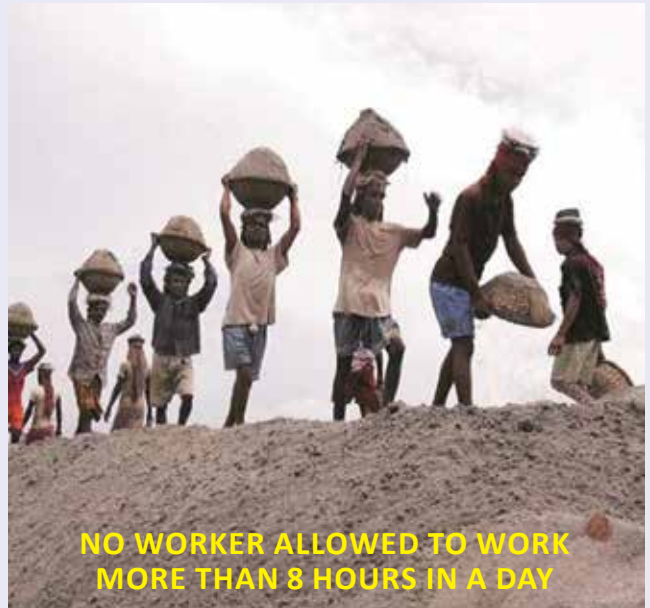
It is a step towards safety and well-being of the women and many women will be benefitted by this. Recently several petitions were received by the Courts seeking permission for aborting pregnancies at a gestational age beyond the present permissible limit on grounds of foetal abnormalities or pregnancies due to sexual violence faced by women. The amendments will increase the ambit and access of women to safe abortion services and will ensure dignity, autonomy, confidentiality and justice for women who need to terminate pregnancy. ■

GOVT. TO DEVELOP NATIONAL DATABASE OF UNORGANISED WORKERS

The Ministry of Labour and employment proposes to develop National Database of Unorganised Workers (NDUW), which will be a comprehensive data base of the Unorganised Workers including the Building and other Construction Workers and Migrant workers, seeded with Aadhaar. It will have details of name, occupation, address, occupation type, educational qualification, skill types & family details etc. for optimum realization of their employability and extend the benefits of the social security schemes to them. The details of schemes/ programme implemented by Government for welfare of unskilled and skilled migrant labourers in the country inter-alia include such as; Garib Kalyan Rojgar Abhiyan, Pradhan Mantri SVANIDHI Scheme, Aatm Nirbhar Bharat, Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Yojana, One Nation One Ration Card, financial assistance to Building and Other Construction workers etc.

'Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA)' is a universal education programme, Government of India to provide free and compulsory education to the children of 6-14 years age group under Right to Education, which is accessible to the children of inter-state migrant workers as well. In addition, Ministry of Minority Affairs, Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Ministry of Labour & Employment, Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Department of School Education & Literacy and some other Ministries provide scholarships to different target groups of students including children of Migrant workers. All these scholarships are coordinated through National Scholarship Portal. In order to safeguard the interest of the migrant workers, the Central Government had enacted the Inter-state Migrant Workmen (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Act, 1979. This Act has now been subsumed in the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020 and the Code has been notified on 29.09.2020. The above mentioned code commonly known as OSH Code, provides for decent working conditions, minimum wages, grievances redressal mechanisms, protection from abuse and exploitation, enhancement of the skills and social security to all category of organised and unorganised workers including Migrant workers. ■

OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY, HEALTH AND WORKING CONDITIONS CODE, 2020 FOR WORKERS WILL COME INTO FORCE



The Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions (OSHW&C) Code, 2020, has provisions for safety, health and working conditions of workers which include daily and weekly working hours, leave etc. The OSHW&C Code, 2020 has been published on 29th September, 2020 and will come into force on the date as notified by the Central Government.

The OSHW&C Code, 2020 and draft Rules framed thereunder provide that no worker shall be required or allowed to work, in any establishment or class of establishments for more than eight hours in a day or forty eight hours in a week.

Ministry of Labour and Employment has received the draft Ordinances/Bills from different State Governments through Ministry of Home Affairs regarding amendment in the existing provisions of the Factories Act, 1948 including extension of working hours under the Factories Act, 1948. This Ministry has not agreed to extend the working hours.

This information was given by Minister of State (I/C) for Labour & Employment Shri Santosh Kumar Gangwar in a written reply in Rajya Sabha on March 17. ■

“INTEGRAL HUMANISM”

I am asked to present my thoughts on the subject of “Integral Humanism” in a series of talks beginning this evening. Last January at Vijayavada, Bharatiya Jana Sangh adopted the statement of “Principles & Policies” in which ‘Integral Humanism’ have also been accepted. There has been scattered discussions here and there on the subject. It is necessary that we consider Integral Humanism in all its aspects. So long as the country was under the yoke of the British rule, all the movements and policies in the country had one principal ‘aim to drive out the foreign rulers and to achieve independence’. But what would be the face of the new Bharat after independence? In which direction were we to advance? These questions were precisely thought out. It would not be correct to say that no thought was devoted to these aspects. There were people who even at that time had considered these questions. Gandhiji himself had set out his idea of the independent Bharat in his book “Hind Swaraj”. Prior to this Lokmanya Tilak discussed the philosophical basis of the rejuvenation of Bharat in his book ‘Gita Rahasya’. He gave a comparative discussion of various schools of thought current all over the world at that time.

Apart from these, the Congress and other political parties adopted various resolutions from time to

time which contain references to this subject. However the subject requires much more serious study than was devoted to it at that time. It did not attract serious attention at that time because every one believed it was more important to think of ways to drive out the British and the other things could be discussed later on. It did not seem right to waste time in internal discussions while the foreign rule continued. Hence even if there might



have been difference in views, they were shelved for the time being.

As a result, even those who held the view that socialism should be the basis of the future Bharat, worked inside the Congress as a socialist group. They did attempt to form as a separate party as such.

The revolutionaries too, were working for independence in their own way. All agreed, however, that the foremost task was to gain

independence.

Having attained. Independence, the question naturally ought to have occurred to us, “Now that we are independent, what shall be the direction of our progress?” But it is amazing that serious thought has not been given to this question and today even after seventeen years of independence we cannot say that a definite direction has been decided upon.

WHITHER BHARAT

From time to time, Congressmen or others have declared Welfare State, Socialism, Liberalism etc. as their aims. Slogans have been raised. But this ideology and slogans attached little significance to the philosophies, apart from the slogans. I am saying this on the basis of personal discussions. A leading gentleman once suggested during a conversation that a joint front should be formed against Congress, whereby a good fight can be given. Now a days political parties adopt this strategy. So, it was not surprising to put forward this suggestion. However, naturally, I asked, “What programme shall we adopt? If such a joint front is formed some idea of the programme is essential. What will be out economic policy? What will our foreign policy? These questions should also be broadly tackled.”

“Do not worry about it.

Whatever you like you can adopt. We are ready to support, anything from extreme Marxist to downright capitalist program.” The reply came as if this was natural. He had no difficulty in adopting any programme. The only object was somehow Congress should be defeated. Even now some declare that Congress must be defeated even with the cooperation of communists and all the rest.

Recently elections were held in Kerala. During the elections, Communists, Muslim League, Swatantra Party, S.S.P. Rebel Congress known as Kerala Congress, Revolutionary Socialist Party etc. entered into a variety of bilateral of multiple alliances. As a result, it was difficult to imagine that any of these parties had a definite ideology, principles and aims. This is the situation as far as principles are concerned.

Congress too, is in a similar state. Even though the Congress has proclaimed democratic socialism as its goal, the behaviour of various Congress leaders shows one thing clearly that there are no definite principles, no single direction in Congress. There are staunch communists in Congress fold. There are also those who have faith in, Capitalism and oppose communism to the teeth. All brands of people are arrayed on Congress platform. If there can be a magic box which contains a cobra and a mangoose living together, it is Congress.

We must ponder whether we can progress under such conditions. If we stop to analyze

the reasons for the problems facing the country we will find that the confusion about our goal and the direction is mainly responsible for the chaos. I realize that all the 450 million people of Bharat cannot agree on all or even on a single question. That is not possible in any country. Yet there is generally, what is called a more or less common desire of the people of any nation. If this popular longing is made the basis of our aims, the common man feels that the nation is moving in a proper direction, and that his own aspiration is reflected in the efforts

of the nation. This also generates the greatest possible feeling of unity. The truth of the statement is borne out by the response of the people during the Chinese Invasion of October/November 1962. A wave of enthusiasm swept across the country. Action and sacrifice both obtained in abundance. There was no barrier between the government and the public or between various political parties. How did this happen? The external threat made us recognize ourselves. The government adopted that policy which

reflected the widespread feeling in the people and which enhanced their sense of self-respect with a call for sacrifice. The result was we stood united.

THE ROOT OF OUR PROBLEMS-NEGLECT OF SELF

It is essential that we think about our national identity. Without this identity there is no meaning. Of neither independence, nor can independence become the instrument of progress and happiness. As long as we are unaware of our national identity, we cannot recognize and develop all our potentialities. Under alien rule this identity is suppressed. That is why nations wish to remain independent so that they can progress according to their natural bent and can experience happiness in their endeavour. Nature is powerful. An attempt to go against nature or to disregard her leads to troubles. The natural instincts cannot be disregarded but it is possible

to elevate this nature to the level of culture. Psychology informs us how by suppression of various natural instincts, different mental disorders ensue. Such a person remains restless and dejected. His abilities slowly deteriorate and become perverted. The Nation too like the individual becomes a prey to numerous ills when its natural instincts are disregarded. The basic cause of the problems facing Bharat is the neglect of its national identity. ■

commitment to a free, open and inclusive Indo-Pacific. Our agenda today - covering areas like vaccines, climate change and emerging technologies - makes the Quad a force for global good".

He said, "I see this positive vision as an extension of India's ancient philosophy of 'Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam', which regards the world as one family".

Shri Modi said, "We will work together, closer than ever before, for advancing our shared values and promoting a secure, stable and prosperous Indo-Pacific".

He further said, "Today's summit meeting shows that Quad has come of age. It will now remain an important pillar of stability in the region". ■

Chief Minister of a State and now Prime Minister for more than two decades without an off day.

Minister of State for Parliamentary Affairs Shri Arjun Ram Meghwal informed it to the media after the meeting.

Besides the Prime Minister, Finance Minister Smt. Nirmala Sitharaman and External Affairs Minister Shri S. Jaishankar also addressed the meeting. Shri Jaishankar emphasised that India's stature rose in the world during the pandemic for its medical diplomacy — first in providing antibiotics and testing kits and later for its vaccine diplomacy.

Giving a presentation on the Union Budget, Smt. Nirmala Sitharman emphasised that despite the economic impact of the pandemic, the government did not impose any additional tax on the public and came with a comprehensive budget for all. ■

GST COLLECTIONS TOP 1 LAKH CR FOR 5 STRAIGHT MONTHS SINCE OCT 2020

Increased economic activities have resulted in higher GST collection which stood above Rs 1 lakh crore for five months in a row since October 2020, Minister of State for Finance and Corporate Affairs Shri Anurag Thakur said in the Rajya Sabha on 23 March, 2021.

He said this could be possible on the back of the measures taken by the government to boost economic activities over the last year to deal with the COVID-19 pandemic.

“GST collection has increased. If you see e-way bill data, numbers... activities have increased,” the minister said.

“GST collection has witnessed above Rs 1 lakh crore for a stretch of five months since October 2020... The GST collection during the period has been higher than the collection in the same period last year,” he said.

On the economy, he said

V-shaped recovery is being seen as the third quarter GDP numbers are positive and trade is getting better.

The Indian economy had seen a contraction of 24.4% in the June quarter of FY21, impacted by COVID-19.

After two consecutive quarters of contraction, the country's GDP entered into a positive territory with a growth of 0.4 per cent in the October-December quarter of the current fiscal.

“When COVID-19 pandemic erupted... -24.4 growth rate was recorded in April-June. The Central government has initiated several good steps with a positive result and 0.4% growth was in the third quarter,” He said.

He also listed various steps taken by the government during the pandemic to boost the economy, including stimulus packages under Aatmanirbhar Bharat programme, emergency



credit line and loan moratorium.

Noteworthy, the GST collection in any particular month depends upon the total taxable value of goods and services supplied in that month.

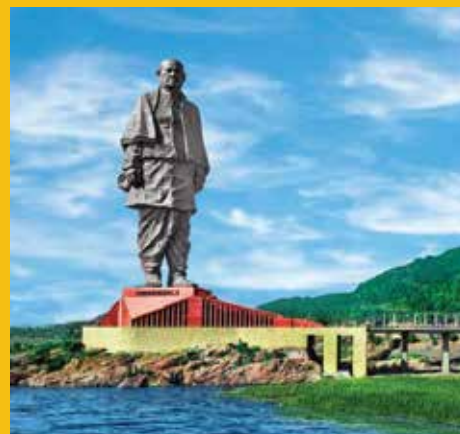
Moreover, the number of e-way bills generated in the current fiscal is almost equal to the number of e-way bills generated last year in spite of a dip in the number of e-way bill generated during April and May 2020, the statement said.

The monthly GST collection trend and the generation of e-way bills are clear indicators of increase in the economic activity, he said. ■

As on 09.03.2021, total 15,812 contractors and total 3,81,831 contract workers are registered on this portal. Along with this, total 48,312 no. of letter of acceptance (LOA), Rs. 349590 lakh (More than Rs3495 crore)wage amount and about 6 crores man-days are also registered on this portal across Indian Railways. ■

India's forex reserves increased for the second consecutive week, touching \$ 584.554 billion as of February 26, up by \$689 million, the Reserve Bank said on March 5. 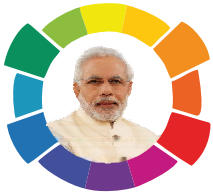


largest foreign exchange reserves in the world, after China, Japan and Switzerland. It surpassed Russia whose reserves stood at \$580.1 bn on

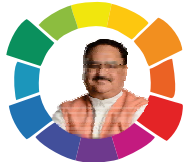
March 14. India's reserves are sufficient to cover 18 months of imports. ■
