EDITORIAL **Congress Politics of Fake Narratives, Lies, and Deceits Defeated**

The massive mandate to Mahayuti (BJP, Shiv Sena, and NCP alliance) in Maharashtra elections, along with emphatic victories in by-elections, has further blessed the BJP and NDA with people's overwhelming love and affection. n the recently concluded Assembly elections for Maharashtra and Jharkhand, the Mahayuti registered a historic landslide victory consecutively for the third time in Maharashtra. The results were announced on 23 November 2024. The ruling Mahayuti alliance comprising the BJP, Shiv Sena (SHS), and NCP sailed past the halfway mark very comfortably and scripting history won 230 seats with around 48.16 percent vote share in the 288-member Assembly house. The Mahayuti, decimated the Opposition Maha Vikas Aghadi (MVA) handing over a humiliating defeat and

leaving it much behind with only 46 seats and 33 percent of the total votes. The majority mark in the Maharashtra Assembly is 145.

In a spectacular performance with 132 seats and 26.77 percent vote share individually, the BJP emerged as the single largest party in the state, whereas, the Mahayuti allies like Shiv Sena (SHS) got 57 seats with a vote percent of 12.38 and the Nationalist Congress Party (NCP) won 41 seats with a vote percent of 9.01.

Likewise, the opposition Shiv Sena (Uddhav

Balasaheb Thackeray) got 20 seats, the Indian National Congress 16 and the Nationalist Congress Party – Sharadchandra Pawar won 10 seats.

Breaking all previous records, this time Maharashtra voted enthusiastically registering a voter turnout of more than 65 percent which was not seen in the last three decades. The BJP-led Mahayuti combindly got about 48.16 percent of the total vote share. In the Konkan, North Maharashtra and Western Maharashtra regions, its vote share even crossed the halfway mark.

On the one hand the Mahayuti increased its vote share across all regions, while the opposition Maha Vikas Aghadi saw its support decline across the State. The BJP alone got 132 seats of the 149 seats it constated, which is nearly a majority in the 288-strong Assembly, and the tally of the alliance is nearly five times that of the MVA which was limited to 46 seats for all its partners combined.

Among others, Samajwadi Party and Jan Surajya Shakti got two seats each, Rashtriya Yuva Swabhiman Party, Rashtriya Samaj Paksha, AIMIM, CPI(M), PWPI, Rajarshi Shahu Vikas Aghadi got one seat each, while Independents won two seats.

Maharashtra- the land of great people like Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj, Shahuji Maharaj, Mahatma Phule, Savitribai Phule, Babasaheb Ambedkar, Veer Savarkar, Balasaheb Thackeray, have broken all previous election records. This is the biggest victory for any party or pre-poll alliance in over 50 years. This is the third time a BJP-led alliance has been chosen by the people of Maharashtra.

"Ek Hain Toh Safe Hain"

PM Shri Modi highlighted the election's Maha-Mantra: "Ek Hain Toh Safe Hain". He said Maharashtra and Haryana sent a clear mandate for unity, rejecting Congress's attempts to divide SC/ST/OBCs with false promises. Tribals, OBCs, Dalits, and all communities backed BJP-NDA, delivering a strong blow to Congress and the INDI alliance's divisive agenda.

Promote and preserve the Marathi language and culture

The Prime Minister also spoke about the BJP's efforts to promote and preserve the Marathi language and culture. Unlike Congress, which he said failed to take significant steps despite decades in power, the BJP granted Marathi the status of a classical language. The PM emphasized that respect for mother tongues, cultures, and historical heritage is intrinsic to the BJP's character. Highlighting his vision for a 'Viksit Bharat,' he referred to the 'Panch Praan' he introduced from the ramparts of the Red Fort, which included pride in India's heritage.

No power in the world can bring back Article 370

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi emphasized that the Indian voter stands firmly with the principle of 'Nation First.' He remarked that citizens across the country reject leaders and parties driven by a 'Kursi First' mentality, i.e. those focused solely on power and personal gains.

Speaking about how this result serves as a mandate against those who want to reinstate Article 370, he reiterated, "This mandate from Maharashtra sends a strong message: the entire nation will adhere to only one Constitution i.e. Baba Saheb Ambedkar's Constitution. Congress and its allies attempted to revive Article 370 in Jammu & Kashmir, but Maharashtra made it clear that such efforts will not succeed. No power in the world can bring back Article 370."

Exposed the double standards of the INDI alliance

The PM called out Congress's hypocrisy regarding Veer Savarkar and Balasaheb Ji, stating, "This election has exposed the double standards of the INDI alliance. While Congress allied with a faction of Balasaheb's party for power, they refused to honour his ideology. I challenged Congress's allies to get Congress to even speak a word in favor of Balasaheb's policies, but they couldn't. Likewise, Congress repeatedly insulted Veer Savarkar. In Maharashtra, they momentarily halted their disrespect to seek votes but failed to recognize his sacrifices. This hypocrisy has revealed their true nature."

Hitting out at the Congress party, PM Shri Modi said, "In India's politics, the Congress party has now become a 'Parjeevi', struggling to form governments on its own. In recent elections, they were wiped out in Andhra Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Sikkim, Haryana, and Maharashtra. NDA SWEEPS By-polls in different states

A long with the Assembly Elections, By-polls in vacated Assembly and Lok Sabha seats were also held in 14 states. In the Assembly contests, Uttar Pradesh led with nine seats, followed by Rajasthan with seven, West Bengal with six, and Assam with five. Punjab and Bihar had four seats each, Karnataka three, while Madhya Pradesh, Sikkim, and Kerala had two each. Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Uttarakhand, and Meghalaya had one seat each. The by-poll results for 48 seats in 14 States were announced on 23 November 2024.

In Uttar Pradesh, the by-poll was held in nine seats of which the BJP-led NDA won seven seats. The BJP alone got six seats while its ally RLD got one seat. The Samajwadi Party won two seats. The BJP, which had won only one of these nine seats in the 2022 State election, won six of them this time. After the victory, CM Yogi Adityanath credited Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi for the success.

Likewise, in Rajasthan, the BJP won five seats. The BJP retained tribal-dominated Salumber and secured victory in Jhunjhunu, Khinwsar, Ramgarh and Deoli-Uniara. The Congress, which won four of the seven seats in the 2023 Assembly election, lost three and won Dausa by a slender margin. The BAP retained its Chorasi seat in Dungarpur district

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi visited Jamui, Bihar on 15 November, 2024 to commemorate Janjatiya Gaurav Divas, marking the commencement of the 150th Birth Anniversary Year celebration of Dharti Aaba Bhagwan Birsa Munda. Shri Modi unveiled a commemorative coin and postal stamp in honour of Bhagwan Birsa Munda. He also inaugurated and laid the foundation stone of multiple development projects worth over Rs 6,640 crore aimed at uplifting tribal communities and improving infrastructure in rural and remote areas of the region.

Shri Modi participated in the Grih Pravesh of 11,000 Awas built under Pradhan Mantri Janjati Adivasi Nyaya Maha Abhiyan (PM-JANMAN). He also inaugurated 23 Mobile Medical Units (MMUs) launched under PM-JANMAN and an additional 30 MMUs under Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DAJGUA) to enhance healthcare access in tribal areas.

Prime Minister inaugurated 300 Van Dhan Vikas Kendras (VDVKs) to promote tribal entrepreneurship and support livelihood generation and 10 Eklavya Model Residential Schools, worth around Rs 450 crore, dedicated to tribal students. He also inaugurated two Tribal Freedom Fighters' Museums in Chhindwara and Jabalpur, Madhya Pradesh and two Tribal Research Institutes in Srinagar, Jammu & Kashmir and Gangtok, Sikkim to document and preserve the rich history and heritage of tribal communities.

PM Shri Modi laid the foundation stone of 500 km of new roads to improve connectivity in tribal regions and 100 Multi-Purpose Centres (MPCs) to act as community hubs under PM JANMAN. He also laid the foundation stone of 25 additional Eklavya Model Residential Schools, worth over Rs 1,110 crore, furthering the commitment of quality education for tribal children.

He added that many degree and engineering colleges along with Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) were started in the Tribal dominated areas in the last decade. Shri Modi also noted that in the last decade. 30 new Medical colleges were started in the tribal areas along with ongoing works in many new medical colleges including one in Jamui, Bihar. He added that a strong network of 7000 Ekalavya schools across the country was also being developed.

Lieutenant Governor of Delhi Shri Vinai Kumar Saxena, Union Minister of State Shri Harsh Malhotra, and several other dignitaries.

In his address during the program, Union Home Minister Shri Amit Shah said that in 2021, Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi had announced that the birth anniversary of Bhagwan Birsa Munda (November 15) would be celebrated as Janjatiya Gaurav Divas (Tribal Pride Day). JANJATIYA GAURAV DIVAS Celebrating Tribal Heritage

Bhagwan Birsa Munda taught us how to live in harmony with our surroundings and be proud of our culture. Inspired by him, we are working to fulfil his dreams and to empower our tribal communities. ~ PM SHRI NARENDRA MODI

Since 2021, Janjatiya Gaurav Divas has been celebrated with great zeal across India to honor the sacrifices of tribal freedom fighters. The tribal communities played a vital role in India's freedom struggle, with movements like those led by the Santhals, Tamars, Kols, Bhils, Khasis, and Mizos, Tribal movements against British rule, like the Ulgulan (Revolution) led by Birsa Munda, were not only pivotal in challenging British oppression but also inspired a national awakening. To ensure the sacrifices of these unsung heroes are never forgotten, the Indian government declared 15th November as Janjatiya Gaurav Divas during the Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav in 2021, marking 75 years of India's independence.

Schemes for the Welfare of Tribes

In addition to Janjatiya Gaurav Divas, the government has launched several programs and initiatives aimed at supporting tribal communities through socio-economic empowerment, sustainable development, and cultural preservation. According to the 2011 Census, India's Scheduled Tribe (ST) population stands at 10.42 crore, or 8.6% of the total population, comprising over 705 distinct groups spread across remote and often inaccessible areas.

Government Initiatives and Financial Support for Tribal Development

The Indian government's efforts for tribal development began with the Tribal Sub-Plan (TSP) in 1974-75, evolving into the Scheduled Tribe Component (STC) and the Development Action Plan for Scheduled Tribes (DAPST). Financial support has grown significantly, with the DAPST budget increasing from Rs. 25,000 crore to Rs. 1.2 lakh crore in 2023-24. For 2024-25, the Union Budget has allocated Rs. 13,000 crore to the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, marking a 73.60% rise from the previous year.

Launch of Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan

On October 2, 2024, Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched the Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan in Hazaribag, Jharkhand. With an outlay of over Rs. 79,156 crore, this ambitious program aims to address critical gaps in social infrastructure, health, education, and livelihood development across approximately 63,843 tribal villages. The Abhiyan benefits over 5.38 crore tribal people.

Pradhan Mantri Janjati Adivasi Nyaya Maha Abhiyan (PM-JANMAN)

Along with the Dharti Aaba program, the Prime Minister launched projects under the Pradhan Mantri Janjati Adivasi Nyaya Maha Abhiyan (PM-JANMAN). This significant initiative was launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on November 15, 2023, during Janjatiya Gaurav Divas in Khunti District, Jharkhand. This aims to uplift Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs). With a budget of Rs. 24,104 crore for 2023-24 to 2025-26, the initiative focuses on improving the quality of life for PVTG communities.

The Pradhan Mantri Adi Adarsh Gram Yojana (PMAAGY)

The scheme aims to provide basic infrastructure in villages with a significant tribal population. Under the scheme, 36428 villages having 50% tribal population and 500 Scheduled Tribes (STs) have been identified for providing basic infrastructure facilities.

Eklavya Model Residential Schools (EMRS)

The Eklavya Model Residential Schools (EMRS) were launched in 2018-19 as part of a Central Sector Scheme to provide quality education to Scheduled Tribe (ST) children in remote areas, offering them opportunities for higher education and employment. These schools follow the Navodaya Pattern and accommodate 480 students from Class VI to XII.

As of now, 1.29 lakh tribal students are enrolled across these schools. The government has approved a total of 728 EMRS schools, with 440 new schools (excluding 12 overlapping locations).

Key Government Scholarships and Fundings for Tribal Empowerment

The government offers various scholarships and financial support to empower tribal communities.

- 1. Pre-Matric and Post-Matric Scholarship Schemes These scholarships aim to reduce dropout rates and
 - support tribal students' education:
 - Pre-Matric Scholarship: Financial assistance for ST students in Classes IX and X.
 - Post-Matric Scholarship: Financial aid for ST students from Class XI to post-graduate courses.

2. National Overseas Scholarship for ST Students

This scheme offers meritorious ST students the chance to pursue post-graduate, doctoral, and post-doctoral studies at international universities. With an emphasis on excellence and global exposure.

3. National Fellowship for ST Students

This fellowship scheme supports tribal students pursuing higher education through a fully digital process, ensuring timely financial assistance and grievance redressal via DigiLocker integration.

Schemes for Income Generation and Economic Empowerment

The government has launched several schemes to empower tribal communities, focusing on income generation and economic development.

- The Term Loan Scheme offers soft loans up to 90% of business costs, with repayment terms of 5 to 10 years.
- The Adivasi Mahila Sashaktikaran Yojna (AMSY) provides concessional loans up to Rs. 2 lakhs at 4% interest for tribal women.
- The Micro Credit Scheme supports tribal self-help

groups with loans up to Rs. 5 lakhs.

• The Adivasi Shiksha Rinn Yojana (ASRY) provides soft loans for tribal students pursuing higher education.

Health Initiatives for Improved Outcomes

The government has launched several health initiatives aimed at improving outcomes for tribal communities.

1. Sickle Cell Anaemia Elimination Mission

Launched by PM Modi on July 1, 2023, in Madhya Pradesh, the mission targets the elimination of Sickle Cell Disease (SCD).

2. Mission Indradhanush

Immunization Campaign focuses on ensuring full immunization for children up to two years of age and pregnant women, with a special emphasis on tribal communities.

3. Nikshay Mitra Initiative

The Nikshay Mitra Initiative targets tuberculosis (TB), offering diagnostic, nutritional, and vocational support to TB patients, particularly those from tribal communities.

5. National Health Mission (NHM)

The National Health Mission developed comprehensive guidelines for the prevention and control of haemoglobinopathies, including Sickle Cell Disease (SCD), which are common among tribal population.

6. Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana

Supports maternal and child health, offering financial assistance to tribal women for prenatal and postnatal care.

Honouring and Celebrating India's Tribal Communities

To honour the sacrifices of tribal freedom fighters, the government has sanctioned the establishment of 10 Tribal Freedom Fighters' Museums across states where tribals fiercely resisted British rule.

All these initiatives, along with other steps taken by the government, have paved the path of bringing the tribal communities into the mainstream while honouring their cultures, legacies and ways of life.

Conclusion

The government has introduced various initiatives to empower these communities, focusing on education, health, and socio-economic development. By raising awareness and fostering solidarity, we can ensure the preservation of tribal cultures while improving their quality of life and integrating them into India's progress.



BUILDING A BETTER FUTURE FOR RURAL INDIA


In May 2014, Prime Minister Narendra Modi's vision and the government's steadfast commitment to building and providing pucca houses for poor people in rural and urban areas culminated in the launch of Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana—Urban (2015) and Gramin (2016).

Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana - Rural

The Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana - Rural (PMAY Rural) was launched on 20th November 2016, aiming to provide housing for the poorest segments of society. Beneficiaries selected are through a rigorous three-stage validation process that includes the Socio-Economic Caste Census (SECC 2011) and Awaas+ (2018) surveys, Gram Sabha approvals, and geo-tagging. This ensures that aid reaches the most deserving individuals. The scheme has further incorporated IT and Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) for efficient fund disbursement. It has also implemented region-specific housing designs, and evidencebased monitorina through geo-tagged photos at various construction stages.

Originally targeting 2.95 crore houses to be completed by 2023-24, the scheme got extended with 2 crore more houses, with a total outlay of Rs. 3,06,137 crore for FY 2024-29 and Rs. 54,500 crore allocated for FY 2024-25.

On August 9, 2024, the Union Cabinet, chaired by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, approved the proposal for financial assistance to be provided for the construction of two crore more houses at the existing unit assistance of Rs.1.20 lakh in plain areas and Rs.1.30 lakh



in North Eastern Region States and Hill States of Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Union Territories of Jammu & Kashmir, and Ladakh.

Application Process

To avail benefits under PMAY-G, beneficiaries must go through a simple online registration process: https://web.umang.gov.in/landing/ department/pmayg.html

Progress under PMAY-G:

Under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana - Gramin (PMAY-G), the Government has set an ambitious target to build 3.32 crore houses. As of November 19, 2024, 3.21 crore houses have been sanctioned, and 2.67 crore houses have been completed, significantly improving the living conditions of millions of rural families.

The scheme has also placed special focus on women а empowerment, 74% with of sanctioned owned houses by The women solely or jointly. scheme now aspires to provide 100% ownership to women. Skilled employment has also been a priority, with almost 3 lakh rural masons trained in disasterresilient construction, boosting their employability.

The construction of houses for two crores more households is expected to benefit nearly ten crore individuals. The approval would facilitate the building of safe and secure houses of good quality with all the basic amenities for all people without housing and people living in dilapidated and kutcha houses. This will ensure the safety, hygiene and social inclusiveness of the beneficiaries.

Key Features of PMAY-G are:

A minimum unit (house) size of 25 sq. mt., including a dedicated area for hygienic cooking.

The beneficiaries construct quality houses using local materials and trained masons.

The beneficiary also has a wide selection of structurally sound, aesthetically, culturally,

and environmentally appropriate house designs available rather than standard cement concrete house designs.

Institutional Loan for Construction

Loan up to Rs. 70,000 is available to eligible beneficiaries at a 3% reduced interest rate for the construction of their permanent house.

The maximum principal amount for which subsidy can be availed is Rs. 2,00,000, ensuring that the construction cost is covered comprehensively.

This additional loan support helps ease the financial burden on beneficiaries, making home construction affordable for rural households.

Convergence with Government Schemes for Enhanced Benefits

PMAY-G works in conjunction with various other government initiatives to ensure comprehensive support for rural households. These schemes aim to improve the quality of life by addressing multiple needs such as sanitation, employment, cooking fuel, and water supply.

- Swachh Bharat Mission-Gramin (SBM-G): Beneficiaries receive up to Rs. 12,000 to construct toilets, ensuring better sanitation facilities in rural homes.
- MGNREGA (Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act): Eligible households can avail 95 days of employment as unskilled labour, specifically under Rural Mason Training, with a daily wage of Rs. 90.95.

- Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY): Under this scheme, each house is entitled to a free LPG connection, promoting cleaner and safer cooking fuel.
- Piped Drinking Water & Electricity Connections: Beneficiaries are provided with access to piped drinking water and electricity connections, improving their living standards and reducing the health risks associated with unsafe water and irregular power supplies.
- Social & Liquid Waste Management: PMAY-G also converges with government programs for managing waste, ensuring better health and hygiene for the beneficiaries.
- Payment Transfer Process

To ensure transparency and efficiency, all payments under PMAY-G are made electronically. Payments are directly transferred to the beneficiaries' bank accounts or post office accounts that are linked to Aadhaar, ensuring that funds reach the intended recipients without delays.

Technological innovation plays a pivotal role here. The Awaas+ 2024 mobile app ensures transparent beneficiary identification with Aadhaar-based face authentication and 3D house desians in collaboration with the Central Building Research Institute (CBRI), enabling beneficiaries to choose suitable designs.

Eligibility Criteria for Beneficiaries

The beneficiaries of PMAY-G are identified using specific criteria, ensuring that the most deserving households, especially those facing housing deprivation, are prioritized. 4. Under this scheme, the beneficiaries are identified through SECC 2011 and Awaas+ (2018) surveys, verified by Gram Sabhas. Over the last decade, the permanent waiting list of SECC 2011 has been saturated, and more than 20 states' Awaas+ 2018 lists are also completed.

The eligibility criteria are as follows:

- Houseless Households: All households without any shelter.
- Households with Kuccha Houses: Households living in homes with kuccha walls and kuccha roofs or houses with zero, one, or two rooms as per the Socio Economic and Caste Census (SECC) 2011.

Compulsory Inclusion Criteria:

The following categories of people are automatically included in the list of beneficiaries:

- Destitute households or those living on alms.
- Manual scavengers
- Primitive Tribal Groups.
- Legally released bonded laborers.

Priority for Assistance

*As on November 19, 2024

Within the universe of eligible beneficiaries, priority will be given to the following categories:

- Houseless households.
- Households with zero or fewer rooms (in the case of households with more than one room, priority will be given to those with fewer rooms).

Special prioritization will also be given based on cumulative deprivation scores, calculated using the following socioeconomic parameters:


- Households with no adult member aged 16 to 59.
- Female-headed households with no adult male member.
- Households with no literate adult above 25 years.
- Households with a disabled member and no able-bodied adult.
- Landless households dependent on manual casual labor.
 - Earmarking of Targets

PMAY-G also ensures targeted assistance for specific disadvantaged groups:

 Scheduled Castes (SC) and Scheduled Tribes (ST): The scheme reserves a minimum 60% of targets for SC/ST households, with 59.58 lakh SC houses and 58.57 lakh ST houses completed.

Another crucial initiative for fulfilling the objective of "Housing for All" is the Dharati Aaba Tribal Village Utkarsh Abhiyan which focuses on tribal development, covering 63,843 villages, benefiting over 5 crore tribal people across 30 States/ UTs. This initiative addresses housing and critical gaps in social infrastructure, health, education, and livelihoods. with 72.31 lakh tribal families already benefitting.

5% of the target is reserved for differently-abled beneficiaries, and another 5% prioritizes housing for families affected by



natural disasters, such as the Fani Cyclone in Odisha

- Minorities: 15% of the total funds at the national level are earmarked for Minority households. The allocation of targets among States/UTs is based on the proportionate rural population of minorities according to the Census 2011 data.
- Exclusion Criteria
 Certain households are excluded from the scheme based on their financial status and assets. The following households will be automatically excluded:
- Households with a Kisan Credit Card having a credit limit of Rs. 50,000 or above.
- Government employees or those with non-agricultural enterprises.
- Households with monthly income over Rs. 15,000 or those paying income tax.
- Households owning assets such as refrigerators, landline phones, or irrigated land (more

than 2.5 acres).

To enhance inclusivity, the exclusion criteria have been reduced from 13 to 10, conditions such as ownership of a fishing boat or motorized two-wheeler have been removed, and the income threshold has been raised to Rs. 15,000 per month.

CONCLUSION

The Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Gramin (PMAY-G) has made remarkable progress in transforming the living conditions of millions of rural families by providing safe and secure housing. PMAY-G is more than a housing scheme-it is a movement to empower rural India, ensure social equity, and uplift marginalized communities. With the recent approval for constructing two crore additional houses. the Government continues to reinforce its commitment to achieving "Housing for All," ensuring that every eligible household has access to quality housing and a dignified life.

EPFO ADDS 18.81 LAKH NET MEMBERS DURING SEPTEMBER 2024

9.47 Lakh New Members Enrolled

The Employees' Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO) has released provisional payroll data for September 2024, revealing a net addition of 18.81 lakh members. This represents a 9.33% year-on-year growth as compared to September 2023, signifying increased employment opportunities and heightened awareness of employee benefits, bolstered by EPFO's effective outreach initiatives.

Key highlights of the EPFO Payroll Data:

• New Membership:

EPFO enrolled around 9.47 lakh new members in September 2024, representing an increase of 6.22% in the new members from the previous year in September 2023.

• Rejoining Members:

The payroll data highlights that approximately 14.10 lakh members exited and subsequently rejoined EPFO.

• Growth in Female Membership:

Gender-wise analysis of payroll data unveils that out of the new members added during the month, around 2.47 lakhs are new female members. This figure exhibits year-over-year growth of 9.11% compared to September 2023.

• State-wise Contribution:

State-wise analysis of payroll data denotes that net member addition in the top five states/ UTs constitutes around 59.86% of net member addition, adding a total around 11.26 lakh net members during the month. Of all the states, Maharashtra is leading by adding 21.20% of net members during the month. The states/UTs of Maharashtra, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Delhi, Haryana, Gujarat, Uttar Pradesh and Telangana individually added more than 5% of the total net members during the month.

20.58 LAKH NEW WORKERS ENROLLED UNDER ESI SCHEME

The provisional payroll data of ESIC on 19 November reveals that 20.58 lakh new employees have been added in the month of September, 2024. 23,043 new establishments have been brought under the social security ambit of the ESI Scheme in the month of September, 2024 thus ensuring social security to more workers. Further, the Year on Year analysis shows a growth of 9% in net registrations compared to September'2023.

AYUSHMAN VAY VANDANA ENROLMENT UNDER AB PM-JAY Touches 10 Lakh within 3 weeks of its rollout

Around 4 lakh enrolments under Ayushman Vay Vandana card are by females

n a significant milestone, more than 10 lakh senior citizens aged 70 and above have enrolled for the newly launched Ayushman Vay Vandana Card, enabling them to access free healthcare benefits under the Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB PM-JAY). This achievement comes within three weeks of the card's rollout by Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi on October 29, 2024. Around 4 lakh enrolments under Ayushman Vay Vandana card are by females.

Since the launch of the Ayushman Vay Vandana Card, treatments worth over Rs 9 crore have been authorized, benefiting more than 4,800 senior citizens aged 70 and above, including over 1,400 women. These treatments cover a range of conditions, including coronary angioplasty, hip fractures/ replacement, gallbladder removal, cataract surgery, prostate resection, and stroke, among others.

DRDO CARRIES OUT SUCCESSFUL TRIAL OF INDIA'S FIRST LONG-RANGE HYPERSONIC MISSILE

Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) conducted a successful flight-trial of India's first long-range hypersonic missile from Dr APJ Abdul Kalam Island off the coast of Odisha late on November 16, 2024. This hypersonic missile is designed to carry various payloads for ranges greater than 1,500 kms for the Armed Forces.

The missile was tracked by various range systems, deployed in multiple domains. The flight data obtained from down range ship stations confirmed the successful terminal maneuvers and impact with high degree of accuracy.

This missile has been indigenously developed by the laboratories of Dr APJ Abdul Kalam Missile complex, Hyderabad along with various other DRDO laboratories and Industry Partners. The flight-trial was carried out in the presence of senior scientists of DRDO and officers of the Armed Forces.

In a post on X, Raksha Mantri Shri Rajnath Singh described the flight-trial as a historic achievement which has put India in the group of select nations having capabilities of such critical and advanced military technologies. He congratulated DRDO, Armed Forces and the Industry for the successful flight trial.

DRDO SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETES FLIGHT TESTS OF GUIDED PINAKA WEAPON SYSTEM

Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) has successfully completed the Flight Tests of Guided Pinaka Weapon System as part of Provisional Staff Qualitative Requirements (PSQR) Validation Trials. The flight tests have been conducted in three phases at different field firing ranges.

During these tests, the PSQR parameters viz., ranging, accuracy, consistency and rate of fire for multiple target engagement in a salvo mode have been assessed by extensive testing of rockets. Twelve (12) rockets from each production agency from two in-service Pinaka launchers upgraded by the launcher production agencies have been tested.

Raksha Mantri Shri Rajnath Singh has complimented DRDO and the Indian Army for the successful PSQR Validation Trials of the system and stated that the induction of this Guided Pinaka Weapon System will further boost the artillery fire power of the Armed Forces.

GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL ASSESSMENT AND INDEX 2023 LAUNCHED

Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) Science & Technology; Minister of State (Independent Charge) Earth Sciences; MoS PMO, Personnel, Public Grievances, Pensions, Atomic Energy and Space, Dr Jitendra Singh has launched Grievance Redressal Assessment and Index (GRAI) 2023 in the presence of Shri V. Srinivas, Secretary, Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances (DARPG), Govt. of India.

Grievance Redressal Assessment and Index (GRAI) was conceptualized and designed by the DARPG, Govt. of India based on the recommendation of Parliamentary Standing Committee of Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions with an objective to present organigation-wise comparative picture and provide valuable insights about strengths and areas of improvement regarding grievance redressal mechanism. The first edition of GRAI 2022 was released on 21 June 2023.

India pulled 250 million people out of poverty in the last ten years: PM Modi

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi during his five days visit (from 18 to 23 November 2024) of three-countries participated in 31 bilateral meetings and informal interactions with world leaders.

As per official sources these diplomatic engagements included a bilateral meeting with the Nigerian president in Nigeria, 10 bilateral meetings on the sidelines of the G20 Summit in Brazil and nine during his visit to Guyana.

In Brazil, Prime Minister Modi held bilateral meetings with the leaders of the country, besides those of Indonesia, Portugal, Italy, Norway, France, the UK, Chile, Argentina and Australia. These were marked by his maiden bilateral meetings with Indonesian leader Prabowo Subianto, Portugal's Luis Montenegro, the UK's Keir Starmer, Chile's Gabriel Boric, and Argentina's Javier Milei, the officials noted.

On the sidelines of the G20,Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi also had informal interactions and meetings with the leaders of Singapore, South Korea, Egypt, the USA and Spain and with the heads and executives of various international organisations like Ursula von der Leyen of the European Union; Antonio Guterres of the United Nations; Ngozi Okonjo-Iweala of the World Trade Organization; Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus of the World Health Organization; and Kristalina Georgieva and Gita Gopinath of the IMF.

In Guyana, Prime Minister Shri Modi held bilateral meetings with the leaders of Guyana, Dominica, Bahamas, Trinidad & Tobago, Suriname, Barbados, Antigua & Barbuda, Grenada and St Lucia.

Social Inclusion and the Fight against Hunger and Poverty

On November 18th and 19th local time (from 18th to 20th JST), the G20 Rio de Janeiro Summit was held in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, hosted by Brazil as the G20 Presidency. It was chaired by H.E. Mr. Luiz Inácio Lula da Silva. Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi addressing the opening session of the G 20 Summit on 'Social Inclusion and the Fight against Hunger and Poverty' thanked the President of Brazil, H.E Mr. Luis Inacio Lula Da Silva, for hosting the Summit and for his gracious hospitality. He appreciated the Brazilian G20 agenda focused on Sustainable Development Goals, noting that this approach highlighted the concerns of the Global South and took forward the people-centric decisions of the New Delhi G20 Summit. He further

underscored that the Indian G20 presidency's call for "One Earth, One Family, One Future" continued to resonate at the Rio conversations.

Speaking about India's initiatives to deal with hunger and poverty, Prime Minister noted that India had pulled 250 million people out of poverty in the last ten years and was distributing free foodgrains to 800 million people in the country. Speaking about India's success in tackling food security, PM emphasized that its approach based on 'Back to Basics and March to Future' was yielding results. He further elaborated on measures taken by India to foster women-led development.

Prime Minister also highlighted the steps taken by India to strengthen food security in Africa and elsewhere. In this regard, he welcomed the Brazilian initiative to establish a Global Alliance against Hunger and Poverty, underlining that the Global South was severely impacted by food, fuel and fertilizer crises created by the ongoing conflicts, and therefore, their concerns ought to be given primacy.

Sustainable Development and Energy Transition

Addressing the session of the G 20 Summit on Sustainable Development and Energy Transition he noted that during the New Delhi G 20 Summit, the group had resolved to triple renewable energy capacity and double the energy efficiency rate by 2030. He welcomed Brazil's decision to take forward these sustainable development priorities.

Prime Minister elaborated on the steps taken by India to foster sustainable development. He stated that India had provided housing to 40 million families in the last ten years; 120 million households with clean drinking water in the last five years; 100 million families with clean cooking fuel and 115 million families with toilets.

Highlighting that India was the first G 20 country to meet its Paris commitments, Prime Minister noted that India has set an ambitious target to produce 500 gw of renewable energy by 2030, of which 200 gw has been achieved. He further spoke about the global initiatives taken by India, such as the International Solar Alliance, Coalition for Disaster Resilient Infrastructure, Mission LiFE, One Sun One World One Grid, and Global Biofuel Alliance to foster

PRIME MINISTER MODI HOLDS OFFICIAL TALKS WITH PRESIDENT OF NIGERIA

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi was on a State Visit to Nigeria from 17-18 November 2024. He held official talks with the President of Nigeria, Bola Ahmed Tinubu, in Abuja on 17 November. Upon arrival at the State House, Prime Minister was accorded a ceremonial welcome with a 21-gun salute.



The two leaders had a restricted meeting which was followed by delegation level talks. Prime Minister recalled his warm meeting with President Tinubu at the G 20 Summit in New Delhi. He noted that the two countries enjoy special bonds of friendship defined by a shared past, common democratic values and strong people-to-people ties. Prime Minister conveyed his sympathies to President Tinubu for the destruction caused by the recent floods in the country. President Tinubu thanked Prime Minister for India's timely assistance with relief material and medicines.

The two leaders reviewed the ongoing bilateral cooperation and discussed ways to further strengthen India-Nigeria Strategic Partnership. Expressing satisfaction at the progress of ties, they agreed that there was immense potential for collaboration in the fields of trade, investment, education, energy, health, culture, and people-to-people ties.

Shri Modi also addressed the Indian diaspora at an event organized in his honour by the Indian community in Abuja, Nigeria. The Prime Minister expressed happiness over the grand welcome he received with special warmth and exuberance by the Indian community. He said that the love and friendship received from the community was a huge capital to him. a sustainable planet. Calling for giving primacy to the sustainable development needs of the Global South, particularly the Small Island Developing States, Prime Minister urged countries to support the Global Development Compact announced by India at the third Voice of the Global South Summit.

PM's GUYANA VISIT

Upon arrival in Georgetown in Guyana, Prime Minister was warmly received by President, Dr. Mohamed Irfaan Ali and Prime Minister, Mark Anthony Phillips. And almost the entire cabinet of Guyana was present, both at the airport and at the hotel, to receive Prime Minister. He was accorded a ceremonial reception at the airport, and on arrival at the hotel. He was received by the President again, by the Prime Minister of Grenada, Prime Minister Dickon, and Prime Minister Mia Mottley of Barbados, and several cabinet ministers. He was also given great honor by being presented with the key to the city of Georgetown by the Mayor of Georgetown. It was remarkable that so many people had turned up at the hotel, even despite the lateness of the hour. It was nearly midnight by the time Prime Minister had reached the hotel, and he was given a tumultuous welcome to Georgetown.



President Mohamed Irfaan Ali welcomed Prime Minister at the State House with a ceremonial guard of honor. The two leaders held restricted meeting, as well as delegation-level talks. During the interactions, they discussed the entire gamut of India-Guyana relations. Ten agreements were exchanged between the two sides, and these covered areas such as hydrocarbons and energy, health and pharmaceuticals, agriculture, digital cooperation, culture, defence and security studies, etc.

Prime Minister and President, together, planted a sapling in honor of President Ali's mother at the State House as part of the initiative of 'Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam', highlighting the shared commitment to sustainability between India and Guyana. President Irfaan Ali, in a very heartwarming gesture, hosted Prime Minister over a traditional 7-curries meal.

2nd India-CARICOM Summit

After holding bilateral engagements with Guyana, Prime Minister co-chaired the 2nd India-CARICOM Summit, along with Prime Minister Dickon Mitchell of Grenada, the current Chair of CARICOM. The Summit was attended by Heads of States and Government of 11 member States; Antigua and Barbuda, Bahamas, Barbados, Dominica, Guyana, St. Lucia, St. Vincent and the Grenadines, Suriname, Trinidad and Tobago, and the foreign ministers of Belize, Jamaica and St. Kitts and Nevis. The Secretary-General of the Caribbean Community, Dr. Carla Barnett, was also present.



The leaders witnessed a fly past of the recently acquired HAL 228 aircraft, two of which Guyana has received from India and have been commissioned. This is to further strengthen the India-CARICOM partnership. Prime Minister put forward seven pillar proposals as C-A-R-I-C-O-M, as CARICOM, standing for C for Capacity building, A for Agriculture and food security, R for Renewable energy and climate change, I for Innovation, technology and trade, C for Cricket and culture, O for Ocean economy and maritime security, and M for Medicine and health care.


CARICOM leaders in one voice applauded these initiatives from India. They highly appreciated Prime Minister's special efforts to strengthen relations with the Group. His seven pillars encompassing all the issues of relevance to CARICOM nations was highly appreciated. These include issues facing CARICOM countries, such as high incidence of noncommunicable diseases such as cancer and diabetes, shortage of skilled manpower, climate resilience and sustainable development, energy security including exploitation of renewable energy, national security including coastal surveillance, connectivity, particularly inter-island maritime connectivity for both goods and passengers, and women empowerment and the promotion of women's cricket.

The leaders were highly appreciative of all the initiatives that have been taken by the Prime Minister, and they in particular appreciated the fact that at the height of COVID pandemic, India had come to the assistance of the CARICOM countries by donating vaccines and also providing other forms of medical assistance. They also appreciated the fact that Prime Minister's initiatives correctly matched the felt need of the CARICOM countries and the leader after leader expressed a view that India is like a family member of the CARICOM community. They thanked Prime Minister for the visit and commended India's efforts for proposing a roadmap to further our ties.

Following the India-CARICOM Summit, which was only the second such summit held between the two sides, the first one was on the margins of the United Nations General Assembly in New York in 2019. So, this was really the very first Summit that was happening in the CARICOM country.

PM addresses the Special Session of Parliament in Guyana

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi also addressed the Special Session of Parliament of Guyana, where he emphasized the power of democracy and humanity to address the world's issues. He was given a standing ovation. Later, Prime Minister paid tributes to the statue of Mahatma Gandhi and the Arya Samaj monument. Prime Minister also visited the Indian Arrival monument and paid homage to the forefathers



who arrived in Guyana 186 years ago. He visited the Saraswati Vidya Niketan School, which he had also visited in his first visit to Guyana 24 years ago. He had spent some time at this school at that time.

In short while, Prime Minister addressed the gathering of the Indian diaspora. India's relations with Guyana, date back to more than 185 years, with the first arrival of Indians on the 5th of May, 1838. Today, the Guyanese Indian community comprise roughly 40% or about 300,000 out of Guyana's total population and is a very vital link in our relationship. Prime Minister has also interacted with some of the people he met here 24 years ago during his visit and he also interacted with some of the famous cricketers of Guyana, including Clive Lloyd, Alvin Kallicharran, Shiv Narayan Chanderpaul, Devendra Bishoo, Hetmyer and others.
