

the people of Bihar once again reposed their faith in the leadership of Shri Narendra Modi and NDA government.

As per the current analysis the women, poor and deprived section of society played crucial role in ensuring NDA's victory in the state. According to the data released by Election Commission the female voter turnout was recorded at 59.7 percent, higher than both overall polling of both 57.05 percent and 54.7 percent male turnout. Of the 38 districts in Bihar, 23 reported higher voter turnout of women than that of men. In all these 23 districts, NDA did better in terms of winning seats.

The BJP has gained massively in this election. In 2015, its tally was 53 out of the 157 seats it contested; in 2020, out of the 110 seats it contested, the BJP has won 74, taking the NDA to victory. The party's victory in Bihar is the result of people's faith in PM Shri Modi, and it is now clear that voters of Bihar have rejected dynasty, casteism and politics of appeasement.

A day after the BJP-led National Democratic Alliance (NDA) retained power in the Bihar Assembly elections, Shri Modi addressed party workers in Delhi. He said the BJP was the only party to increase its seats, despite being in power for three terms -- the BJP managed to garner 19.5 per cent votes in this election. It was the result of a well-targeted ground work by the party karyakartas that the BJP has managed to make people relate with development-oriented politics in the state.

The ruling Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) swept the byelections for eight assembly constituencies in Gujarat, voting for which took place on November 3. Almost all candidates won convincingly, with the margin of 4,649 in Morbi being the narrowest.

The eight constituencies for which by-polls were held are Abdasa, Karjan, Morbi, Gadhada, Dhari, Limbdi, Kaprada and Dangs.

Taking a jibe at the Congress, Chief Minister Shri Vijay Rupani called the party a 'sinking' ship, adding that the bypoll results were just a 'trailer' of the assembly elections in the state which will take place in 2022.

UTTAR PRADESH

BJP won a total of 6 seats in the state while Samajwadi Party managed only 1 seat in Uttar Pradesh



by-polls. Polling was held on 7 seats. The seven seats which went to bypolls included Ghatampur, Malhani, Bangarmau, Deoria Naugaon Sadat, Bulandshahr and Tundla. A voter

turnout of more than 53 percent was recorded in the state bypolls for which 88 candidates were in the fray. Uttar Pradesh Chief minister Shri Yogi Adityanath said the exceptional performance of the BJP in the bypolls give a "clear indication" of the party's chances in the upcoming

MANIPUR

In Manipur, the BJP won the Wangoi, Singhat and Wangjing Tentha and Saitu Manipur Assembly bypoll seats. The by-polls held on November 7 were necessitated after Congress MLAs of these four seats resigned from the assembly and joined the ruling BJP.

tating that he can sense massive public anger against the Mamata Banerjee government in West Bengal, Union Home Minister Shri Amit Shah on November 5 said that the days of the Trinamool Congress government were numbered and that the BJP will come to power with a two-third majority in the Assembly polls next year.

"I want to appeal to the people of Bengal to uproot the TMC government and give the BJP an opportunity to form the next government. We will transform the state into Sonar Bangla (Golden Bengal)," he said.

On a two-day visit to the state, Shri Amit Shah landed in Kolkata on November 4 and reached Bankura, on the western part of the state, on

November 5. He began his visit by garlanding the statue of Birsa Munda, a renowned freedom fighter who came from the Munda tribe.

While talking to media Shri Shah said, "I am in West Bengal since last night and can sense the massive public anger against the Mamata Banerjee government. We are confident of bringing in change in the state under the leadership of Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi. The Mamata Banerjee government has stopped benefits of Central schemes from reaching to the tribal people, the poor, the farmers, and people from the backward classes in Bengal.

"If Mamata Banerjee thinks that by stopping implementation of Central schemes in Bengal she will stop the BJP, then she is mistaken. The way the state government has oppressed BJP workers here, I am confident that the death knell has begun for the TMC government."

He said: "The tribal people of Bengal are not getting benefit of housing schemes started by the Centre. The poor are not getting healthcare schemes and the farmers are not getting the annual aid of Rs 6,000. If you (Banerjee) let these people enjoy the




benefits of these schemes, they may at least spare some thoughts for you."

After the garlanding ceremony, Shri Shah held an internal meeting with party workers and leaders from 13 districts to chalk out strategies for the next year's Vidhan Sabha polls.

Later, the Home Minister had lunch at the home of party worker Shri Bibhishan Hansda in tribal-dominated Chaturdihi village, near Bankura town. He was accompanied by Lok Sabha MP and West Bengal BJP President Shri Dilip Ghosh, Union Minister Debashree Chaudhuri, party's National General Secretary Shri Kailash Vijayvargiya, National Vice-President Shri Mukul Roy, BJP MP Saumitra Khan and senior leader Shri Rahul Sinha.

Shri Shah was offered a traditional Bengali vegetarian meal by the Hansda family and spent some time with them. "Had amazing Bengali food at Shri Vivishan Hansda ji's home in Chaturdhi village. No words can express their warmth and hospitality," the Home Minister said in a tweet.

Shri Amit Shah addressed a press conference at the Westin Hotel in Kolkata on the second and last day of his two-day pravas of West Bengal attacking the anarchist policies the Trinamool Congress government and called upon the people to overthrow the Mamata government and form the BJP government. Earlier, Shri Shah offered prayers at Dakshineswar Kali Temple. After the puja, Shri Amit Shah while talking to reporters said that he has wished the Mother Kali for the well being of entire state and countrymen.



Shri Amit Shah said that on May 2011, there was a change in West Bengal with the slogan 'Maa-Mati-Manush'. The people of the state also had many expectations and hopes and wanted their aspiration to get appropriate response. Plagued by three decades of communist rule, the command of Bengal was given to the Trinamool Congress. But 10 years later, today the slogan of 'Maa, Mati and Manush' has changed to appeasement, dictatorship and tolabaji. The Trinamool government and the Chief Minister of the state failed to meet the expectations of the people.

Shri Shah, while sharply questioning the Mamata government on the atrocities on women in West Bengal, asked why did Mamta ji not send the crime records of West Bengal to the National Crime Records Bureau since 2018? What are you trying to hide and why? People want to know about the law and order situation of the state. I want to ask Mamta ji seven questions that despite being a woman Chief Minister, what did you do for women safety in Bengal?

- 1. Why did you stop giving Bengal crime records to NCB from 2018 onwards?
- 2. Why West Bengal ranks third in the country in crime against women?



- 3. Why West Bengal tops the country in rape attempts?
- 4. How is West Bengal ranked first in the country in acid attack and acid attack attempts?
- 5. Why is West Bengal second in the country in the disappearance of women?
- 6. Why is West Bengal on top in not finding missing women?
- 7. The conviction rate in Bengal for crimes against women was only 5.3 percent while the national conviction rate is 22.9 percent, why?

The promises made by the Mamta government to the people of the state proved to be hollow, disappointment and hope turned into anger. A strange kind of atmosphere is visible amidst the people of Bengal. Hundreds of people came to road, wherever I went. When they used to shout slogans of Bharat Mata ki Jai, Vande Mataram, Jai Shri Ram,it was less in our welcome, displaying more anger towards Mamata government.

Shri Amit Shah added that I have come to assure the people of Bengal that you gave opportunity to Congress, gave opportunities to communists again and again and gave two opportunities to Mamata ji. Give one chance to the BJP under the leadership of Modi ji, we promise to make Sonar Bangla within 5 years. Our aim is clear that Bengal should be developed, the borders of the country are secure, infiltration inside Bengal should be stopped. The only goal of the Trinamool Congress and Mamta Didi is to make her nephew, the Chief Minister in the next term. Now the people of Bengal have to decide whether they need 'Parivarvad' or 'Vikasvad'.

The net stimulus announced on November 12 amounts to Rs. 2.65 Lakh crore. She also informed that the total stimulus announced by the Government and Reserve Bank of India till date, to help the nation tide over the COVID-19 pandemic, works out to Rs. 29.87 lakh crore, which is 15% of national GDP. Out of this, stimulus worth 9% of GDP has been provided by the government.



FM'S 12 KEY ANNOUNCEMENTS AS PART OF AATMA NIRBHAR BHARAT 3.0

1. Aatma Nirbhar Bharat Rozgar Yojana

A new scheme is being launched to incentivize job creation during COVID-19 recovery. If EPFO-registered establishments take in new employees without EPFO numbers or those who lost jobs earlier, the Yojana will benefit these employees. The scheme will be effective from October 1, 2020.

2. Emergency Credit Line Guarantee Scheme for MSMEs, businesses, MUDRA borrowers and individuals (loans for business purposes), has been extended till March 31, 2021. Credit guarantee support scheme is being launched for Healthcare sector and 26 sectors stressed due to COVID-19. Entities will get additional credit up to 20% of outstanding credit; repayment can be done in five years (1 year moratorium + 4 years repayment).

3. Production Linked Incentive worth Rs. 1.46 Lakh Crore is being offered to 10 champion sectors.

This will help boost competitiveness of domestic manufacturing. Will give a big boost to economy, investment, exports and job creation. A total amount of nearly 1.5 Lakh Crore has been earmarked across sectors, for next five years.

4. Rs. 18,000 Crore Additional outlay for PM Awaas Yojana - Urban

This is over and above Rs. 8000 Crore already allocated this year; will help ground 12 Lakh houses and complete 18 Lakh houses; will create additional 78 Lakh jobs and improve production and sale of steel and cement, resulting in multiplier effect on economy.

5. Support for Construction & Infrastructure Relaxation of Earnest Deposit Money & Performance Security on Government Tenders

To provide ease of doing business and relief to contractors whose money otherwise remains locked up, performance security on contracts will be reduced to 3%. EMD for tenders will be replaced by bid security self-declaration. The relaxations will be till December 31, 2021.

6. Income Tax relief for Developers & Home Buyers

Differential between circle rate and agreement value in real estate income tax is being increased from 10% to 20%. This is for primary sale of residential units up to Rs. 2 Crore (from date of announcement of this scheme, till June 30 2021). The Income Tax relief provides incentive to middle class to buy homes.

7. Platform for Infra Debt Financing

Govt. will make Rs. 6,000 Crore equity investment in debt platform of National Investment and

Infrastructure Fund, which will help NIIF raise Rs. 1.10 Lakh Crore by 2025 for financing infrastructure projects.

8. Support for Agriculture: Rs. 65,000 Crore for subsidized fertilizers

As fertilizer consumption is going up significantly, increased supply of fertilizers will ensure that forthcoming crop seasons will not be affected for want of adequate fertilizers.

9. Boost for Rural Employment:

Additional outlay of Rs. 10,000 Crore is being provided for PM Garib Kalyan Rozgar Yojana. Funds can be used for MGNREGA or for Gram Sadak Yojana, this will help accelerate rural economy.

10. Boost for Project Exports

Rs. 3,000 Crore boost to be given for project exports through assistance given by India to

developing countries under Indian Development and Economic Assistance Scheme (IDEAS Scheme). This will help EXIM Bank facilitate these Line of Credit development assistance activities and promote exports from India.

11. Capital and Industrial Stimulus

Rs. 10,200 Crore additional budget stimulus will be provided for capital and industrial expenditure on defence equipment, industrial infrastructure and green energy.

12. R&D grant for COVID Vaccine

Rs. 900 Crore is being provided to Department of Biotechnology for research activities related to COVID-19 vaccine development. This does not include cost of vaccine or logistics for vaccine distribution (whatever is required for that will be provided)

Enhanced version of PINAKA Rocket System successfully Flight Tested



Enhanced PINAKA rocket, developed by Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) has been successfully flight tested from Integrated Test Range, Chandipur off the coast of Odisha on November 4 November 2020. Development of Enhanced Pinaka system was taken up to achieve longer range performance compared to earlier design with reduced length. The design and development has been carried out by Pune based DRDO laboratories, namely Armament Research and Development Establishment, ARDE and High Energy Materials Research Laboratory, HEMRL. A total of six rockets were launched in quick succession and the tests met complete mission objectives. Rockets tested have been manufactured by M/s Economic Explosives Limited, Nagpur, to whom the technology has been transferred. All the flight articles were tracked by Range instruments such as telemetry, radar and Electro Optical Tracking Systems which confirmed the flight performance. Enhanced version of the Pinaka rocket would replace the existing Pinaka Mk-I rockets which are currently under production.

FIVE YEARS OF HISTORIC DECISION TO IMPLEMENT OROP

OVER RS. 42740 CRORE DISBURSED TO 20,60,220 PENSIONERS/FAMILY PENSIONERS

overnment of India took the historic decision to implement One Rank One Pension, OROPby issuing an order on 7.11.2015, benefit effective from 01.07.2014, despite huge financial burden demonstrating its commitment to the welfare of ex-servicemen.Armed Forces Personnel retired upto 30.06.2014 were covered under this Order. Keeping in view the magnitude and complexity of Defence pension, extensive consultations were held with experts and ex-Servicemen before issue of Government order on implementation of OROP. Ex-Servicemen had been agitating for implementation of OROP nearly for the 45 years, but the same was not implemented before 2015.

OROP implies that uniform pension be paid to the Armed Forces Personnel retiring in the same rank with the same length of service regardless of their date of retirement. Thus, OROP implies bridging the gap between the rate of pension of current and past retirees at periodic intervals.

A sum of Rs. 10795.4 crorehas been disbursed to 20,60,220 Defence Forces Pensioners/Family Pensioners as arrears on account of implementation of OROP. The yearly recurring expenditure on account of OROP is about Rs.7123.38 crores and for about six years starting from 01.07.2014, the total recurring expenditure worked out to approximately Rs. 42740.28 crore. OROP beneficiaries also got the benefit of fixation of pension under 7th CPC while calculating the pension by multiplication factor of 2.57.

NATIONAL DEMOCRATS, DEMOCRATIC SOCIALISTS & NATIONAL SOCIALISTS

he Political Development modern world the influenced has been and shaped by the three concepts of nationalism, democracy socialism. and Chronologically, nationalism is the earliest, and socialism the latest. Taking Europe to be of representative character in this respect, we find that right from the thirteenth to the nineteenth century, its map was drawn re-drawn and according national urges. Nationalism united the people and forced different united people forced different principalities to forgo their autonomy in favour of a national government. It also differentiated one set of people from another, and slowly we find that national interests, rather than whims or wished of an individual. increasingly guided the conduct of war and peace. As nations came to acquire a distinctive character, the form of government also became a matter of interest and controversy. When Alexander pope tried to summarily reject all controversies regarding form of government, he only exhibited his subconscious interest in the matter He wrote:

For forms of Government let

fools contend; What ever is administered best, is best.

POPE DID NOT ANSWER THE QUESTION

Pope, however, did not answer the knotty problem: under which form of government we get, or can hope to get, or can hope to get, the best administration? Monarchy was the form in vogue then, and all the ills of the Government were due to, or could easily be made to look as due to, that system. Moreover and more political philosophers came forward to question the divine right theory of kingship. All men came to be regarded as equal. All this gave birth to democratic ideas. Interest in city republics of Greece was revived. By the time of the French Revolution democracy had become more than a century for democracy to take practical shape and strike root in the many countries of Europe.

With the growth of industrial revolution it was soon realised that real power rested in the hands of the few. There was exploitation not only in the economic field, but in the political sphere also. The common man was either denied franchise, or conditions in which the right of franchise could be freely exercised, did not exist. The urge for social justice gave birth to a political philosophy—which was termed as socialism. Till Marx made a system of it,

socialism was a vague tendency representing the utopian ideals of a number of social workers, trade union leaders and political philosophers. Not that Marx's enunciation of his philosophy lacked any of these traits, or that socialism became any more practicable, but he contributed to socialist thought an analysis and a theory, which elevated it into a definite political philosophy. Even after Marx, there have been socialists who have differed from him, but in their main premises and ultimate objectives they have not been able to make any distinctive mark. The influence of Marxian methodology has made socialism an anathema many people, and made it incompatible both with nationalism and democracy.

NATIONALISM IS A FACT

Nationalism is still the single dominate factor influencing policies of the Governments of the world. But there are very few who expressly recognise its force; and some even want to put an end to nationalism, considering it a curse for humanity. The latter have not succeeded in freeing themselves from this elementary urge; they have only created a number of complexes and thus weakened their national policies. Today most people claim to follow a combination of the two ideals. Thus there are national democrats, national socialists.

and democratic socialists. Taken singly, there could be nationalists, socialists and democrats.

Most countries of the free would can be included in the first category, viz. national democrats. They take nationalism for granted and keep democracy as an ideal before them. These people are not very much enamoured of socialism and some even consider it to be detrimental to democracy. Nazism and Fascism were forms of national socialism. The communist countries USSR. China, Yugoslavia etc. could also be called national socialist. The only difference that is visible is that the latter do not deify nationalism. But impact of nationalism can easily be noticed. Hitler, by placing an undue stress on nationalism. Definitely roused his own antagonized people but the rest. The communist countries are acting in a subtler manner. By claiming to be a world movement thev easily undermine national loyalties of other people and thus serve their own national expansionist designs.

SOCIALISM IS A FORCE

Bhartiya Jana Sangh places equal reliance on nationalism and democracy and recognises that socialism too has some part to play in the present stage or development of the country.

In countries of Asia and Africa that have got their independence from the western colonial powers, the political philosophy in vogue is democratic socialism. Having acquired freedom they seem to have forgotten nationalism, which, in fact, had been the source of inspiration in their freedom struggle. Being associated with the West, they have some faith in democracy. But at the same time they cannot escape the demonstration effect of the fashionable slogan of socialism. Moreover socialism satisfies the lust for power of the cliques that rule and delude the masses. In a society which abounds in poverty and ignorance, socialism has anappeal but it is not a cure. Thus we see that the free and developed countries of the world are national reaimented democrats:

developed or under-developedones are national socialists or communists; and free but under-developed countries are democratic socialists. These are broad categories. But there are exceptions which it is difficult to place in any of the three. Pakistan, for example, is neither national democratic nor national socialist.

DEMOCRACY IS A GOAL

India with the Congress Party in power, can be termed a democratic socialist country.

Presently, in the under-developed stage of the country's economy, and in the early period of our independence, due to the legacy of British Parliamentary institutions we can both afford to be socialistic and democratic socialism. Todav it simply means assumption of certain responsibilities in the field of economic development by the State. There are certain field where in private capital, due to its limited capacities in an under developed country, cannot possibly enter. The State has to come in. Then there are certain regulatory functions which are a must for a developing State. There is then

the question of reducing inequalities. In these respects India has got to be socialist. But there are some harmful effects also. In the first place due to socialism the State definitely takes over a large sphere of enterprise and thus keeps away the entrepreneur even from activities which he can legitimately discharge to the advantage of the State. The State activities become

monopolistic. Here again, to satisfy the socialist craving of the fanatic few, the Government diverts its energies in taking up other industrial activities and/or nationalising what has already been developed by private enterprise. Instead of supplementing economic activity which, in a developing country, is a legitimate responsibility of the State it starts supplanting the already developed industries.

PM CONGRATULATES ISRO FOR THE SUCCESSFUL LAUNCH OF PSLV-C49/EOS-01 MISSION

he Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) launched the 51st mission of Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle (PSLV) on November 7. The carrier vehicle PSLV C49 will deliver 10 satellites in all with EOS-01 as the primary one. The EOS-01, an earth observation satellite, was intended to provide agriculture, forestry and disaster management support. The nine customer satellites are from Lithuania (1), Luxembourg (4) and USA (4). The carrier was launched from the Satish Dhawan Space Centre (SDSC) in Sriharikota, Andhra Pradesh at 3.12pm. Earlier, the launch time was at 3.02pm.

Soon after the lift off, EOS-01 and all other nine customer satellites successfully separated and injected into the orbit. This is the first mission by ISRO in 2020.

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has congratulated Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) and India's space industry for the successful launch of PSLV-C49/EOS-01 Mission.

4.39 CRORE BOGUS RATION CARDS WEEDED OUT SINCE 2013

NEW CARDS ARE REGULARLY ISSUED TO GENUINE & RIGHTFULLY ELIGIBLE BENEFICIARIES/ HOUSEHOLDS AGAINST DELETED RATION CARDS

s part technology-driven PDS reforms across the country to modernise the Targeted Public Distribution System (TPDS) and to improve the transparency and efficiency in its operations through digitization of ration cards/beneficiaries databases, Aadhaar seeding, detection of ineligible/bogus ration cards, de-duplication of digitised data, migration/deaths of beneficiaries and during the runup to the implementation of NFSA, a total of about 4.39 Crore ineligible/bogus ration cards have been weeded out in the country during the period 2013 to 2020, so far, by the State/UT Governments.

Further, the respective quota of NFSA coverage thus released, is being regularly utilised by concerned

State/UT for the 'Rightful Targeting' of beneficiaries under NFSA i.e. inclusion/addition of other genuine & rightfully eligible beneficiaries/households by issuing new ration cards to them, while remaining within the respective ceiling limits of coverage defined for each States/UT under the Act.

The NFSA provides coverage for 81.35 Crore persons to receive highly subsidised foodgrains through TPDS, which is nearly 2/3rd of the country's population as per the Census of 2011. Presently, more than 80 Crore persons in the country are receiving foodgrains (Rice, Wheat and Coarse grains) at highly subsidised Central Issue Prices of Rs. 3, 2 and 1 per Kg respectively under NFSA, on monthly basis.

INDIA STANDS FIRMLY WITH COUNTRY'S BRAVE SOLDIERS AND SECURITY FORCES

ndia stands firmly with country's brave soldiers and security forces, Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi said on October 25 as he urged people to light a lamp for soldiers while celebrating festivals amid the novel coronavirus pandemic.

Addressing the nation through his monthly radio programme "Mann Ki Baat", PM Modi said "The soldiers are serving the nation away from their family as they guard the country's borders to ensure that the people in the country are safe from external threats".

"Lots of festivals like Eid, Diwali will take place at this time of the year. During these festivals, we

also have to remember our brave soldiers who have also stood at the borders.

We have to light a lamp at home, in honour of these brave sons and daughters of Mother India," PM Modi added.

He urged people to celebrate festivals with restraint and to remember the resolve of "vocal for local" while shopping.

"Not only is the popularity of khadi rising, it is also being produced in many places of the world. There is a place

in Mexico called Oaxaca, there are many villages in this area where the local villagers weave khadi. Today the khadi of this place has gained popularity by the name Oaxaca khaadi. How khadi reached Oaxaca is no less interesting. In fact a young person of Oaxaca, Mark Brown once watched a movie on Mahatma Gandhi. Brown got so inspired by watching this movie on Bapu that he visted Bapu's ashram in India, understood him and learnt about him in depth. It was then, that Brown realised that khadi was not just a cloth; it was a complete way of life. Brown was deeply moved by the way khadi was intertwined with the rural economy and self sufficiency. It was here that Brown resolved to work on khadi on his return to Mexico. He introduced the villagers of Oaxaca in Mexico to khadi and trained them. And now Oaxaca khadi has become a brand. The website of this project bears the inscription 'the

symbol of Dharma in motion'. You can also find a very interesting interview of Marc Brown on this website. He narrates that initially the people were wary of khadi but ultimately they got interested and a market got ready for it. He states that these are matters related to Ram Rajya, when you fulfill the needs of the people, the people start connecting with you."

He added, "Previously, a large number of people used to gather in Durga Pandal for darshan of Goddess Durga. It was afair like atmosphere. But this time it did not happen. Earlier, big fairs were also held on Dussehra. But this time their form

is also changed. The festival of Ramleela was also a big attraction, but there are some restrictions for it also. This time

all large gatherings are banned. There will be Eid, Sharad Purnima, Valmiki Jayanti, Dhantesras, Diwali, Chhatth Pooja, Guru Nanak Dev Jayanti festival in coming days. During this corona crisis, we have to work with restraints," he added.

He said "My dear countrymen, Pulwama in Kashmir is playing an important role in educating the

entire country. Today, when children all over the nation do their homework, or prepare notes, somewhere behind this lies the hard work of the people of Pulwama! The Kashmir Valley meets almost 90% demand for the Pencil Slats, timber casings of the entire country, and of that, a very large share comes from Pulwama. Once upon a time we used to import wood for pencils from abroad, but, now our Pulwama is making the country self-sufficient in the field of pencil making. In fact, these Pencil Slats of Pulwama are reducing the gaps between states! Chinar wood of the valley has high moisture content and softness, which makes it most suitable for the manufacture of pencils. In Pulwama, Oukhoo is known as the Pencil Village. Here, several manufacturing units of Pencil Slats are located, which provide employment, and, in these units, a large number of women are employed."

IDEOLOGY SHOULD NEVER BE PUT BEFORE NATIONAL INTEREST: PM


NEW DIMENSIONS OF UNITY

PM MODI LAYS FOUNDATION STONE AND INAUGURATES MULTIPLE DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS IN VARANASI



He listed the infrastructure works carried out in Varanasi like Ghats being decorated, introduction of CNG to reduce pollution, Tourist Plaza at Dashashwamedh Ghat.

The Prime Minister said these efforts towards River Ganga are also the resolve for Kashi and the path of new opportunities for Kashi. Gradually, the situation of the ghats here is improving. He said along with the cleanliness and beautification of Ganga Ghats, Sarnath is also getting a new look.



He added that the light and sound programme launched today will increase the grandeur of Sarnath.

The Prime Minister announced that, a large part of Kashi is also being freed from the problem of hanging electric wires. Another phase of laying the wires underground is completed today. He said in addition, Smart LED lights will lighten and beautify the streets.

The Prime Minister stressed that the connectivity of Varanasi has always been a top priority of the Government. He said new infrastructure is being constructed so that the people of Kashi and the tourists don't waste their time in traffic jams. He remarked the road connecting Babatpur to the city has also become a new identity of Varanasi. He termed the launch of two Passenger Boarding Bridges in Varanasi airport as necessary, since six years ago, Varanasi airport used to handle 12

flights daily which has now become 48 flights a day. He said modern infrastructure is being made in Varansi to make life easier for both the people who live here and who visit here. He listed the road infrastructure works carried out in the city of Varanasi.

The Prime Minister said for the last 6 years, unprecedented work has also been done on health infrastructure in Varanasi. Today not only UP, but in a way, it is becoming a hub of health facilities for the entire Purvanchal. He listed the health infrastructure done in the Varanasi area like modernization of Lal Bahadur Shastri Hospital in Ramnagar, etc.

The Prime Minister remarked that all-round development is happening in Varanasi today, and is benefiting the entire eastern India including Purvanchal. He said now the people of Purvanchal do not have to go to Delhi and Mumbai even for small needs.

The Prime Minister said for the farmers of Varanasi and Purvanchal, many facilities ranging from storage to transport have been created here like the center of the International Rice Institute, Milk Processing Plant, Construction of Perishable Cargo Center, etc. He said farmers are benefiting a lot from such facilities. He expressed happiness that for the first time this year, fruits, vegetables and paddy from the Varanasi region, have been exported abroad. He said a godown with storage capacity of 100 MT launched today will expand the storage facilities for farmers in Kashi. He said the multi-purpose Seed warehouse and dissemination Center has been launched in Jansa.

The Prime Minister said the village poor and the farmers are the biggest pillars of the AtmaNirbhar Bharat campaign and the biggest beneficiaries too. He said the recent agricultural reforms are going to directly benefit the farmers. He said today, under the Pradhan Mantri Swanidhi Yojana, the street vendors are getting easy loans, so that they can resume their work after the pandemic.

The Prime Minister said to provide legal rights to the people living in the village on their lands and houses, 'Swamitva Yojana' has been launched. He said after the issuance of property cards under this scheme, the scope for property disputes will not




remain in the villages. He added now it will be easy to get a loan from the bank on the village house or land.

The Prime Minister wished the people on Diwali, Govardhan Puja and Bhaiya Dooj and urged them to promote Local for Diwali a lot and also to proudly propogate great local goods and said this will strengthen the local identity.
