




Nayab Singh Saini takes oath for second time as Chief Minister

LIFE SKETCH

- CM Shri Nayab Singh Saini was born in the small village of Mizapur Majra near Ambala, Haryana on 25 January 1970.
- He is a law graduate and did his LLB degree from Chaudhary Charan Singh University, Meerut, Uttar Pradesh, and did his B.A from B. R. Ambedkar University, Muzaffarpur, Bihar.
- Coming from a humble family background, Shri Saini joined the Bharatiya Janata Party Ambala unit and steadily rose through the ranks.
- He became the General Secretary of Haryana BJP Kisan Morcha.
- In 2014, Shri Saini contested the Haryana state elections from Naraingarh Assembly constituency in Ambala District as a BJP candidate and won the MLA election by 24,361 votes to become a member of the Haryana Legislative Assembly from 2014 to 2019.
- He served as the Minister of State, Government of Haryana from 2015 to 2019.
- In the 2019 National General Election he was elected as Member of Parliament from Kurukshetra.
- He was appointed as the Bharatiya Janata Party State President of Haryana from 2023 to 2024.



- For the first time Shri Saini, assumed the charge of Chief Minister of Haryana on 12 March 2024.
- In October 2024, he won the Haryana Assembly Election from Ladwa seat in Kurukshetra District and also led the party to secure a historic thirdterm victory in the state.
- Shri Saini, 54, was unanimously elected as the leader of the BJP Legislature Party in a meeting held at the party office in Panchkula on October 16, 2024.
- Shri Nayab Singh Saini took oath of office on 17th October 2024 and became the Chief Minister of Haryana for the second consecutive time.

The National Master Plan for Multi-modal Connectivity, launched on October 13, 2021, is set to celebrate its third anniversary on 13 October. This digital platform is designed to bring various Ministries, including Railways and Roadways, to ensure integrated planning and coordinated execution of infrastructure projects. The initiative aims to provide seamless and efficient connectivity for the movement of people, goods, and services across various modes of transport, thereby enhancing last-mile connectivity and reducing travel time. PM Gati Shakti incorporates the infrastructure schemes of various Ministries and State Governments such as Bharatmala, Sagarmala, inland waterways, dry/land ports, and UDAN. Gati Shakti: Central Ministries and State Participation

The PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan (NMP) has onboarded 44 Central Ministries and 36 States/UTs and a total of 1,614 data layers have also been integrated. To ensure data accuracy, key infrastructure ministries have finalised Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for a three-tier system. SOPs for 8 infrastructure ministries and 15 social sector ministries have been notified, with development continuing for other ministries and States/UTs. A 'Compendium on PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan' on data management, prepared by DPIIT, outlines the stakeholder responsibilities.

A 'Compendium of PM Gati Shakti Volume I and Volume II' has been developed and launched, that highlights the success stories of PM Gati Shakti. A milestone of assessing 208 big-ticket infrastructure projects worth Rs. 15.39 lakh Crores, of various Ministries adhering to PM Gati Shakti principles has been achieved. Additionally, 434 projects under three economic corridors of the Ministry of Railways have been evaluated and shared with the PMO and they are Energy, Mineral, and Cement Corridors, High Traffic Density Corridors and Rail Sagar.

District-Level Integration

A District Master Plan (DMP) portal is being developed to extend PM Gati Shakti to the district level.

This portal will aid district authorities in collaborative planning, infrastructure gap identification, and scheme implementation. A beta version of this portal has already been created for 28 aspirational districts, and user accounts were provided to these districts on September 18th, 2024. Trial runs of the portal are ongoing, with orientation programs in October 2024. The DMP portals for all the country's districts will be developed in a phased manner and completed by March 31, 25.

Key Accomplishments under PM GatiShakti National Master Plan (NMP)

The PM GatiShakti NMP has resulted in numerous achievements across various sectors, significantly improving project planning, speed, and execution.

The Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MoRTH) planned over 8,891 km of roads using NMP, while the Ministry of Railways (MoR) used NMP to plan more than 27,000 km of railway lines. MoR also accelerated the completion of Final Location Surveys (FLS), completing 449 FLS in FY '22 compared to 57 in FY '21.

The Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas (MoPNG) streamlined the process for Detail Route Survey (DRS), reducing the time required to create reports from 6-9 months to just one day using electronic DRS (eDRS).

Using NMP principles, a 13 GW renewable energy

project from Leh (Ladakh) to Kaithal (Haryana) achieved optimal alignment of the 'Green Energy Corridor' for inter-state transmissions.

- Goa used the NMP platform to develop a disaster management plan for flood-prone areas along the Amona River.
- The Uttar Pradesh government employed the State Master Plan (SMP) portal to identify locations for new schools in underserved areas via the Pahunch Portal.
- Gujarat planned its 300 km coastal corridor using NMP, which reduced the number of NoC permissions required for clearance from 28 to 13, enhancing connectivity between four districts while boosting tourism.
- The Department of School Education and Literacy used the NMP portal to link PM Shri Schools with local industries for district-specific skill training.
- The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare identified internet shadow areas and mapped sites for new healthcare facilities using NMP.
- The Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship utilized NMP to identify suitable locations for new training institutes near economic clusters.
- The Ministry of Rural Development integrated schemes such as PMGSY and PMAY-G for better asset planning and implementation.
- The Ministry of Tribal Affairs identified infrastructure gaps for Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTG) using the PM JanMan portal.
- These accomplishments highlight the NMP's broad utility in improving planning, efficiency, and collaboration across various ministries and sectors.

National Logistics Policy (NLP) 2022: Progress and Key Initiatives

The National Logistics Policy (NLP) was launched on 17th September 2022 to boost India's economic growth by creating an integrated, efficient, and costeffective logistics network. The policy aims to reduce logistics costs, improve India's Logistics Performance Index (LPI) ranking to be among the top 25 countries by 2030, and promote data-driven decision-making. Implementation is driven by the Comprehensive Logistics Action Plan (CLAP), focusing on areas such as digital logistics systems, asset standardization, human resource development, state engagement, and



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EXIM logistics.

The policy emphasizes training and capacitybuilding efforts in collaboration with the Capacity Building Commission (CBC). Training modules are integrated with Central and Administrative Training Institutes through webinars, workshops, and digital platforms.

State Logistics Plans (SLPs): 26 States and Union Territories have aligned with the National Logistics Policy (NLP) by notifying their State Logistics Policies to enhance focus on logistics in public policy.

LEADS Survey: The fifth edition of the Logistics Ease Across Different States (LEADS) report was launched in December 2023, with the sixth edition released in January 2024. LEADS assesses logistics ease based on infrastructure and services across States and UTs.

Unified Logistics Integrated Platform (ULIP): ULIP integrates 33 logistics-related systems across 10 Ministries, promoting innovation. Currently, over 930 private companies are registered, with 95 applications made live and 185 companies signing NDAs. ULIP also integrates GST data for end-to-end cargo tracking.

Logistics Data Bank (LDB): For tracking and tracing 100% of India's containerized EXIM cargo, the Logistics Data Bank (LDB), has been developed. LDB uses RFID technology through the Internet of Things (IoT), Big Data and Cloud-based solutions to provide real-time tracking of EXIM container movement in India. It is a single window, cloud-based

logistics visualization solution which provides container movement tracking using only the container numbers; from the Ports to Inland Container Depot's/ Container Freight Stations; and across the port associated Parking Plazas, Toll Plaza & Railways.

Improving LPI Rank

A dedicated LPI Action Plan has been created, involving multiple ministries (MoRTH, MoR, MoPSW, MoCA) to

address logistics challenges across six LPI parameters. Continuous engagement with the World Bank has resulted in discussions on logistics efficiency, reforms, and LPI methodology, along with a national workshop held in February 2024.

The policy incorporates global best practices, collaborating with the Asian Development Bank (ADB) and Korea's LPI improvement strategies. A round table with the World Bank was held in the U.S. in March 2024 to discuss innovative approaches and logistics improvements for India.

Through these efforts, NLP is driving India towards a more efficient logistics ecosystem while enhancing global competitiveness.

Gati Shakti Sanchar Portal

Universal and equitable access to Broadband services across the country, especially in the rural areas- is one of the most important visions of Prime Minister Narendra Modi. In line with the PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan, "Gati Shakti Sanchar" portal was launched for Centralised Right of Way (RoW) approvals on May 14, 2022.

The Gati Shakti Sanchar portal is a major reform brought in to facilitate faster rollout of telecom infrastructure. It is a Centralised Right of Way (RoW) Portal that enables applicants such as Telecom Service Providers/Infrastructure Providers / Internet Service Providers (TSP/IP/ISPs) to apply for RoW approvals. As on October 11, 2024, 2.11 lakh applications have been approved.

The portal is integrated with all 36 States /UTs and

The PM Gati Shakti initiative represents a transformative approach to infrastructure development in India, aiming to create a seamless and efficient multimodal transportation network. By integrating the efforts of various ministries and leveraging advanced technologies, this initiative seeks to enhance connectivity and reduce logistics costs across the nation with relevant central ministries viz. Ministry of Railways (MoR), Ministry of Road, Transport and Highways (MoRTH), Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC) and Ministry of Defence (MoD).

5G services were launched in India on 1st October 2022. More than 13 Cr subscribers have begun to use 5G services, making it the fastest roll-out of 5G anywhere in the world. To further improve telecom connectivity in the country,

Government is implementing various schemes.

A total of 41,160 mobile towers have been sanctioned with an outlay of Rs. 41,331 Cr to provide 4G connectivity to about 55 thousand villages. Scope of BharatNet program has been expanded to connect all inhabited villages with an outlay of 1.88 Lakh Cr.



Under the visionary leadership of Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, the program has played a pivotal role boosting domestic in manufacturing, fostering innovation, enhancing skill development, and facilitating foreign investment.

10 Years of Impact: A Snapshot

Foreign Direct Investment (FDI): Since 2014, India has attracted a cumulative FDI inflow of USD 667.4 billion (2014-24), registering an increase of 119% over the preceding decade (2004-14). This investment inflow spans 31

States and 57 sectors, driving growth across diverse industries. Most sectors, except certain strategically important sectors, are open for 100% FDI under the automatic route. FDI equity inflows into the manufacturing sector over the past decade (2014-24) reached USD 165.1 billion, marking a 69% increase compared to the previous decade (2004 -14), which saw inflows of USD 97.7 billion.

Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme: The PLI Schemes introduced in 2020 have resulted in



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Exports & India's Employment: merchandise exports surpassed USD 437 billion in FY 2023-24. Exports have surged, with an additional Rs. 4 lakh crore generated due to the PLI schemes, while total employment in the manufacturing sector increased from 57 million in 2017-18 to 64.4 million in 2022-23.

EaseofDoingBusiness:India'scommitment to improvingbusinessconditions isevident in its sharp risefrom 142nd rank in 2014to 63rd rank in 2019 in

the World Bank's Doing Business Report. Over 42,000 compliances have been reduced, and 3,700 provisions has been decriminalized. The Jan Vishwas (Amendment of Provisions) Act, 2023, passed by Lok Sabha on 27th July 2023 and Rajya Sabha on 2nd August 2023, which has decriminalized 183 provisions across 42 Central Acts.

Key Reforms

Semiconductor Ecosystem Development:

Semicon India Program, worth Rs. 76,000 crore, aims to provide an impetus to semiconductor and display manufacturing by facilitating capital support and technological collaborations. One-District-One-Product (ODOP): Promoting indigenous products and craftsmanship across India, the ODOP initiative has fostered local economic development, with Unity Malls being set up in 27 states to provide platforms for these unique products.

Startup India: The Government with intent to build a strong ecosystem for nurturing innovation and encouraging investments launched the Startup India initiative on 16th January 2016. Sustained efforts

by the Government under the Startup India initiative have led to an increase in the number of recognised startups to 1,40,803 as on 30th June 2024, which have created over 15.5 lakh direct jobs.

efence Minister, Shri Rajnath Singh on 12 October virtually inaugurated and dedicated 75 Border Roads Organisation road and bridge projects to the nation at a cost of Rs 2,236 crore.

These include 7 road and 12 bridge projects in Jammu & Kashmir worth Rs 731.22 crore virtually today. Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) Dr. Jitendra Singh, who is also Lok Sabha MP from J&K also joined the inauguration function virtually.

The J&K road projects are Bishnah-Kaulpur-Khojipur (Km 0.0 to 24.328) worth Rs.73.26crore, Basoli-Bani-Bhaderwah (Km 70.00 to 89.00) Rs.97.76 crore, Basoli-Bani-Bhaderwah (Km 89.00 to 102.00) Rs81.42 crore, Galhar-Sansari(Km 0 to 10) Rs.37.69 under Project Sampark of BRO. Bandipur-Gureizin Rs.230.54 crore, Mohura-Baaz Rs.134.99 and Tutmarigali-Kaiyan Bowl Rs24.35 crore under Project Beacon of BRO.

In addition, 12 bridges at Sawan, Sanu, Naigarh, Channani, Nantoo, Korga, Sewa-II, Biyalu, Dersu,

Nirunar, Gurai and Garjun were constructed at the cost of Rs 51.21 crore in different areas of J&K. Overall, these Projects have been constructed in 11 border States/UTs of the country, including Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

EPFO Adds 18.53 Lakh Net Members During August 2024 9.3 Lakh New Members Enrolled with EPFO during August 2024

The Employees' Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO) on 20 October released provisional payroll data for August 2024, revealing a net addition of 18.53 lakh members in the month of August 2024. This represents a 9.07% year-on-year growth compared to August 2023, signifying increased employment opportunities and heightened awareness of employee benefits, bolstered by EPFO's effective outreach initiatives.

New Membership:

EPFO enrolled around 9.30 lakh new members in August 2024, representing an increase of 0.48% in the new members from the previous year in August 2023. This surge in new memberships can be attributed to growing employment opportunities, increased awareness of employee benefits, and EPFO 's successful outreach programs.

Growth in Female Membership:

Gender-wise analysis of payroll data unveils that out of the new members added during the month, around 2.53 lakhs are new female members. This figure exhibits year-over-year growth of 3.75% compared to August 2023. Also, the net female member addition during the month stood at around 3.79 lakh. It reflects a year over year growth of 10.41% compared to August 2023. The surge in female member additions is indicative of a broader shift towards a more inclusive and diverse workforce.

CABINET APPROVES ADDITIONAL INSTALMENT OF 3% OF DA TO CENTRAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES AND DEARNESS RELIEF TO PENSIONERS

The Union Cabinet, chaired by the Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi on 16 October approved an additional instalment of Dearness Allowance (DA) to Central Government employees and Dearness Relief (DR) to pensioners w.e.f. 01.07.2024 representing an increase of three percent (3%) over the existing rate of 50% of the Basic Pay/Pension, to compensate against price rise.

This increase is in accordance with the accepted formula, which is based on the recommendations of the 7th Central Pay Commission. The combined impact on the exchequer on account of both DA and DR would be Rs.9,448.35 crore per annum. This will benefit about 49.18 lakh central government employees and 64.89 lakh pensioners.

PM MODI INAUGURATES SAHARANPUR, REWA AND AMBIKAPUR AIRPORTS UNDER RCS-UDAN

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi on 20 October inaugurated three airports, developed under the Regional Connectivity Scheme (RCS) – UDAN (Ude Desh Ka Aam Nagrik), from Varanasi in Uttar Pradesh. These airports are: Rewa in Madhya Pradesh, Ambikapur in Chhatisgarh and Saharanpur in UP. Flights under RCS-UDAN will begin from these airports shortly.

The RCS- UDAN, a government-backed initiative to improve infrastructure and connectivity in India, especially in remote and underserved regions, completes seven years. It is a vital component of India's National Civil Aviation Policy (NCAP) 2016, launched by the Ministry of Civil Aviation (MoCA) on October 21, 2016, with a 10-year vision.

The first RCS-UDAN flight was inaugurated by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi on April 27, 2017, connecting Shimla to Delhi. The scheme focuses on improving unserved air routes in underserved regions of the country and fulfilling the aspirations of the common citizens.

So far, the RCS-UDAN has facilitated travel of more than 144 lakh passengers, demonstrating its success in enhancing air travel accessibility.

CABINET APPROVES DEVELOPMENT OF NATIONAL MARITIME HERITAGE COMPLEX AT LOTHAL, GUJARAT

The Union Cabinet, chaired by the Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi on October 9 approved the development of National Maritime Heritage Complex (NMHC) at Lothal, Gujarat. The project will be completed in two phases.

The Cabinet also accorded in-principle approval for Phase 1B and Phase 2, as per master plan by raising funds through voluntary resources/ contributions and their execution after raising of the funds.

Construction of Light House Museum under Phase 1B will be funded by Directorate General of Lighthouses and Lightships (DGLL). Around 22,000 jobs are expected be created in development of NMHC project, with 15,000 direct employment and 7,000 indirect employments.

The implementation of NMHC will boost growth and immensely help the local communities, tourists and visitors, researchers and scholars, government bodies, educational institutions, cultural organisations, environment and conservation groups, businesses.

CABINET APPROVES MSP INCREASE FOR RABI CROPS FOR MARKETING SEASON 2025-26

The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) chaired by the Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi on 16 October approved the increase in the Minimum Support Prices (MSP) for all mandated Rabi Crops for Marketing Season 2025-26.

Government has increased the MSP of Rabi Crops for Marketing Season 2025-26, to ensure remunerative prices to the growers for their produce. The absolute highest increase in MSP has been announced for Rapeseed & Mustard at Rs.300 per quintal followed by Lentil (Masur) at Rs.275 per quintal. For gram, wheat, safflower and barley, there is an increase of Rs.210 per quintal, Rs.150 per quintal, Rs.140 per quintal and Rs.130 per quintal respectively.

CABINET APPROVES ROAD CONSTRUCTION IN BORDER AREAS OF RAJASTHAN AND PUNJAB

he Union Cabinet, chaired by the Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi on 9 October approved

construction of 2,280 km roads in border areas of Rajasthan and Punjab at an investment of Rs 4,406 crore emphasizing development of infrastructure in border areas.

The project is a result of a change in mindset that has accorded a special focus on development of border areas with facilities similar to other parts of the country.

This decision will have a major impact on the road and telecom connectivity, and facilities of water supply, health and education. It will also enhance rural livelihood, ease travel, and ensure connectivity of these areas with rest of the highway network.

INDIGENOUS 'SAMARTHAK' LAUNCHED

The first ship of the two Multi-Purpose Vessel project, being built by L&T, Shipyard for the Indian Navy, was launched on 14 Oct 24 at L&T, Kattupalli. In keeping with the maritime traditions, the ship was launched. The ship has been named 'Samarthak' which means 'Supporter' and is synonymous to the muti-dimensional role envisaged from the platform.

The contract for building two Multi Purpose Vessel was signed between the Ministry of Defence and L&T Shipyard on 25 Mar 22. These Multi Purpose Vessels will be capable of towing ships, launch and recover various targets, operate uncrewed autonomous vehicles and act as a trial platform for various indigenous weapons and sensors under development. The Multi Purpose Vessels can achieve a maximum speed of 15 knots and are 106 m long and 16.8 wide.

The Indian Navy remains steadfast in its efforts towards indigenous shipbuilding. The launch of this vessel by private Indian shipyard showcases Indian Navy's strides in indigenous shipbuilding, in consonance with Govt of India vision for 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat' and ' Make in India' initiative.

NAMAMI GANGE MISSION 2.0: COMPLETION OF 4 MAJOR SEWERAGE INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS IN UTTAR PRADESH AND BIHAR

Under Namami Gange Mission 2.0, Ministry of Jal Shakti completed of four key projects in the second quarter of the financial year 2024-25. These projects, located in Uttar Pradesh and Bihar, are specifically aimed at preventing sewage from entering



the river, improving water quality, and rejuvenating the rivers. This initiative will help in maintaining the sanctity of the Ganga and its tributaries, a crucial step for the country.

These projects have been developed at a total cost of Rs 492 crore, aimed at enhancing waste water treatment in various regions. In Patna-Danapur, Bihar a 25 MLD Sewage Treatment Plant (STP), along with an I&D network, has been completed at a cost of Rs.103 crore. Similarly, in Patna -Maner, Bihar an STP with a capacity of 6.5 MLD, along with I&D network, completed at a cost of Rs.70 crore.

In Kairana, Uttar Pradesh a 15 MLD STP along with I&D network has been completed, at a total cost of Rs.78 crore. This project, located on the Yamuna River, follows the Design, Build, Operate, and Transfer (DBOT) model. Additionally, in Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh, a major project to rejuvenate the Gomti River led to the successful completion of a 39 MLD STP at a total cost of Rs.241 crore.

Agreement has been signed for development of a Saharanpur, Uttar Pradesh project approved under Namami Gange-II with financial assistance from the World Bank. A tripartite agreement has been signed for the conservation of the Hindon River's tributaries— Pawandhoi and Dhamola—in Saharanpur. This agreement was signed between the NMCG, Uttar Pradesh Jal Nigam (Rural), and M/s EIEL Infra Engineers (Saharanpur) Pvt Ltd (a consortium of M/s Enviro Infra Engineers Ltd, M/s Bhugan Infracon Pvt Ltd, and M/s Micro Transmission Systems SPV).

This projects includes construction of 135 MLD STP, sewage pumping stations, and interception structures, with a total cost of Rs.344 crore. The project will operate on a Hybrid Annuity PPP Model and include a 15-year O&M provision.

Pm Shri Narendra Modi always had the idea of setting up a vibrant economic hub in India – which he realised as the Gift City in Gujarat. One of his colleagues relate a visit of his to US in the 1990s as a referral point for this project.

According to Shri CK Patel, a businessman from Gujarat based in the US, Shri Modi was very curious about the central business district of Los Angeles, when he travelled to US in the 1997. "One night, I took him to Downtown Los Angeles. During that walk, the vision for Gift City began to take shape. As we explored the area, Narendrabhai said 'Downtown is a concentrated area with skyscrapers. This is where the economy thrives, with banks, corporate offices, and large institutions driving the city," Shri Patel added.

What Shri Narendra Modi saw in the US likely sowed the seeds for what would later become the Gift City in Gujarat, according to Shri Patel. He said when he accompanied Shri Modi to the seashore in Los Angeles, Shri Modi saw high-rise buildings, tourists, and bustling restaurants. He asked him, "Why can't we develop (Gujarat) in the same way. It too has a vast coastline like here".

"It was fascinating to see how Shri Modi connected everything he saw in the US to the potential development of India. Whenever he saw something new, he would ask questions, and link it to how it could be beneficial back home," Shri Patel

said.

There was another incident that Shri Patel recalls while they were driving. Shri Narendra Modi heard a weird sound when the car moved slightly offside. "Curious, he asked me, 'What is that sound? It's similar to the noise you hear during a flat tyre. Why is it happening?'".

"I explained to him that there were no issues with the tyres. In the US, roads are built in a way that the vehicles start making a sound when they start drifting off the road," Shri Patel said. Shri Modi has always been very curious about new technologies and wanted to know how those roads were built.

Chri Harinarayan Arora, a OSwayamsevak from Port Blair. was instrumental in establishing the Hindi Sahitya Kala Parishad in 1962. 

India's First Indigenous Semiconductor Assembly and Testing Facility, Morigaon Assam: In an effort to decentralize the semiconductor industry and bring development to new regions, Tata Electronics is setting up India's first greenfield semiconductor assembly and testing facility in Morigaon, Assam. With an investment of INR 27,000 crore, this facility will create over 27,000 jobs and serve as a critical hub for semiconductor assembly, testing, and packaging.

The plant will focus on wire bond, flip chip, and integrated systems

packaging (ISP) technologies, with a capacity to produce 48 million chips daily. Operations are expected to commence by mid-2025, making this facility a cornerstone of India's semiconductor ambitions in the northeastern region.

4.CG Power's OSAT Facility, Sanand, Gujarat: The Murugappa Group's C G Power, in partnership with Renesas

Laid by Prime Minister Narendra Modi in March 2024, the Dholera plant will focus on sectors such as automotive, computing, communications, and AI, with the first batch of semiconductors expected by December 2026

Electronics Corporation Stars from Japan and Microelectronics from Thailand. is developing an advanced OSAT facility in Sanand, Gujarat. With a planned investment of INR 7,600 crore over five years, this facility will cater to industries such as automotive, consumer electronics, and 5G technology. This facility will produce a range semiconductor products of and is expected to create 5,000 jobs. Over the next three

years, the plant aims to scale up production to 1.5 crore units daily, further bolstering India's semiconductor manufacturing capacity.

5. Kaynes Semicon Plant, Gujarat: In a significant move to expand India's semiconductor production capabilities. the Union Cabinet approved Kaynes Semicon's proposal to set up an OSAT unit in Sanand, Gujarat. With an investment of INR 3,307 crore, this facility is set to produce 6.3 million chips daily. The government is offering 50% capital investment support under the ISM's modified scheme, reinforcing India's efforts to offer a competitive alternative to China in the global semiconductor landscape.

Inclusion of Youth, Academia and Industry:

Under Modi Govt's National Semiconductor Mission, Currently, 113 universities. academic institutions, and research organizations across India have incorporated semiconductorfocused courses. tailored in collaboration with industry leaders. These programs aim to align academic knowledge with real-world industry needs, ensuring that graduates are ready

to contribute to the semiconductor landscape.

For I AM instance. the Research's Semiverse program, running in 74 universities, has trained over 2.600 students this year alone. This initiative is expected to expand massively in the coming years. In another key development, AMD's Global Design Center in Bengaluru has opened, currently employing 5,000 engineers, with further expansions planned. These academic and industry linkages are setting the stage for India to become a major player in global semiconductor design and manufacturing.

India's existing strength in semiconductor design is another critical pillar of the Semiconductor Mission. The country already boasts over 300,000 engineers working in chip design across various companies, with 52,000 of them engaged in leadingedge, complex chip designs. This design capability has drawn international interest,

and the government's support for the sector is evident. Thirteen design ecosystem partners have received financial assistance through the program, with several attracting venture capital interest, signaling strong growth potential in this area.

Recognizing the strategic importance of semiconductors, the Modi government has decided to enhance its chip manufacturing incentive policy, increasing the funding outlay for the second phase of the ISM to \$15 billion, up from \$10 billion in the first phase. This expanded financial support is crucial for ensuring the successful establishment of these critical facilities and accelerating India's emergence as a global semiconductor hub.

is not only addressing the critical need for domestic semiconductor manufacturing but also reinforcing the country's strategic autonomy and global influence. The mission's emphasis on building а comprehensive semiconductor ecosystemincluding fabrication plants, assembly units, and research facilities-positions India as a key player in the global

supply chain, enhancing national security and economic stability. AAP HAS BROUGHT PUNJAB TO A DARK AGE

Punjab, once known as a golden land of prosperity, famous for its rich heritage and culture, is now crying for a new life. The state is beleaguered by crisis, all around, be it economic, industrial or agricultural. Once one of India's most prosperous states, it has become a laggard state today.

As the present AAP government has failed on all fronts we see that social unrest has plagued the state in an alarming manner. The people of Punjab aspire for better living standards, including better healthcare, education, employment, infrastructure, and law and order.

The Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) government in Punjab, with CM Bhagwant Mann, has failed in performance since assuming office in March 2022. From day one, the CM has let down the expectations of the people of Punjab. The disrespect shown by removing the photo of Sher-e-Punjab Maharaja Ranjit Singh from the CMO has deeply hurt the sentiments of Punjabis. Maharaja Ranjit Singh is a great symbol of Punjab's pride, valor, and courage. This act of CM is still etched in the minds of Punjabis.

The administration has failed to deliver on many of its key promises, leading to insecurity among people. One of the most pressing issues is the instability within the government itself, with four cabinet reshuffles in two and a half years, highlighting a lack of well-structured plan and direction. These frequent reshuffles have not converted into better governance or service delivery, a clear sign of deeper systemic issues within the administration. Frequent reshuffles speak of instability of the government and governance and lack of confidence within AAP leadership.

Despite being in power for two and a half years and completing half the term, the AAP government has failed to maintain basic infrastructure, provide civic amenities to citizens, and tackle pressing issues such as drug abuse and unemployment.

Financial mismanagement has emerged as a major critical concern during this tenure. Punjab is grappling with a staggering debt of Rs. 3.51 lakh crore, and the government's borrowing spree has only worsened the situation, the AAP government is reaching out to the central government for an additional borrowing limit of Rs 10,000 crore to meet its expenses over and above the sanctioned borrowing limit of Rs 30,464.92 crore. This financial strain has led to delays in salary and pension disbursements for state employees, raisina auestions about the government's fiscal responsibility. There is a lack of transparency and accountability in financial dealings. The AAP government lacks financial discipline; this is evident by the way the government is handling debt and borrowing. The state is getting into a vicious loop by taking on new debt while still paying down part of its existing debt to pay for capital expenditures and debt payments. This leaves us with many unanswered questions. How does the state plan to manage its debt and what specific measures have been taken to reduce it since the CM assumed the office? With the current debt repayment obligations standing at Rs 69,867 crore for this fiscal year, how does the government justify seeking additional borrowing? The government needs to provide a detailed plan on how it intends to curb unnecessary spending and improve financial discipline. The AAP government needs to come out with answers to many such questions, and we demand a White Paper on the financial handling. This is nothing but a clear failure of AAP's government's policies, and the situation demands an urgent need for reforms. The AAP government has pushed Punjab into bankruptcy, and its rising outstanding debts year by year have caused great financial concern.

The government's promise to rejuvenate the mining sector and generate substantial revenue has also fallen flat, instead of the projected Rs. 20,000 crore during the 2022 assembly elections, actual revenue from mining activities has barely reached Rs. 300 crore annually. On top of this, there has been rampant illegal mining across Punjab under the AAP government rule, which speaks of the government being hand in glove with the mining mafia. Having appointed the fourth mining minister in two and a half years of their term points out the AAP government's failure to manage critical sectors like mining.

The infrastructure development and basic civic amenities have not kept pace with growing demands from people across urban and rural Punjab. There is widespread dissatisfaction regarding inadequate public services and facilities. The government has failed to address these issues effectively.

Unemployment remains another critical challenge for the AAP government. Although it claims to have created jobs across various state departments, unemployment is still a major concern. Following this is a migration issue. What is the root cause of migration? Is it the lack of a better education system or lack of Job opportunities, or is it the drug menace that has gripped Punjab? The AAP Government does not seem to be finding solutions for these.

The issue of drug abuse and drug trafficking continues to plague Puniab, with the state being labelled as one of the epicenters of drug abuse in India. Drug addiction has devastated many young lives across all social classes in both urban and rural areas. Despite Chief Minister Mann's commitment to making Punjab drug-free by the next Independence Day, drug-related deaths have surged since AAP came into power, and there are a large number of fatalities recorded. The establishment of de-addiction centers and government Outpatient Opioid Assisted Treatment (OOAT) clinics has not yielded significant The results. rural healthcare system is plagued by insufficient infrastructure, persistent shortages of medicines, and understaffing.

The law-and-order situation in Punjab has completely collapsed. Gangsters make ransom calls from the jail, and there exists large-scale corruption among jail authorities. There is a serious sense of fear and panic among the people in the State. The Aam Aadmi Party in Punjab has failed to curtail ransoms, lootings, and killings. Day by day, there is an increased number of such reported incidents.

In terms of performance and governance, the AAP government has lost its credibility to effectively run the Chief Minister's office. As of today, scams and failures in various government departments are being exposed almost daily. The AAP government, under Bhagwant Mann as Chief Minister of Punjab, has failed miserably.

There is an urgent need for the revival of governance in Punjab. The AAP government must bring reforms to address these multifaceted challenges. The need for stable leadership in Punjab can only be fulfilled by a double-engine government, with the BJP holding the mantle of power in Punjab.

Today, the AAP government in Punjab has become infamous for its financial mismanagement. The government has driven Punjab into a financial mess by increasing VAT on diesel, petrol, and bus fares and, at the same time, creating a debt trap for the state. Failure to clear bills for hospitals preventing free healthcare for the poor under the Ayushman Bharat Health Scheme, recent mishandling of English teacher promotions, failure to regularise teachers, a shortage of medical officers in the government hospitals, rollback of power subsidies, and failure to fill vacant posts in various government departments have all contributed to the state's failures. The presence of gangsters running the state and failure to make Punjab drug-free as promised in their manifesto reflects poor governance and a deteriorating law and order situation. The AAP government has failed to fulfill its promises to the people of Punjab and betrayed the mandate given to them.

The history of the Aam Aadmi Party has been full of hypocrisy in matters related to corruption. Since its inception, Arvind Kejriwal and the Aam Aadmi Party have made massive claims about removing corruption; however, reports of sand mafia, excise scams, and other financial irregularities suggest otherwise. The AAP came to power through false promises, and their manifesto remains an empty promise. Today, corruption is at its peak in Punjab. The corruption king, Arvind Kejriwal, might be out on bail from jail, but the legacy seems to be continued by AAP leaders, whether in Delhi or Punjab.

These are just a few of the burning issues that have created a sense of insecurity and fear in the minds of the people of Punjab. It is time for the Punjab CM to step down for his failure in running the state and to provide relief to the people. Punjab needs a capable leader, and the administration requires complete rehabilitation, with the BJP being the only party capable of providing stable and good governance for a prosperous Punjab.

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi laid the foundation stone and inaugurated multiple development projects in Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh on 20 October 2024. The projects include multiple airport projects worth over Rs 6,100 crore and multiple development initiatives in Varanasi.

The Prime Minister highlighted that today UP was known as 'state of expressways' as against the past when it was taunted for its dilapidated roads. He added that today UP was also known as a state with the most number of international airports with a grand international airport going to be built soon in Jewar, Noida.

Make Kashi and Purvanchal a huge center of trade

The Prime Minister said that it is the Government's constant endeavor to make Kashi and Purvanchal a huge center of trade and business as he mentioned the construction of a new rail-road bridge over River Ganga a few days ago which would comprise a 6 lane highway and railway lines for several trains. He said that it would hugely benefit the people of Varanasi and Chandauli.

Prime Minister Modi said, "We have done our work with sincerity, implemented policies with good intentions and strive to improve the lives of every family in the country". PM Modi participates in 21st ASEAN-India Summit and the 19th East Asia Summit

The Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi was on two days (10th & 11th October) visit of Vientiane in Lao PDR for the 21st ASEAN-India Summit and the 19th East Asia Summit at the invitation of Prime Minister Siphandone of Lao PDR. It was Prime Minister's 10th attendance at the ASEAN-India Summit

The significance of this particular summit was that it was also the 10th anniversary of Prime Minister's Act East policy. Prime Minister along with other Heads of State and Government of ASEAN countries, reviewed the progress in the relations between India and ASEAN over this time. And they also planned the future direction of our relationship. ASEAN leaders especially very positively appraised India's cooperation in many areas of diverse collaboration as a result of India's 'Act East' policy and also, they appraised very positively India's leadership role in digital public infrastructure and the fact that ASEAN countries can benefit significantly from this.

Prime Minister congratulated Lao PDR on a very successful stewardship of ASEAN and related mechanisms throughout the year and he announced a 10-point special plan to strengthen connectivity and resilience with ASEAN. These involve a wide variety of initiatives that India is taking with ASEAN. They include, for example, celebrating next year as the ASEAN-India Year of Tourism. The ASEAN leaders all universally welcomed this as a very positive development. It was also announced that India will contribute \$5 million towards joint cooperative activities in this area. To mark this decade of 'Act East' policy, several people-to-people and peoplecentric initiatives were announced like Youth Summit, music festival of ASEAN bands with Indian bands, an Artist Camp, a Hackathon, Startup Festival, the Delhi Dialogue. The ASEAN-India Network of Think Tanks will also meet next month.

Another important initiative is the ASEAN-India Women Scientists' Conclave, which it has been decided to institutionalize, and it will be funded by the ASEAN-India Science and Technology Development Fund. The number of scholarships from Nalanda University will be nearly doubled for ASEAN students,



and we emphasized also that secure, resilient and reliable supply chains are an important aspect of our relations with ASEAN countries, and for that we will also expedite our discussions on the review of the ASEAN-India Free Trade in Goods Agreement by 2025.

India will also contribute \$5 million towards disaster resilience, and the National Disaster Management Authority and the ASEAN Coordinating Center for Humanitarian Assistance have a working relationship and an MoU, and they will work together on this. In the field of health, is also planning to institute a new Health Ministers' Track and also a Cooperative Framework for ASEAN countries to tap India's National Cancer-Grid 'Vishwam'. In digital and cyber resilience, India propose a regular mechanism for ASEAN-India Cyber Dialogue, and its first meeting is scheduled next week in Singapore, and the ASEAN-India Fund for the Digital Future has also been institutionalized and operationalized. We will also have a workshop on Green Hydrogen with ASEAN towards climate resilience. The Prime Minister invited ASEAN leaders to join the campaign to plant a tree for mother, 'Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam',

The 21st ASEAN-India Summit adopted two declarations, two statements at the leader level. One was a Statement on the 'Act East' policy and its contribution to ASEAN-India relations, the Comprehensive Strategic Partnership that we have, and another on Advancing Digital Transformation in the region. As you know, Singapore has been our coordinator in ASEAN for the past three years and the Prime Minister appreciated Singapore's role in this and also welcomed the fact that Philippines will be our coordinator as we go forward for the next three years.

At the East Asia Summit Prime Minister conveyed India's support for ASEAN unity and centrality and ASEAN's importance as a central pillar of our own Indo-Pacific vision and of Quad cooperation, and that the East Asia Summit is an important pillar also of India's 'Act East' policy. The Prime Minister recalled the support that was received from the East Asia Summit states for revival of Nalanda University and briefed them that we have now operationalized this and the new campus of Nalanda University was inaugurated in June this year and he also took this opportunity to invite the East Asia Summit states for their Heads of Higher Education to participate in a conclave that will be held in Nalanda University.

Leaders exchanged views on regional and international matters that affect peace, stability and prosperity in the Indo-Pacific region and beyond, and Prime Minister underlined the severe impact of these conflicts on countries of the Global South; and also highlighted that path of dialogue and diplomacy based on a humanitarian approach is the only way forward, and that he reiterated that there was no solution that can be found on the battlefield.

Prime Minister also had several bilateral meetings. Prime Minister had the bilateral meeting with the newly appointed Prime Minister of Japan, Mr. Shigeru Ishiba and he congratulated Prime Minister Ishiba on assuming his new role and wished him success in leading Japan to greater heights. Both leaders emphasized the importance of the bilateral relationship.

Prime Minister also had a meeting with the Prime Minister of New Zealand, Prime Minister Christopher Luxon on the sidelines and this was the first meeting between the two leaders, so Prime Minister used this opportunity to congratulate him and the two Prime Ministers discussed ways to strengthen bilateral cooperation in a number of areas including agri-tech, dairy-tech, in defence and security, in education, climate change, sports cooperation, tourism, space and people-to-people ties.

With the Prime Minister of Lao PDR, Prime Minister Modi had a meeting. These talks covered the entire gamut of our bilateral relations. They held productive discussions on how to strengthen our civilizational and contemporary ties. Prime Minister congratulated Prime Minister Sonexay Siphandone on the very successful conduct of the ASEAN and related summits.

Six MOUs were signed, one on defence cooperation, another on customs facilitation, one on audio-visual cooperation and three Memoranda of Understanding on quick impact projects which were especially significant because they contribute towards the conservation of our common heritage. One is on the puppet theatre in Lao PDR that is based on the Ramayana, then one of them is on the restoration work in one of the monasteries and temples here in Lao PDR which has murals from the Ramayana, and a third on Lao Ramayana theater; and these initiatives were greatly appreciated by the Lao leadership.

Prime Minister also called on President Sisoulith and the President has been to India in the previous role as Prime Minister during the 2018 ASEAN-India Commemorative Summit, so he recounted his very positive impressions at that time and having met Prime Minister Modi at that time and Prime Minister invited him to visit India again as well.

Prime Minister also had a bilateral meeting with the new Prime Minister of Thailand, Ms. Paetongtarn Shinawatra and Prime Minister congratulated her on assuming this role and this was their first meeting and she extended her greetings to Prime Minister on his historic third term in office. They discussed bilateral relations as well as the very positive cooperation that we have under the BIMSTEC arrangement.

Prime Minister also had brief interactions with other world leaders such as President Marcos of the Philippines, the President of the European Council, Prime Minister of Malaysia and the Prime Minister of Australia.
