

PM ALSO VISITS THE EXHIBITION MODELS OF UTTAR PRADESH DEFENCE INDUSTRIAL CORRIDOR


rime Minister Shri Narendra Modi on 14 September laid the foundation stone of Raja Mahendra Pratap Singh State University in Aligarh. He also visited the exhibition models of the Aligarh node of Uttar Pradesh Defence Industrial Corridor.

Addressing the event, the Prime Minister remembered the late Kalyan Singh ji. He said that Kalyan Singh Ji would have been very happy to see the emerging profile of Aligarh in the defence sector and the establishment of Raja Mahendra Pratap Singh State University in Aligarh.

FDI INFLOWS GROW 62% DURING FIRST FOUR MONTHS OF CURRENT FINANCIAL YEAR OVER CORRESPONDING PERIOD LAST YEAR

Measures taken by the Modi government on the fronts of FDI policy reforms, investment facilitation and 'Ease of Doing Business' have resulted in increased FDI inflows into the country. The following trends in India's Foreign Direct Investment are an endorsement of its status as a preferred investment destination amongst global investors:

India has attracted total FDI inflow of US\$ 27.37 billion during first four months of F.Y. 2021-22 which is 62% higher as compared to corresponding period of F.Y. 2020-21 (US\$ 16.92 billion).

FDI equity inflow grew by 112% in the first four months of F.Y. 2021-22 (US\$ 20.42 billion) compared to the year ago period (US\$ 9.61 billion).

'Automobile Industry' has emerged as the top sector during the first four months of F.Y. 2021-22 with 23% share of the total FDI Equity inflow followed by Computer Software & Hardware (18%) and Services Sector (10%) respectively.



Under the sector `Automobile Industry', majority of FDI Equity inflow (87%) was reported in the state of Karnataka during the first four months of the current financial year (2021-22). Karnataka is the top recipient state during the F.Y. 2021-22 (upto July, 2021) with 45% share of the total FDI Equity inflows followed by Maharashtra (23%) and Delhi (12%).

CENTRE ENHANCES FINANCIAL SUPPORT TO OPEN AYUSH COLLEGES

The central government on 11 September has increased the financial support from Rs. nine crore to Rs. 70 crore to ensure more Ayush colleges are opened across the country, Union Minister for Ayush and Ports, Shipping Waterways, Sarbananda Sonowal, said on 11 September. The Minister was addressing conference on 'Diverse а and Fulfilling Career Paths in Systems: Education. Avush Entrepreneurship & Employment Focus on North eastern States' in Guwahati.

The Union minister said that there are only a few Ayush colleges in the North-East and the Indian traditional medicine systems can only be popularised by making available more qualified practitioners.

The minister also announced the starting Panchkarma Technician course affiliated to Health Sector Skill Council - National Development Skill Corporation at Central Ayurveda Research Institute (CARI), Guwahati with 10 seats

for 10+2 students to produce skilled manpower for Panchkarma therapy in NE region and enhance the employment opportunities in that part of the country.

"Career opportunities in the Ayush sector for professionals of all disciplines have increased dramatically during recent years. Moreover, consequent to these efforts, faith in the Ayush cesystems has been restored



among communities worldwide," Shri Sonowal said. He added that Ayush has a great potential to cater to a large number of healthcare needs of people and contribute to the growth and development of this country.

Minister of Health & Family Welfare and Science & Technology and Information & Broadcasting in the Government of Assam, Keshab Mahanta, was the guest of honour at the conference.

DAILY WHOLESALE PRICES OF EDIBLE OILS DROP SIGNIFICANTLY POST REDUCTION IN STANDARD RATE OF DUTY

ollowing Centre's bold move to slash standard rate of duty on edible oils to check prices, a massive difference on daily wholesale prices was reported.

The daily wholesale prices of packed Palm Oil dropped by 2.50% followed by Seasame Oil by 2.08%, Coconut Oil by 1.72%, packed Ground Nut Oil by 1.38%, packed Sunflower Oil by 1.30%, packed Mustard Oil by 0.97%, packed Vanaspati by 0.71% and packed Soya Oil by 0.68%.

Based on the interaction with all the States and Edible Oil Industry Associations, need for greater transparency was felt. As a follow up action the Department of Food and Public Distribution is in the process of creating a web portal for monitoring the

stocks of Edible Oils/Oilseeds on a weekly basis in the country. The data on the portal will be submitted by millers, refiners, stockists and wholesalers etc. States have also issued directions for display of retail price prominently to ensure fair pricing.

The Government of India, Vide Notification No. 42/2021- Customs, dated 10th September 2021, further reduced the standard rate of duty on

Crude Palm Oil, Crude Soyabean oil and Crude Sunflower Oil to 2.5% with effect from 11, September 2021.

The standard rate of duty on Refined Palm Oils, Refined Soyabean oil and Refined Sunflower Oil to 32.5% with effect from 11 September 2021.

MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE SIGNS 5 MOUS FOR TAKING FORWARD DIGITAL AGRICULTURE

'MOUS AIMED AT INCREASING FARMERS INCOME AND PROTECTING THEIR PRODUCE'

Modernisation of the Agriculture sector will continue by infusing new technologies so that farmers can increase their income. Agriculture Minister Shri Narendra Singh Tomar stated this at the MOU signing ceremony at KrishiBhavan on September 14. MOUs were signed for pilot projects with CISCO, Ninjacart, Jio Platforms Limited, ITC Limited and NCDEX e-Markets Limited (NeML).

Based on these pilot projects farmers will be able to take informed decisions on what crop to grow, what variety of seed to use and what best practises to adopt to maximise the yield. The agriculture supply chain players can plan their procurement and logistics on precise and timely information. Farmers can take informed decisions about whether to sell or store their produce and when and where and what price to sell.

A Digital agriculture mission has been initiated for 2021 -2025 by government for projects based on new technologies like artificial intelligence, block chain, remote sensing and GIS technology, use of drones and robots etc. Any attempt to transform Agriculture sector needs to imbibe an ecosystem thinking and a digital ecosystem. The Agriculture value chain extends from crop selection to crop management and the market; it involves public and private players in agricultural inputs and services and also logistics.

Establishing a digital ecosystem of agriculture needs to take a long-term view of aspects like interoperability,



data governance, data quality, data standards, security and privacy, besides promoting innovation. A significant requirement is adoption of a decentralized, federated architecture that assures autonomy to the service providers and all other actors and ensures interoperability at the same time. Recoanizina the importance of Digitization in Agriculture the Department is creating a federated Farmers Database and building different Services around this Database so as to built Digital Ecosystems of Agriculture. Federated farmers' database will be linked by the land records of farmers from across the country and unique Farmer ID will be created. Under this unified database for all farmers the information of all benefits and supports of various schemes of Central & State Government can be kept and this can be the source for accessing information for providing benefits to farmers in the future. So far, the database is ready with details of around 5.5 crore farmers.

MyGov LAUNCHES PLANETARIUM INNOVATION CHALLENGE FOR INDIAN START-UPS AND TECH ENTREPRENEURS

MyGov India, under the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), has launched the Planetarium Innovation Challenge for Indian start-ups and tech entrepreneurs in the second week of September .The challenge aims to bring together the tech firms and Start-ups (based out of India) with the potential to build an indigenous planetariums system software using latest technologies including Augmented Reality (A.R.), Virtual Reality (V.R.) and Merged Reality (M.R.).

Inspired by the Chandrayaan launches, Indian Space Research Organization conducted the ISRO Quiz competition 2019 in collaboration with MyGov where several schools, parents and enthusiastic mentors made it memorable through their active participation. Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi was accompanied by the Quiz winners from across the country to watch Chandrayaan 2 lunar landing live from the ISRO control room. 'We will succeed, no one can stop India', said PM to ISRO scientists, inspiring space enthusiasts all across the nation.

DHARMA SUSTAINS THE SOCIETY

We shall have to examine the reasons why the state was established. No one will dispute that the state must have some specific aim, some ideal. Then this aim or ideal must consider to be of highest importance rather then the state which is created to fulfil this ideal. A watchman is not deemed greater than the treasure he is supposed to protect, nor is a treasure. The state is brought into existence to protect the nation: produce and maintain conditions in which the ideals of the nation can be translated into reality. The ideals of the nation constitute "Chiti", which is analogous to the soul of an individual. It requires some effort to comprehend Chiti. The laws that help manifest and maintain Chiti of a Nation are termed Dharma of that nation. Hence it is this "Dharma" that is supreme. Dharma is the repository of the nation's soul. If Dharma is destroyed, the Nation perishes. Anyone who abandons Dharma betrays the nation.

Dharma is not confined to temples or mosques. Worship of God is only a part of Dharma. Dharma is much wider. In the past, temples have served as effective medium to educate people in their Dharma. However just as schools themselves do not constitute knowledge, so also temples do not constitute Dharma. A child may attend school regularly and yet may remain uneducated. So also, it is possible that a person may visit temple or mosque without break and yet he may not know his Dharma. To attend temple or mosque constitutes a part of religion, sect., creed, but not necessarily "Dharma". Many misconceptions that originated from faulty English translations, include this most harmful confusion of Dharma with religion.

DHARMA AND RELIGION ARE DIFFERENT

On the one hand we used the word religion as synonymous with "Dharma" and on the other hand increasing ignorance, neglect of our society and Dharma, and greater acceptance of European life, became the outstanding features of our education. As a result all the characteristics of a narrow religion, especially as practiced in the West were attributed automatically to the concept of Dharma also. Since in the West, injustice atrocities, were perpetrated, bitter conflicts and battles were fought in the name of religion, all these were unblock listed on the debit

side of "Dharma" also. We felt that in the name of Dharma also battles were fought. However battles of religion and battles for Dharma are two different things. Religion means a creed or a sect; it does not mean Dharma. Dharma is very wide concept. It is concerned with all aspects of life. It sustains the society. Even further, it sustains the whole world. That which sustains is "Dharma".

The fundamental principles of Dharma are eternal and universal. Yet, their implementation may differ according to time, place and circumstances. It is a fact that a human being requires food for maintaining his body. However, what a particular person should eat in, how much quantity, at what intervals is all decided according to circumstances. It is possible at times that even fasting is advisable. If a typhoid patient is given normal food, the consequences may

be disastrous. For such a person, keeping away from food is necessary, similarly the principles of Dharma have to be adapted to changing times and space.

Some rules are temporary and others are valid for longer periods. There are some rules regulating our conduct at this meeting. One of the rules is that I speak and you listen with attention. If in contravention of this rule, you start conversing with one another or addressing the gathering at the same time, than there will be disorder; our work will not progress: the meeting will not be sustained. It can be said that you have not observed your Dharma. Thus it is our Dharma that we observed your Dharma. Thus it is our Dharma that we observed the rules by winch the meeting proceeds smoothly. But this rule is applicable only as long as this meeting lasts. If after the meeting is over, even when you reach home, you continue to

observe this rule and do not speak, a different problem will arise. Your family might have to call in a doctor. At home, the rules suitable there will have to be observed. The complete treatise on the rules in general, and their philosophical basis is the meaning of Dharma. These rules cannot be arbitrary. They

should be such as to sustain and further existence and progress of the entity which they serve. At the same time they should be in agreement with and supplementary to the larger framework of Dharma of which they form a part. For instance, when we form a registered society, we have the right to frame the rules and regulations, but these cannot be contradictory to the constitution of the society. The constitution itself cannot violate the Societies Registration Act. The act has to be within the provision of the constitution of the country. In other words, the constitution of the country is a fundamental document which governs the formulation of all acts in the country. In Germany the constitution is known as the "Basic Law".

Is the constitution too, not subject to some principles of more fundamental nature? Or is it a product of any arbitrary decisions of the constituent assembly? On serious consideration, it will be clear that even the constitution has to follow certain basic principles of Nature. Constitution is for sustaining the

nation. If instead it is instrumental in its deterioration, then it must be pronounced improper. It must be amended. The amendment is also not solely dependent on majority opinion. Now-a-days the majority is much talked of. Is the majority capable of doing anything and everything? Is the action of the majority always just and proper? No. In the West, the king used to be the sovereign. There after when royalty was deprived of its so-called divine rights, sovereignty was proclaimed to be with the people. Here in Our country neither the kings, nor the people, nor the parliament have had absolute sovereignty. Parliament cannot legislate arbitrarily.

It is said about the British parliament that it is sovereign and can do anything. They say that "British Parliament can do everything except making a woman a man and vice versa." But is it possible for

the parliament to legislate that every Englishman must walk on his head? It is not possible. Can they pass an act that everyone in England must present himself before the local authority once everyday? They cannot. England has no written constitution. They regard

England has no written constitution. They regard tradition highly. But their traditions too have undergone change. What is the basis for making changes in their traditions? Whichever tradition proved an obstacle in the progress of England, was discarded. Those which

The traditions are respected everywhere, just as in England. We have written constitution, but even this written constitutions cannot go contrary to the traditions of this country. In as much as it does go contrary to our traditions, it is not fulfilling Dharma. That constitution which sustains the nation is in tune with Dharma. Dharma sustains the nation. Hence we have always given primary importance to Dharma, which is considered sovereign. All other entities, institutions or authorities derive their power from Dharma and are subordinate to it.


RAJMATA VIJAYA RAJE SCINDHIA

SHAT SHAT NAMAN!

ajmata Smt. Vijaya Raje Scindhia is remembered as a towering leader of BJP and one of the founders of the party. She belonged to erstwhile Royal family of Gwalior.

Born in 1919 at Sagar in presentday Madhya Pradesh, Smt. Vijaya Raje Scindhia was the eldest child of Thakur Mahendra Singh, a government officer, by his second wife, Chuda Devashwari Devi. She was named Lekha Divyeshwari Devi at birth. Her father was a deputy collector in the provincial administration. Her mother, who belonged to the influential Rana family of Nepal, died at Vijaya Raje's birth. In 1941, at the age of 22, Lekha was married to Jivajirao Scindia, Maharaja of Gwalior, one of the largest, richest and highestranking 21-gun-salute princely states in India. As per tradition, a new name was chosen for 'Lekha' based upon the matching the couple's horoscopes, and she assumed the name 'Vijayaraje Scindia'. She had active association with the Jana Sangh and later with the Bharatiya Janata Partv.

Rajmata Vijayaraje entered into electoral politics in 1957 when she contested and won the Guna Lok Sabha seat in Madhya Pradesh on a Congress ticket. Five years later, she won on a Congress ticket from Gwalior. Later, she quit the Congress and won the Guna seat in 1967 on Swatantra Party's ticket. She again soon joined Bharatiya Jan Sangh and resigned from Lok

Sabha to take part in state politics. She was elected from Karera assembly seat in Madhya Pradesh as the Jan Sangh candidate in 1967 and plunged headlong into state politics.

Jan Sangh defied the Indirawave in the 1971 Lok Sabha polls to win 3 seats in Gwalior region – Rajmata Vijaya Raje Scindia from Bhind, Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee from Gwalior and Madhavrao Scindia from Guna, though he later left the party. Vijayaraje Scindia did not contest Lok Sabha elections in 1977 and 1984 and lost to Smt. Indira Gandhi in Rae Bareli in 1980. In 1989, she won from Guna as member of Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP), and retained the seat in 1991, 1996 and 1998. She did not contest the elections in 1999 due to old age. She was jailed by Indira Gandhi during the Emergency, ultimately sharing a cell with fellow Rajmata and MP, Gayatri Devi, in Tihar Jail.

Vijayaraje came to the forefront of the BJP leadership in 1980 when she was made one of its vice-presidents. She played a key role in propagating the Ramianmabhoomi movement and was considered a committed nationalist. She remained a BJP vice-president until 1998 when she stepped down on health grounds and quit electoral politics. She left for her heavenly abode in January 2001. With her demise the BJP lost a powerful matriarchal figure.

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi participated virtually in the 21st Meeting of the Council of Heads of State of the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO), and through video-message in the Joint SCO-CSTO Outreach Session on Afghanistan. The 21st meeting of the SCO Council of Heads of State was held on 17 September 2021 in Dushanbe in hybrid format. The meeting was chaired by H.E. Emomali Rahmon, the President of Tajikistan. is also a suitable occasion to think about the future of the SCO.I believe that biggest challenges the in this area are related to peace, security and trust-deficit and the root cause of these problems is increasing radicalization. Recent developments in Afghanistan have made challenge this more apparent. SCO should take an initiative on this issue.

In India, and almost in all SCO countries, there are moderate, tolerant and inclusive institutions and traditions associated with

Islam. SCO should work to develop a strong network between them. In this context, I appreciate the useful work being done by SCO-RATS. We expect our SCO partners to actively participate in the calendar of activities that has been built for India's Presidency of SCO-RATS.

Fighting radicalization is not only necessary for regional security and mutual trust, but it is also necessary for the bright future of our younger generations. To compete with the developed world, our region has to become a stakeholder in emerging

resenting the budget (FY 2021-22) in Parliament, Union Finance Minister Smt. Nirmala Sitharaman emphasized on need to double digit growth in manufacturing sector. She said, "Manufacturing companies need to become an integral part of global supply chains, possess core competence and state-ofthe-art technology." To accomplish the goal, Production Linked Incentive scheme(PLI) was launched across 13 sectors. About Rs. 1.97 lakh crore was provisioned for PLI in FY 2021-22 budgets. Under the scheme direct incentive is provided by the government on incremental sales. The incentive will be given to those domestic manufacturing units which manage additional

for a period of sales five years subsequent to the base year. PLI will be also provided incremental investment. Substantial goal of the scheme is to domestic manufacturing and enhancing export capacity and to attract foreign investment manufacturing. The initiative will be also able to improve balance of payment by quantifying export and reducing import. This initiative

is inspired by government's Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyan(Self-reliant Campaign).

Earlier in March 2020, PLI had been announced in three sectors- Drug Intermediates (DIs) and Active Pharmaceutical Ingredients (APIs), Large Scale Electronics Manufacturing and Manufacturing of Medical Devices. Additional 10 sectors which include Electronic/Technology Products, Telecom & Networking Products, Food Products, White Goods, High-Efficiency Solar PV Modules, Automobiles & Auto Components, Advance Chemistry Cell (ACC) Battery, Textile Products and Specialty Steel are announced in the Budget of this year.

Taking forward the scheme, Modi Government on 15th September, 2021 approved a PLI scheme with an outlay of Rs 26,058 crore for the automobile and drone sector to boost electric vehicle and hydrogen fuel-cell vehicle manufacturing in the country. PLI Scheme for Automobile Industry and Drone Industry is part of the overall announcement of PLI Schemes for 13 sectors made in the Union Budget 2021-22.

The PLI scheme for the auto sector will incentivize high value advanced automotive technology vehicles and products and will create jobs. This scheme will be helpful in creating additional 7.5 lakhs job, further this will increase India's share in global automotive trade. This

ACC battery manufacturing represents one of the largest economic opportunities of the twenty-first century for several global growth sectors, such as consumer electronics, electric vehicles, and renewable

energy. The PLI scheme for ACC battery will incentivize large domestic and international players in establishing a competitive ACC battery set-up in the country. The automotive industry is a major economic contributor in India. The PLI scheme will make the Indian automotive Industry more competitive and will enhance globalization of the Indian automotive sector.

According to government's data, the Indian pharmaceutical industry is the third largest in the world by volume and 14th largest in terms of value. It contributes 3.5% of the total drugs and medicines exported globally. India possesses the complete ecosystem for development and manufacturing of pharmaceuticals and a robust ecosystem of allied industries. The PLI scheme will incentivize the global and domestic players to engage in high value production.

Telecom equipment forms a critical and strategic element of building a secured telecom infrastructure and India aspires to become a major original equipment manufacturer of telecom and networking products. The PLI scheme is expected to attract large investments from global players and help domestic companies seize the emerging opportunities and become big players in the export market.

The Indian textile industry has a share of $\sim 5\%$ of global exports in textiles and apparel. But India's share in the manmade fibre (MMF) segment is low in contrast to the global consumption pattern. The PLI scheme will attract large investment in the sector to further boost domestic manufacturing, especially in the MMF segment and technical textiles. The growth of the processed food industry leads to better price for farmers and reduces high levels of wastage.

India in last one financial year brought down import of solar PV panels to 571 million dollar by encouraging domestic manufacturers. Apart from protective tariff measures, focused PLI scheme for solar PV modules will incentivize domestic and global players to build large-scale solar PV capacity in India and help India leapfrog in capturing the global value chains for solar

PV manufacturing.

White goods (air conditioners and LEDs) have very high potential of domestic value addition and making these products globally competitive. A PLI scheme for the sector will lead to more domestic manufacturing, generation of jobs and increased exports.

Several companies like Daikin, Panasonic, Hitachi, Mettube, Nidec, Voltas, Bluestar, Havells, Amber, EPack, TVS-Lucas, Dixon, R K Lighting, Uniglobus, RadhikaOpto, Syska among others have applied for manufacturing critical components of Air conditioners and LED Lights.

A total of 52 companies have filed their application with committed investment of Rs 5,866 crore under the PLI scheme to incentivize the domestic manufacturing of components of White Goods (Air conditioners and LED lights), applications for which closed on 15 September, 2021. The PLI Scheme on White goods was notified on 16 April, 2021. 21 firms will invest Rs. 871 crore for LED components. 31 firms have committed about Rs. 4,995 crore for AC component manufacturing. India's annual market for ACs is more than 7 million, but irony is that out of which 6 million are assembled with just 25% domestic value addition.PLI scheme has potential to reverse the ratio of value addition with manifold production capacity'

India is the world's second largest steel producer in the world. According to data shared by the Ministry of Steel, India exported 10.7 million tonnes of finished steel during 2020-21. India exports steel to more than 170 countries. It has the potential to become a champion in certain grades of steel. A PLI scheme in Specialty Steel will help in enhancing manufacturing capabilities for value added steel leading to increase in total exports.

After the launch of the scheme, foreign companies like Toyota-Tsusho and Sumida are also planning to shift their manufacturing units to India. According to a report, around 1,000 companies have engaged in discussions with the Indian officials at various levels for shifting its manufacturing base in India. About 300 companies belonging to sectors like mobiles, electronics, medical devices, textiles and synthetic fabric are actively pursuing production plans.

The PLI scheme has created catalyst effect for Indian Economy by attracting foreign firms and lending agencies. PLI scheme shall create strong assets in long run and will strengthen the foundations of the Indian economy by 2024.





INDIA CREATES WORLD RECORD ON PM'S BIRTHDAY WITH 2.5 CRORE VACCINATIONS

India administered over 2.5 crore Covid vaccinations in a day for the first time on September 17 on Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi's birthday. Earlier, the Prime Minister took to Twitter to declare that "every Indian would be proud of today's record vaccination numbers" and thanked healthcare and frontline workers who had worked hard to make the vaccination drive a success. In the evening, as the country crossed the two crore-mark, the World Health Organization's South-East Asia office tweeted its congratulations. Congratulations India for yet another milestone!" the global health body's regional arm said.

The government's tracker showed around 434 vaccinations per second, around 48,000 in a minute, or 15.62 Lakh per hour jabs has been administered on September 17. This push to the national vaccination campaign is at the core of the BJP's three-week celebrations to mark the Prime Minister's 71st birthday. To achieve its target, the BJP prepared health volunteers "to ensure maximum number of people get their COVID-19 vaccines on the day". BJP National President Shri Jagat Prakash Nadda in a tweet said, "New World Record!

On Birthday of world's most popular Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, a new record of giving more than 2.25 crore Covid vaccine doses has been set in the country today. Under the leadership of Modi ji, our health workers showed the power of India to the world through their hard work. Later in the evening Union Health Minister Shri Mansukh Mandaviya informed in a tweet that India has achieved the 2.5 crore vaccination mark and tweeted "Congratulations India!

On the birthday of Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi India has created a history. We have written a golden chapter in the history of the country and the world by administering more than 2.5 crore vaccines. The day is dedicated to the health workers.

indigenous 'Covaxin' developed by Bharat BioTech. Apart from these, authorities have given approval to Russia's Sputnik V vaccine. Around 70 million Covishield doses and 10 million Covaxin doses per month were manufactured in India up to May, 2021. The monthly production capacity of Covishield is projected to be increased to more than 120 million doses and of Covaxin to around 58 million doses by December, 2021 to meet the requirements.

OPPOSITION CREATED A MESS OF VACCINATION DRIVE

India's vaccine supply policy has gone through several phases. In the first three, vaccinations were opened up to healthcare workers, front-line workers, and those over the age of 60 years or over the age of 45 years but with co-morbidities. In all three, the vaccines were sourced and supplied by the Union government — to the states and to private centres. Starting April 1, vaccinations were opened up to those over the age of 45. In this phase too, vaccines were procured and allocated to states and private centres by the Union government. Starting May 1, India opened up vaccinations for everyone over

the age of 18 and states were allowed to procure up to 25% of the vaccines made locally for this; private hospitals were allowed to buy another 25%; and the remaining 50% was sourced by the Union government for distribution to the states for healthcare and frontline workers and those over the age of 45 years. But the opposition ruled states like Rajasthan, Chattishgarh, Jharkhand and Punjab who appealed to the Union government to open up the procurement of vaccine for the state government failed to procure requisite demands of their states. And after a messy month-and-half when supply and demand ratio mismatched, the Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi took over the 18-44 age group responsibilities of the vaccines starting June 21 with the launch of free vaccination drive.

THREE STATES AND THREE UTS ADMINISTERED FIRST DOSE TO THEIR 100 PERCENT POPULATION

As Centre and state governments gave a major push to the vaccination drive against the coronavirus disease amid fears of an imminent third wave of the pandemic, three states and as many Union territories have achieved cent per cent inoculation of its entire adult population with at least one dose of the jab.

Himachal Pradesh was among the first states to have vaccinated all the eligible adults. The other states were Goa and Sikkim, while Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Daman and Diu, Ladakh and Lakshadweep have achieved the feat.

INDIA GAVE MORE JABS THAN G7 NATIONS COMBINED IN AUGUST

In another milestone, India administered more Covid-19 vaccine doses than all of G7 nations put together, the Union Health Ministry said on September 5. The ministry informed that over 18 crore (180 million) vaccine doses were administered in the month of August. This number is greater than the United State of America's total vaccination in the month of August 2021 which stood at 23 million, France 13 million, Germany 9 million, Italy 8 million and United Kingdom 5 million. Canada administered 3 million

doses and Japan 40 million doses in the two lowest and highest ranges, respectively, according to data tweeted out.

"Yet another achievement! With more than 180 million vaccine doses administered in the month of August, India leaves a mark on the Global map of leading its way in vaccinating its population on


priority. #LargestVaccineDrive," social media handle of MyGovIndia tweeted. The G7 nations included Canada, the UK, the US, Italy, Germany, France and Japan.

According data, more than 66.89 crore (66,89,80,635) vaccine doses have been provided to States and Union Territories so far through the government of India (free of cost channel) and

through the direct state procurement category. Further, more than 1.56 crore doses (1,56,96,450) are in the pipeline. As part of the nationwide vaccination drive. the government of India has been supporting the States and Union Territories by providing them COVID vaccines free of cost.

India's fight against the Covid-19 pandemic has been very successful so far and the vaccination drive have played a crucial role in this fight. India is not only producing vaccine for its citizens but also helping other countries

on the humanitarian ground as well. As newer Indian vaccines get developed, India is hopeful that production capacity of existing vaccines will be ramped up further. ELECTRONIC POLYMER BASED LOW-COST SENSOR DEVELOPED TO DETECT EXPLOSIVES RAPIDLY

Indian scientists, for the first time, have developed a thermally stable and cost-effective electronic polymer-based sensor for rapidly detecting nitro-aromatic chemicals used in high-energy explosives. The detection of explosives without destroying them is essential for protection, and criminal investigations, minefield remediation, military applications, ammunition remediation sites, security applications, and chemical sensors play a vital role in such cases.

Though explosive poly-nitroaromatic compounds can be analyzed usually by sophisticated instrumental techniques, the requirements for quick decision making in criminology laboratories or reclaimed military sites or to detect explosives in possession of extremists often require simple, cheap, and selective field techniques which will be non-destructive in nature.

Ltd. under the supervision of IAF and National Highways Authority of India (NHAI). This is the first time that a National Highway has been used for emergency landing of aircraft of Indian Air Force. This landing strip will be able to facilitate landing of all types of IAF aircraft.

In his address, Shri Rajnath Singh lauded the IAF, NHAI & the private sector for joining hands and completing the construction of Emergency Landing

Field in 19 months despite COVID-19 restrictions. It is a great example of coordination among multiple departments & Ministries; Government & private sector and Civil & Defence, he added. The Raksha Mantri defined the landing of IAF aircraft on the 3 km stretch as a historic new strength of New India, as it coincides with the 75th year of Independence and 50th year of India's victory in the 1971 war.

Apart from the Emergency Landing Strip, three helipads have been constructed in Kundanpura, Singhania & Bakhasar villages under this project as per the requirements of the Armed Forces.
