 The government has also been working on preventive healthcare, and building health and wellness infrastructure.

RESERVATION FOR DALITS, BACKWARD CLASSES, ADIVASIS

 We need to provide hand holding to the backward categories and sectors. With the concern of fulfilling the basic needs, reservation is being ensured for the Dalits, Backward classes, Adivasis and the poor people from general category. More recently, in the field of medical education, reservation has also been ensured for the OBC category in the All India Quota. By formulating a law in Parliament, the right to make their own list of OBC has been given to the states. Be it rice available at ration shop, rice available in mid-day meal, rice available through every scheme will be fortified by the year 2024.

JAMMU AND KASHMIR AND LADAKH

- The delimitation commission has been constituted in Jammu and Kashmir itself and preparations are also going on for the assembly elections.
- Ladakh is witnessing a new transformative phase where the government is focusing on building world-class infrastructure. On one hand, Ladakh is witnessing the creation of modern infrastructure, while on the other; 'Sindhu Central University' is

going to make Ladakh a centre of higher education.

- There is a huge potential in the fields of tourism, adventure sports, organic farming, herbal medicine, and oil pump in the North East. We have to fully harness this potential and make it a part of the development journey of the country. And we have to complete this work within a few decades of the 'Amrit Kaal'. Giving a fair opportunity to the capabilities of all is the true spirit of democracy. Be
 - it Jammu or Kashmir, the balance of development is now visible on the ground.
- Whether East, North East, Jammu and Kashmir, Ladakh, the entire Himalayan region, our coastal belt or tribal region, these will become a big base for India's development in the future.
- Today, a new history of connectivity is being written in the North-East. This is a connectivity of both the hearts and the infrastructure. Very soon the work of connecting all the state capitals of the North-East with rail service is going to be completed.

NEW PHASE IN DEVELOPMENTAL JOURNEY OF VILLAGES

 Under the Act-East Policy, today North-East, Bangladesh, Myanmar and South-East Asia are also being connected. Due to the efforts made in the past years, now the enthusiasm for the creation of 'Shreshtha Bharat' and long-lasting peace in the North-East has increased manifold.

- We are witnessing a new phase in the developmental journey of our villages. It not only has electricity and water but also nurturing Digital Entrepreneurs.
 Priority is being given to schemes related to education, health, nutrition, roads, employment, in over 110 aspirational districts of the country. Many of these districts are in tribal areas.
- We have to focus on helping our small farmers. We have to give maximum benefits of the government's schemes to them; be it through DBT or Krishi Rail.
- Kisan Rail can help small farmers with this modern facility to reach far flung areas on a low cost of produce and transportation. Several

- products like Kamalam, Shahi litchi, BhutJolokiachillis, black rice or turmeric are being exported to different countries of the world.
- The government is now focusing on welfare of small farmers. 10 Crore farmer families have directly received over 1.5 lakh crore in their bank accounts.
- SVAMITVA Yojna is transforming the lives in rural India. Drone is helping our rural citizens to map their land and apply for various schemes/loans online.
- Co-operatives are not just a system with a network of laws and rules, but co-operative is a spirit, culture, and a mindset of collective growth. We have taken steps to empower them by forming a separate ministry. We have taken this step to empower the cooperative sector in the states.
- In the coming years, we will have to increase the collective power of the small farmers of the country. They have to be given new facilities. We are trying to empower these farmers through SVAMITVA Yojana.

'AMRIT MAHOTSAV' OF INDEPENDENCE

We have decided to celebrate this 'Amrit Mahotsav' of independence for 75 weeks. It started from 12th March and will continue till 15th August, 2023. We have to move forward with new enthusiasm and, therefore, the country has made a very important decision. During these 75 weeks of the Amrit Mahotsav of Independence, 75 Vande Bharat

trains will connect every corner of the country. The pace at which new airports are being built in the country and the UDAN scheme connecting remote areas is unprecedented.

- We will have to work together for manufacturing world class products, using cutting-edge innovation and new age technology.
- Under the Jan Aushadhi Yojana, the poor and needy are now getting affordable medicines. Over 75,000 Health & Wellness Centres have been built and we are working on a network of hospitals at the block level.
- To further increase our developmental progress, we have to focus on our manufacturing and export.
- The country has also announced Production Linked Incentive to consolidate our 'Make in India'
 - campaign in the wake of the new economic conditions that have emerged due to Corona. The electronic manufacturing sector stands as an example of the change that is enforced through this scheme. Seven years ago, we used to import mobile phones worth about eight billion dollars. However, now the import has reduced considerably, and today we are also exporting mobile phones worth three billion dollars.
- Treading ahead on the path of development, India will have to augment both its manufacturing and exports. You have witnessed, just a few days ago, India launched its first indigenous Aircraft Carrier INS Vikrant for trial in the sea. Today, India is making its own indigenous fighter aircraft, its own submarine. 'Gaganyaan' is also slated to hoist India's flag in space. This itself is evidential of our immense capabilities in indigenous manufacturing.
- I want to tell the manufacturers Every product you
 make is a brand ambassador for India. As long as
 that product is in use, the buyer will say yes this
 is 'Made in India'.
- We have to stop the over involvement of government in the form of complex policies. Today, we have abolished over 15,000 unnecessary compliances.
- · We have introduced tax reforms that will give

- impetus to 'Ease of Living' and 'Ease of Doing Business'. Good and smart governance is required to implement the reforms. Today, the world is also witnessing how India is writing a new chapter of governance.
- To introduce people centric approach in Bureaucracy, we have started 'Mission Karmayogi' and Capacity Building programme.
- Today, the country also has a new 'National Education Policy' to meet the needs of the 21st century. Now our children will neither stop due to lack of skills nor will they be bound by language barriers. This new National Education Policy is also going to be a great tool to fight against poverty in a way. The basis of winning the war against poverty is also the education, prestige and importance of

the vernacular language.

- In a move towards strengthening BetiBachao, Beti Padhao initiative, our daughters will now be able to study in Sainik schools too. Today, be it education or Olympics our daughters are performing tremendously. We have to ensure that they get equal opportunities and they feel safe and respected.
- More than eight crore sisters in the villages are associated with Self-Help Groups and they design topend products. Now the government

will also prepare an e-commerce platform to ensure a huge market in the country and abroad for their products. When the country is moving forward with the mantra of being vocal for local, this digital platform will connect the products of women self-help groups with people in far flung areas of the country as well as abroad and it will have far-reaching consequences.

'AATMA NIRBHAR' IN ENERGY PRODUCTION

- India is not Energy independent. It spends over Rs. 12 lakh crores on importing energy. As we celebrate 75 years of Independence, we have to ensure that India becomes 'Aatma Nirbhar' in energy production too.
- We are giving equal emphasis to Environmental Security as to National Security. Be it biodiversity or land neutrality, climate change or waste recycling,

In a series of tweets, the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi made the solemn announcement.



PM NARENDRA MODI BECOMES INDIA'S FIRST PM TO PRESIDE OVER UNSC DEBATE

PM MODI PUTS FORWARD FIVE BASIC PRINCIPLES FOR UNSC DEBATE

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi chaired the High-level Open Debate on 'Enhancing Maritime Security – A Case for International Cooperation' on 9th August via video conferencing. The Open Debate focused on ways to effectively counter maritime crime and insecurity and strengthened coordination in the maritime domain. Shri Narendra Modi became the first Indian Prime Minister to preside over a UN Security Council Open Debate.

The meeting was attended by several Heads of State & Government of member states of the United Nations Security Council, and high level briefers from the UN System and key Regional Organizations. In his remarks, Prime Minister Shri Modi outlined a five-principle framework for the debate. The first was removing barriers to maritime trade. In this context, Shri Modi highlighted SAGAR ('Security and Growth for all in the Region') — a 2015 Indian framework for regional maritime security.

The original address was delivered by PM Shri Modi in Hindi. Excerpts:

Excellencies, Thank you all for joining this important discussion on Maritime Security. I appreciate the positive message by Secretary General and I would like to thank the Executive Director of U.N.O.D.C. for the briefing. The President of the Democratic Republic of the Congo delivered his message in capacity of the President of the African Union. I am especially grateful to him. I also express my heartfelt gratitude for the presence of the President of Russia, the President of Kenya, and the Prime Minister of Vietnam.

The ocean is our joint heritage. Our sea routes are the lifeline of international trade. And, the biggest thing is that these oceans are very important for the future of our planet. But today our shared maritime heritage is facing many challenges. Sea routes are being misused for piracy and terrorism. There are maritime disputes between many countries. And climate change and natural disasters are also maritime domain related issues. In this broad context, we must make a framework of mutual understanding and cooperation for the preservation and use of our common maritime heritage. No country can make such a framework alone. It can only be realized through a common effort. It is with this thought that we have brought this important issue before the Security Council. I am

confident that today's High Level discussion will guide the world on the issue of maritime security.

I would like to place before you five basic principles to structure this brainstorming.

First principle: We must remove barriers from legitimate maritime trade. The prosperity of all of us depends on the active flow of maritime trade. The hurdles could be a challenge for the entire global economy. Free maritime trade has been associated with the civilization of India since time immemorial. Thousands of years ago, Lothal port of Indus valley civilization was linked to maritime trade. It was in the independent maritime environment of ancient times that the message of peace of Lord Buddha spread to the world. In today's context, India has defined the vision of SAGAR - (Security and Growth for All in the Region) – based on this open and inclusive ethos. Through this vision, we want to create an inclusive structure of maritime security in our region. This vision is of a Safe, a Secure and a Stable maritime domain. Free maritime trade also requires that we fully respect the rights of each other's sailors.

Second principle: The settlement of maritime disputes must be peaceful and on the basis of international law only. This is very important for

mutual trust and confidence. It is only through this that we can ensure global peace and stability. With this understanding and maturity, India has resolved its maritime boundary with its neighboring country Bangladesh.

Third principle: We must face natural disasters and maritime threats created by Non-state actors together. India has initiated several steps to enhance regional cooperation on this subject. We have been the first responder in maritime disasters related to cyclone, tsunami and pollution. The Indian Navy has been patrolling in the Indian Ocean since 2008 to prevent piracy. India's White Shipping Information Fusion Center is increasing shared maritime domain awareness in our region. We have provided training in Hydrographic Survey Support and Maritime Security to many countries. India's role in the Indian Ocean has been as a Net Security Provider.

Fourth principle: We have to preserve the maritime environment and maritime resources. As we know, the oceans have a direct impact on the climate. And therefore, we have to keep our maritime

environment free from pollution like plastics and oil spills. And take joint steps against over-fishing and marine poaching. At the same time, we must also increase cooperation in ocean science.India has launched an ambitious "Deep Ocean Mission". We have also taken several initiatives to encourage sustainable fishing.

Fifth Principle: We must encourage responsible maritime connectivity. It is clear that infrastructure creation is necessary to increase maritime trade. But, the physical sustainability and absorption capacity of the countries have to be kept in mind in the development of such infrastructure projects. For this we must make proper global norms and standards.

I am sure, on the basis of these five principles, a global roadmap of maritime security cooperation can be formed. The high and active participation of today's open debate shows that the subject is important for all members of the Security Council.

With this, I once again express my gratitude to you for your presence.

CALCUTTA HIGH COURT HANDOVERS WEST BENGAL POST POLL VIOLENCE CASE TO CBI

The Calcutta High Court on 20 August ordered a probe by the Central Bureau of Investigation into all cases of heinous crimes such as rape and murder in connection with violence following the Assembly election in West Bengal. For other cases involving post-poll violence, the court constituted a special investigation team (SIT) of three senior IPS officers of the West Bengal cadre.

The order by a five-judge bench came after deliberations by the court following cases of post poll violence were brought before it in the form of several writ petitions. The court had urged the National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) to set up a committee to look into the cases, and the panel submitted a report to the court on July 13 suggesting a CBI probe into the matter.

Following the direction of Calcutta High Court, CBI formed four special teams headed by senior officers to investigate the cases.





UNDER CONGRESS RULE SCAMS HAPPENED IN EVERY DEFENCE DEAL: JP NADDA

DRDO DEVELOPS ADVANCED CHAFF TECHNOLOGY FOR INDIAN AIR FORCE

RAKSHA MANTRI TERMS IT ANOTHER STEP OF DRDO TOWARDS 'AATMANIRBHAR BHARAT'

efence Research & Development Organisation (DRDO) has developed an Advanced Chaff Technology to safeguard fighter aircraft of the Indian Air Force (IAF) against

hostile radar threats. Defence Laboratory Jodhpur, DRDO а laboratory developed the advanced Chaff material and chaff cartridge-118/I in collaboration with High Energy Materials Research Laboratory (HEMRL), a Pune based laboratory of DRDO, meeting qualitative requirements of IAF. The Indian Air Force has

started the process of induction of this technology after completion of successful user trials.

In today's electronic warfare, survivability of fighter aircraft is of prime concern because of advancement in modern radar threats. To ensure survivability of aircraft, Counter Measure Dispensing System (CMDS) is used which provides passive jamming against Infra-Red and radar threats. Chaff is a critical



defence technology used to protect fighter aircraft from hostile radar threats. The importance of this technology lies in the fact that very less quantity of chaff material deployed in the air acts as decoy to deflect enemy's missiles for ensuring safety of the fighter aircraft. The technology has been given to the industry for production in large quantities to meet the annual rolling requirement of the Indian

Air Force.

Mantri Raksha Shri Rainath Singh has IAF lauded DRDO. and the industry for indigenous development of this critical technology, terming it as one more step of DRDO towards 'AatmaNirbhar Bharat' defence strategic technologies. Secretary Department of Defence

R&D and Chairman DRDO Dr G Satheesh Reddy congratulated the teams associated with the successful development of this advanced technology that will further strengthen the Indian Air Force.

CENTER REVENUE REFLECTS STRONG GROWTH IN COLLECTION

Despite the second wave shock of corona pandemic, the Government's revenue reflects strong growth in collection. The Union government's revenue collection went up to 28% of



its budgeted revenues for fiscal 2022 in the first quarter (Apr-Jun) alone. This quarter collection is the best revenue collection drive in five years. In the three years prior to the pandemic, the Union Government could only manage 14% of the budgeted revenues for the year in the first quarter.

NEARLY 72% OF FINANCIAL TRANSACTIONS OF PUBLIC SECTOR BANKS (PSBS) DONE THROUGH DIGITAL CHANNELS

Nearly 72% of financial transactions of Public Sector Banks (PSBs) are now done through digital channels, with customers active on digital channels having doubled from 3.4 crore in FY2019-20 to 7.6 crore in FY2020-21. This was stated by Union Minister of State for Finance Dr Bhagwat Kisanrao Karad in a written reply to a question in Rajya Sabha on August 10. The Minister stated, however, that the license for banking is given by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) and RBI has informed that it is not considering a separate licensing category for digital banks at present.

CABINET APPROVES IMPLEMENTATION OF NATIONAL MISSION ON EDIBLE OILS — OIL PALM

The Union Cabinet, chaired by the Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi on August 18 has given its nod to launch a new Mission on Oil palm to be known as the National Mission on Edible Oils – Oil Palm (NMEO-OP) as a new Centrally Sponsored Scheme with a special focus on the North east region and the Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Due to the heavy dependence on imports for edible oils, it is important to make efforts for increasing the domestic production of edible oils in which increasing area and productivity of oil palm plays an important part.

A financial outlay of Rs.11,040 crore has been made for the scheme, out of which Rs.8,844 crore is the Government of India share and Rs.2,196 crore is State share and this includes the viability gap funding also.

Under this scheme, it is proposed to cover an additional area of 6.5 lakh hectare (ha.) for oil palm till the year 2025-26 and thereby reaching the target of 10 lakh hectares ultimately. The production of Crude Palm Oil (CPO) is expected to go upto 11.20 lakh tonnes by 2025-26 and upto 28 lakh tonnes by 2029-30.

The scheme will immensely benefit the oil palm farmers, increase capital investment, create employment generation, shall reduce the import dependence and also increase the income of the farmers.

200 VAN DHAN PRODUCER COMPANIES PLANNED TO BE SET UP

200 Van Dhan producer companies are planned to be set up in 27 States during 2020-21 to 2025-26 with priority in Aspirational Districts under Van Dhan programme of TRIFED. It is worth mentioning that a Van Dhan Producer company existing in Jawadhu Hills in Tiruvannamalai district, Tamil Nadu since 2020 is a noteworthy example of how this initiative benefits the tribals and promotes tribal entrepreneurship.

To help the tribals empower themselves and gain better opportunities and market access, the Jawadhu Hills Tribal Farmer Producer Company was formed in 2020. It falls under the State Balanced Growth Fund for Value Addition of Non-Timber forest Product and Agricultural Products of Jawadhu hills, Tiruvannamalai District (SPV).

In less than a year, four manufacturing units have already been set up for, the processing and packaging of tamarind, minor millet, and honey and pepper. The units, which are being run by the tribals, have started production in November 2020. The daily production capacity is 1 tonne. Up until now, in less than 4 months, the producer company has sold processed products up to Rs 12 lakhs. The Van Dhan tribal start-ups, a component of the same scheme, is a programme for value addition, branding & marketing of Minor Forest Produces by establishing Van Dhan Kendras to facilitate creation of sustainable livelihoods for the forest-based tribes.

PM HAILS PASSAGE OF THE CONSTITUTION (127TH AMENDMENT) BILL, 2021 IN BOTH HOUSES

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi on August 11 has called Passage of the Constitution (127th Amendment) Bill, 2021 in both Houses a landmark moment for the nation.

The Bill that aims at restoring powers of states to notify backward classes. The Amendment Bill amends Articles 342 A (clauses 1 and 2) and will introduce a new clause - 342 A (3) specifically authorising states to maintain their state list of Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (SEBC). There will be a consequential amendment

in Articles 366(26c) and 338B (9). The states will thus be able to directly notify SEBCs without having to refer to the National Commission for Backward Classes (NCBC).

In a tweet, the Prime Minister said, "Passage of the Constitution (127th Amendment) Bill, 2021 in both Houses is a landmark moment for our nation. This Bill furthers social empowerment. It also reflects our Government's commitment to ensuring dignity, opportunity and justice to the marginalised sections."

FOUR INDIAN SITES GET RAMSAR RECOGNITION

our more wetlands from India get recognition from the Ramsar Secretariat as Ramsar sites. These sites are Thol and Wadhwana from Gujarat and Sultanpur and Bhindawas from Haryana. Informing this in a tweet message, Union Environment Minister, Shri Bhupender Yadav expressed happiness and stated that it is Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi's special concern for the environment which has led to overall improvement in how India cares for its wetlands.

With this, the number of Ramsar sites in India are 46 and the surface area covered by these

sites is now 1,083,322 hectares. While Haryana gets its first Ramsar sites, Gujarat gets three more after Nalsarovar which was declared in 2012. The aim of the Ramsar list is "to develop and maintain an international network of wetlands which are important for the conservation of global biological diversity and for sustaining human life through the maintenance of their ecosystem components, processes and benefits".

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has said that it is a matter of pride for us that four Indian sites get Ramsar recognition.

TILL DATE, 363 ROUTES AND 59 AIRPORTS OPERATIONALIZED UNDER 'UDAN'

Union Minister of Civil Aviation, Shri Jyotiraditya Scindia along with the Minister of State in the Ministry of Civil Aviation, General (Retd.) Dr. V.K. Singh, and Member of Parliament, Bareilly, Shri Santosh Gangwar, flagged off the new flight connecting Bareilly (Uttar Pradesh) with Mumbai (Maharashtra) in a virtual ceremony on August 12.

The operationalization of this route aligns with the objectives of the 'Sab Uden Sab Juden' initiative of the Government of India that aims to strengthen the aerial

connectivity of the Tier-2 & Tier-3 cities of the country with the metros.

Till date, 363 routes and 59 airports (including 5 heliports and 2 water aerodromes) have been operationalized under the UDAN scheme.

The number of domestic passengers is on the rise as flying emerges as a preferred, safe & time-saving mode of transport. On 11 August 2021, 1,98,495 passengers travelled on 1,798 flights. Total flight movement was 3,592 & total passenger movement was 3,95,143. ■

WORLD'S SECOND-LARGEST REFURBISHED GENE BANK INAUGURATED

The customer was surprised especially because the handle was quite shiny and new In appearance. "Why the handle is quite shiny? How have your preserved the brightness for sixty years?" He asked. Barber too was amused with this. Is it possible to preserve the handle in a brand new appearance for sixty years? It has been replaced only six months ago". He replied naturally. The customer was curious and asked and how old is the steel? Three years was the reply. In brief. the handle was replaced. the steel was also replaced, but the razor remained old! Its identity was intact. Similarly a nation too has a soul. There is a technique name for it. In the "Principles and Policies" adopted by the Jana Sangh, this name is mentioned. The word is 'Chiti'. According to McDougal, it is the innate nature of a group. Every group of persons has an innate nature. Similarly every society has an innate nature, which is inborn and is not the result of historical circumstances.

A human being is born with a soul. Human personality, Soul and character are all distinct from one another.. Personality results from a cumulative effect of all the actions, thoughts and impressions of an individual. But Soul is unaffected by this history, Similarly national culture is continuously modified and enlarged by the historic reasons and circumstances. Culture does include all those things which by the association, endeavours and the history of the society, have come to be held up as good and commendable. but these are not added on to Chiti. Chiti is fundamental and is central to the nation from its very beginning. Chiti determines the direction in which the nation is to advance culturally. Whatever is in accordance with 'Chiti', is included in culture.

CHITI, CULTURE, DHARMA

By way of an illustration consider the story of Mahabharata. Kauravas were defeated, and Pandavas won. Why did we hold up the conduct of Pandavas as Dharma? Or why this battle was not considered just a battle for a kingdom? The praise for Yudhistir and the dishonour heaped on Duryodhana are not a result of political causes Krishna killed his uncle Kansa, the established king of the times. Instead of branding this as a revolt, we consider Krishna as an Avatar of God,

and Kansa as an Asura.

Rama was assisted in his invasion of Lanka by Vibhishana, brother of Ravana. Such conduct of Vibhishana instead of being branded as treason, is considered good and exemplary. He betrayed his brother and his king even as Jaichand had one later on. He might be branded as a "quisling". But Vibhishana is not called "quisling' by any one. On the contrary he is highly praised for his conduct, and Ravana's actions are disapproved. Why so? The reason behind this is not political.

If there is any standard for determining the merits and demerits of particular action, it is this Chiti; from nature whatever is in accordance with 'Chiti', is approved and added on to culture. These things are to be cultivated. Whatever is against 'Chiti,' is discarded as perversion, undesirable, is to be avoided. Chiti is the touchstone on which each action, each attitude is tested, and determined to be acceptable or otherwise. 'Chitti' is the soul of the nation. On the strength of this

'Chiti', a nation arises, strong and virile if it is this 'Chiti' that is demonstrated in the actions of every great man of a nation.

An individual is also in instrument in bringing forth the soul of the nation 'Chiti'. Thus apart from his own self, an individual also represents his nation. Not only that, but he also mans the various institutions that are created for the fulfilment of the national goal. Therefore he represents these too. The groups larger than nation such as "mankind" are also represented by him. In short, an individual has a multitude of aspect, but they are not conflicting; there is co-operation. unity and harmony in them. A system based on the recognition of this mutuality complementary nature of the different ideals of mankind, their essential harmony, a system

which devises laws, which removes the disharmony and enhances these mutual usefulness and co-operation, alone can bring peace and happiness to mankind; can ensure steady development.

"INSTITUTION"- A MEANS TO **FULFIL NATIONAL NEEDS**

According to Darwin's theory, living beings develop various organs as per the requirements dedicated by the circumstances. In our shastras, it was stated slightly differently, that the soul constructs, using the strength of "Prana'", various organs as the need

is felt, for the purpose of continuing life. Just as the soul produced these different organs in the body, so also in the nation many different organs are produced as instruments to achieve national goals. Like various departments in a factory, building, machinery, sales, production, maintenance etc. nations also produce different departments, which are called institutions. These institutions are created to fulfil the needs of a nation. Family, castes, guilds, (which are now known as trade unions)etc., are such institutions. Property, marriage are also institution. Formerly there were no marriages. Later on some Rishi established this practice of marriage. He produced the institution of marriage. Similarly Gurukul and Rishkul were institutions. In the same way, the state is also an institution. The Nation creates it. A lot of trouble in the West is due to the fact that they confused the state with the nation, they considered the state synonymous with the nation. Truly speaking, nation and state are not the same. In our country, the state was produced as per social contract theory. Formerly there was no king. Mahabharata describes that in Krityuga, there was no state or king. Society was sustained and protected mutually by practicing 'Dharma'.

Later on interruption and disorganization came into existence. Greed and anger dominated. 'Dharma' was on the decline and the rule "might is right" prevailed. The Rishis were perturbed over the developments. They all went to Brahma to seek counsel, Brahma gave them a treatise on "Law and the Functions of the State", which he had himself writer. At the same time,

> he asked Manu to become the first you will gain 'Dharma' considerably

King. Manu declined saying that a king will have to punish other persons, put them in jail and so on; he was not prepared to commit all these sins. There upon Brahma said, your actions in the capacity of king will not constitute sin, a long as they are aimed at securing conditions under which the society can live peacefully and according to 'Dharma'. This will be your duty, your 'Dharma'. Not only that but You will also have a share of the 'Karma' of your subjects, whereby

if your subjects maintain conduct according to Dharma. Although it is not explicitly stated here, but I believe that if the society under any king committed sin, a part of that too must automatically go to the account of the king. It is not proper if only good things are shared by the king and not the bad ones; both must be shared in the same proportion. Thus state came into existence as a contract. This contract theory can be applied to the state but not to the nation. In the West, it was exactly opposite. Society as a nation, according to them was a contract, but the king claimed a divine right and proclaimed himself the sole representative of God. This is wrong.



Addressing the event, the Prime Minister said he was delighted to address the sisters of UP ahead of Raksha Bandhan. He said the number of people, especially women whose lives have been illuminated by the Ujjwala Yojana is unprecedented. This scheme was launched in 2016 from Ballia in UP, from the land of Mangal Pandey, the pioneer of the freedom struggle. He said that the second

edition of Ujjwala was also being launched from UP's Veerbhoomi - Mahoba. He remembered another son of the soil of Bundelkhand, Major Dhyan Chand or Dadda Dhyan Chand. He said the name of the

country's highest sports award is now named as Major Dhyan Chand Khel Ratna Award. He said this will inspire lakhs of people who want to pursue sports.

The Prime Minister lamented that the countrymen had to wait for decades for getting many basic amenities such as Housing, Electricity, Water, Toilet, Gas, Roads, Hospital and School. Many of such

things could have been addressed decades ago. He said that our daughters will be able to come out of the house and kitchen and contribute extensively in nation building only when the problems related to house and kitchen are solved first. Therefore, in the last 6-7 years, he said, the Government has worked to get solutions to various issues on a mission mode. He listed many such interventions like crores of toilets being built across the country under Swachh Bharat Mission; more than 2 crore houses for poor families, mostly, in the names of women; rural roads; 3 crore families got electricity connection; Ayushman Bharat is giving 50 crore people cover for upto 5 lakh rupees worth of medical treatment; direct money transfer for



vaccination and nutrition during pregnancy under MatruVandana Yojana; 30 thousand crore rupees were deposited by the government in the Jan Dhan Account of women during Corona period; our sisters

> are getting piped water under Jal Jeevan Mission. He said that these schemes have brought massive transformation in the lives of women.

The Prime Minister noted that the resolve of health, convenience and empowerment of sisters has received great impetus from Ujjwala Yojana. In the first phase of the scheme, 8 crore poor, dalit,

deprived, backward and tribal families were given free gas connections. He said the benefit of this free gas connection was felt in the era of the Corona pandemic. Ujjawala Yojana has led to manifold expansion of LPG gas infrastructure. During the last 6-7 years more than 11 thousand LPG distribution centres have been opened. In UP the number of these centres increased to 4 thousand from 2 thousand in 2014. The Prime Minister said that we are very near the cent percent gas coverage.

He said that Ujjwala 2.0 scheme will give maximum benefit to lakhs of families. He added that now workers from other places need not run from pillar to post for address proof.

50 CRORE VACCINATIONS: PIVOTAL MOMENT IN COVID FIGHT

n August 7, India crossed an important landmark of administering 50 crore vaccines to its citizens. Despite negative campaigning, India has managed to efficiently run the world's largest and fastest vaccination programme. The credit goes to Prime Minister Narendra Modi's leadership and our Covid warriors – doctors, scientists and medical staff.

Just nine months after the spread of the pandemic, India managed to develop not one but two 'Made in India' vaccines. It was a rare feat for which full credit goes to our scientists.

NO LOOKING BACK SINCE JUNE 21

On January 16 India kickstarted the world's largest vaccination programme. Initially there were some challenges but overcoming them, India took 85 days to complete the first 10 crore vaccinations. On June 21 the government decided to absorb the entire expanse of the vaccination drive. The message was loud and clear – our PM cares. Since then there has been no looking back.

India was able to complete the next 10 crore vaccinations in

just 45 days to reach the 20 crore mark. Since then, the drive has continued in top gear – 29 days for the next 10 crore, and 24 days and 20 days for the two subsequent 10 crore bands

Now, we have to accomplish the PM's mission of completing our nationwide vaccination drive of all adults by end of 2021. India will have well over 136 crore doses by the end of this year as production has been hiked. We will have 26.65 crore doses available in August, 26.15 crore in September, 28.25 crore in October, 28.25

crore in November and 28.5 crore in December.

COMPULSORY LICENSING POLICY HELPED

Among many significant decisions taken by the PM is simplifying compulsory licensing policy to speed up vaccine production. It ensured clearance

for manufacturing of Russia's Sputnik V in the country and just a few days back Johnson & Johnson vaccine has also been given clearance. In the coming days more vaccines will be available in India.

But let's note the negative role played by some opposition parties. While the PM was leading India's fight, the opposition was busy spreading canards and casting serious aspersions on our vaccines. One opposition party even labelled the 'Made in India' vaccine as a 'BJP vaccine' - such was the desperation to discredit India and its scientists. These opposition parties neither cooperated with the Centre nor supported the PM. They had one common agenda - to derail India's fight against Covid.

DESPITE RUMOURS AND FALSE NARRATIVES

The chief conspirator was Congress whose senior leaders and CMs persistently questioned the efficacy of our vaccines and spread rumours about its side-effects. They called our citizens 'guinea pigs', 'lab rats'. Some Congress-ruled states even declined to let the vaccination drive take place, which resulted in slowing down of the entire drive.

Congress also tried to derail the process by creating a false narrative of vaccine shortages, while the fact remains that some Congress-ruled states committed the unpardonable sin of wasting the precious vaccines and diverting vaccines to private hospitals.

We all know how many years it took for other vaccines to reach India. During Congress's rule, it took several years for the Japanese Encephalitis vaccine to reach India. Even all-important vaccines of polio and tetanus took decades to reach India after they were developed.

MADE IN INDIA INDEPENDENCE

Today India has shown the world that it is no longer dependent on developed nations for supply of vaccines. We also helped many countries with supplies of


time period that we look for new possibilities in religious tourism and strengthen the links between pilgrimage and local economy," the Prime Minister pointed out.

from SC, ST and OBC communities drawn from varied geographical spread from across the country which never happened before. Today, 35 percent of the ministers in the Union government are from the OBC category.




