INDIA'S COVID-19 VACCINATION CROSSES LANDMARK MILESTONE OF 70 CRORE

LAST 10 CRORE DOSES ADMINISTERED IN JUST 13 DAYS

In a landmark achievement, India's COVID-19 vaccination coverage has crossed 70 Crore milestone (70, 63, 55,796) on 07 September, 2021. Earlier, as per the release of Health Ministry, on 06 September, 2021 India administered more than one crore doses of COVID-19 vaccine in a day.

India had started the COVID-19 vaccination drive on 16 January, 2021 with two vaccines manufactured in India-- Covishield (Oxford-AstraZeneca's vaccine manufactured by Serum Institute of India) and Covaxin (manufactured by Bharat Biotech, India).

The second phase of the COVID-19 vaccination drive to inoculate people above 60 years and those over 45 with co-morbidities against the corona virus began on 01 March.

The third phase began on 01 April for all above 45 years of age. In the next phase that began from 01 May, for all above the age of 18 were eligible to receive the shot.

As per the release, the active cases have declined to 3,92,864 comprising 1.19 per cent of the total infections, while the national COVID-19 recovery rate was recorded at 97.48 per cent. A decrease of 12,010 cases has been recorded in the active COVID-19 case load in a span of 24 hours till 07 September.

BJP WINS BIG IN KARNATKA CIVIC BODY ELECTIONS

BJP on September 7 won 35 of the 58 wards in Belagavi City Corporation. BJP won 35 seats, Congress 9, independents 13 and AIMIM got one seat. Polling percentage stood at 50.41, with around 2.2 laky people came out to vote on September 3. BJP has won 39 seats out of 82 in Hubballi-Dharwad Municipal Corporation. In Kalburgi civic body, the BJP secured 23 seats out of 55 and 12 seats out of 31 in Bengaluru rural. INDIA'S GDP REGISTERS RECORD HIGH GROWTH OF 20.1%

India's GDP for the period April to June 2021 registered a record high. Gross domestic product (GDP) grew at 20.1% in the three-month period, compared with a contraction of 24.4% in the same quarter a year earlier. It is reflecting a rebound in consumer spending, and improved manufacturing in spite of a devastating second wave of Covid cases. The National Statistical Office (NSO), Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation on 31 August, 2021 have released the data for the first quarter (April-June) Q1 of 2021-22. The released statement said, "GDP at Constant (2011-12) Prices in Q1 of 2021-22 is estimated at Rs 32.38 lakh crore, as against Rs 26.95 lakh crore in Q1 of 2020-21, showing a growth of 20.1 percent as compared to contraction of 24.4% in Q1 2020-21. Quarterly GVA at Basic Price at Constant (2011-12) Prices for Q1 of 2021-22 is estimated at Rs 30.48 lakh crore, as against Rs 25.66 lakh crore in Q1 of 2020-21, showing a growth of 18.8%". This is India's fastest growth since official quarterly data started being released in the mid-1990s, which is up sharply from 1.6% in the previous quarter, but a bit slower than the Reserve Bank of India's 21.4% projection.

"The lockdown instructions in various States were duly considered by the National Statistical Office. The impact on economic activities and the data collection mechanisms owing to COVID-19 pandemic has an effect on the Quarterly GDP estimates also. The impact of these measures on overall economic activity is embedded in source data," said National Statistical Office.

According to the NSO data, gross value



added (GVA) growth in the manufacturing sector accelerated to 49.6 per cent in the first quarter of 2021-22, compared to a contraction 36 per cent a year ago. Farm sector GVA growth was up at 4.5 per cent, compared to 3.5 per cent earlier. Construction sector GVA grew by 68.3 per cent compared to 49.5 per cent contraction earlier. Mining sector grew by 18.6 per cent, as against a contraction of 17.2 per cent a year ago. Electricity, gas, water supply and other utility services segment grew by 14.3 per cent in the first quarter of this fiscal, against 9.9 per cent contraction a year ago. Similarly, trade, hotel, transport, communication and services related to broadcasting grew by 34.3 per cent compared to 48.1 per cent contraction earlier. Financial, real estate and professional services grew by 3.7 per cent in Q1 FY22 compared to a contraction of 5 per cent. Public administration, defence and other services grew at 5.8 per cent during the quarter under review, compared to (-) 10.2 per cent a year earlier. ■

EXTENSIVE INCREASE OF MSP FOR RABI CROPS

The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) chaired by the Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi on 8 September approved the increase in the Minimum Support Prices (MSP) for all mandated Rabi crops for Rabi Marketing Season (RMS) 2022-23.

Government has increased the MSP of Rabi crops for RMS 2022-23, to ensure remunerative prices to the growers for their produce. The highest absolute increase in MSP over the previous year has been recommended for Lentil (Masur) and Rapeseeds &

Additionally, National Mission on Edible Oils-Oil Palm (NMEOP), Centrally Sponsored Scheme recently announced by the government, will

help in increasing the domestic production of edible oils and reduce imports dependency. With the total

Mustard (Rs.400 per quintal each) followed by gram (Rs.130 per quintal). In case of safflower, there has been an increase of Rs.114 per quintal, in comparison to last year. The differential remuneration is aimed at encouraging crop diversification.

The increase in MSP for Rabi Crops for RMS 2022-23 is in line with the Union Budget 2018-19 announcement of fixing the MSPs at a level of at least 1.5 times of the all-India weighted average cost of production, aiming a reasonably fair remuneration for the farmers. The expected returns to farmers over their cost of production are estimated to be highest in case of wheat and rapeseed & mustard (100% each), followed by lentil (79%); gram (74%); barley (60%); safflower (50%).

Concerted efforts were made over the last few years to realign the MSPs in favour of oilseeds, pulses and coarse cereals to encourage farmers shift to larger area under these crops and adopt best technologies and farm practices, to correct demand — supply imbalance.

outlay of Rs.11,040 crore, the scheme will not only aid in expanding area and productivity of the sector, but also benefit the farmers by increasing their income and generation of additional employment.

The Umbrella Scheme 'Pradhan Mantri Annadata Aay SanraksHan Abhiyan' (PM-AASHA) announced by the government in 2018 will aid in providing remunerative return to farmers for their produce. The Umbrella Scheme consists of three sub-schemes i.e. Price Support Scheme (PSS), Price Deficiency Payment Scheme (PDPS) and Private Procurement & Stockist Scheme (PPSS) on a pilot basis. ■

OVER 16% INCREASE IN PADDY PROCUREMENT COMPARED TO PREVIOUS SEASON

In the ongoing season of Kharif 2020-21, purchase of 889.62 LMTs of paddy (includes Kharif Crop 718.09 LMT and Rabi Crop 171.53 LMT) up to 05 September, 2021 has been done against the last year corresponding purchase of 764.39 LMT.

This has benefitted about 130.47 Lakh farmers from the ongoing KMS procurement Operations with MSP value of Rs. 1,67,960.77 Crore. Paddy procurement has reached at all-time high level, surpassing previous high of 773.45 LMT in KMS 2019-20.

Marketing Season RMS 2021-22 has concluded in wheat procuring States and till now (upto 18.08.2021) a quantity of 433.44 LMT of Wheat has been procured (which is all time high, as it has exceeded previous high 389.93 LMT of RMS 2020-21) against the last year corresponding purchase of 389.93 LMT.

About 49.20 Lakh farmers have already been benefitted from the ongoing RMS procurement operations with MSP value of Rs. 85603.57 Crore.

For the cropping year 2020-21 which includes Kharif 2020-21, Rabi 2021 and Summer 2021 seasons, the Government through its Nodal Agencies has procured 11,99,713.15 MT of Pulses and Oilseeds having MSP value of Rs.6,742.51 Crores benefitting

7,02,368 farmers in Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Gujarat, Uttar Pradesh, Telangana, Haryana, Odisha and Rajasthan upto 05 September, 2021.

Fresh crop arrivals of Kharif Marketing Season (KMS) 2021-22 season is expected to arrive soon. Based on the proposal received from Karnataka State, approval was accorded for procurement of 40,000 MT of Pulses under Price Support Scheme (PSS) during KMS 2021-22. For other States/UTs, approval will also be accorded on receipt of proposals for procurement of Pulses, Oilseeds and Copra under PSS so that procurement of FAQ grade of these crops can be made at notified MSP for the Kharif Marketing Season 2021-22 directly from the registered farmers, if the market rate goes below MSP during the notified harvesting period in the respective States/UTs by the Central Nodal Agencies through State nominated procuring agencies as done during previous years.

For the season 2021-22, sanction for procurement of 51000 MT of Copra from Tamil Nadu has been given, against which 8.30 MT having MSP value of Rs. 0.09 crores has been procured benefitting 36 farmers in Tamil Nadu, up to 05.09.2021. ■

EXPORTS RISE 45% TO \$33 BN IN AUGUST

India exported goods worth \$33.14 billion in August, up 45.17 per cent on-year, as demand continued to remain robust from other countries,



revealed the preliminary data released by the commerce and industry ministry on 2 September. Outbound shipments were dominated by higher demand for items such as engineering and petroleum products, gems and jewellery. The 45-per cent growth can also be partially attributed to a low base in August 2020 due to disruption caused by Covid-19. However, the base effect is on the wane. ■

1,12,020 CRORE OF GROSS GST REVENUE COLLECTED IN AUGUST

The gross GST revenue collected in the month of August 2021 is Rs. 1,12,020 crore of which CGST is Rs. 20,522 crore, SGST is Rs. 26,605 crore, IGST is Rs. 56,247 crore (including Rs. 26,884 crore collected on import of goods) and Cess is Rs. 8,646 crore (including Rs. 646 crore collected on import of goods).

The revenues for the month of August 2021 are 30% higher than the GST revenues in the same month last year. During the month, the revenues from domestic transaction (including import of services) are 27% higher than the revenues from these sources during the same month last year. Even as compared to the August revenues in 2019-20 of Rs. 98,202 crore, this is a growth of 14%. ■

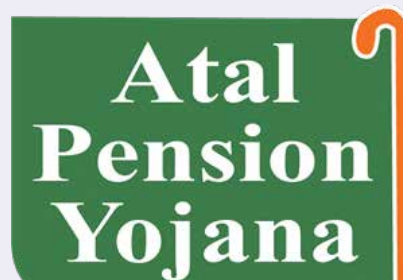
ATAL PENSION YOJANA TOTAL ENROLMENTS CROSSES 3.30 CRORE

Under the Atal Pension Yojana (APY), a guaranteed pension scheme of Government of India and administered by PFRDA, more than 28 lakh new APY accounts have been opened during current FY 2021-22. Overall, enrolments under APY has crossed 3.30 crore as on 25th August 2021.

Out of the total enrolments under APY as on 25th August 2021, nearly 78% subscribers have opted for Rs 1,000 pension

plan while around 14% for Rs 5,000 pension plan. Further, around 44% are female subscribers and also around 44% subscribers getting enrolled are very young and belong to the age-group of 18-25 years.

In the recent past, PFRDA has undertaken new initiatives like addition of new features in the APY mobile App and its availability on Umang platform, updation of APY FAQs, issuance of APY Subscriber Information Brochure



and APY Citizen Charter in 13 regional languages for expanding the outreach of the APY Scheme and for the benefit of existing and potential APY subscribers as well as APY service providers. ■

FDI EQUITY INFLOW GROWS BY 168%

Measures taken by the Government on the fronts of FDI policy reforms, investment facilitation and ease of doing business have resulted in increased FDI inflows into the country.

- India has attracted total FDI inflow of US\$ 22.53 billion during first three months of 2021-22, i.e. April, 2021 to June, 2021 which is 90% higher as compared to first three months of 2020-21 (US\$ 11.84 billion).
- FDI equity inflow grew by 168% in the first three months of F.Y. 2021-22 (US\$ 17.57 billion) compared to the year ago period (US\$ 6.56 billion).
- 'Automobile Industry' has emerged as the top sector during the first three months of F.Y. 2021-22 with 27% share of the total FDI Equity inflow followed by Computer Software & Hardware (17%) and Services Sector (11%) respectively.
- Under the sector 'Automobile Industry', majority of FDI Equity inflow (88%) was reported in the state of Karnataka during the first three months of the current financial year (2021-22).
- Karnataka is the top recipient state during the F.Y. 2021-22 (upto June, 2021) with 48% share of the total FDI Equity inflows followed by Maharashtra (23%) and Delhi (11%). ■

HIGHEST EVER FAIR AND REMUNERATIVE PRICE OF 290 Rs./QTL APPROVED FOR SUGARCANE FARMERS (GANNAKISAN)

Keeping in view interest of sugarcane farmers (GannaKisan), the Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs chaired by Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi on September 25 has approved Fair and Remunerative Price (FRP) of sugarcane for sugar season 2021-22 (October - September) at Rs. 290/- per quintal for a basic recovery rate of 10%, providing a premium of Rs. 2.90/qtl for each 0.1% increase in recovery over and above 10%, & reduction in FRP by Rs. 2.90/qtl for every 0.1% decrease in recovery. The Government's proactive approach to protect interest of farmers is also seen in the decision of no deduction in case of sugar mills where recovery is below 9.5%. Such farmers will get Rs. 275.50 per quintal for sugarcane in ensuing sugar season 2021-22 in place of Rs. 270.75/qtl in current sugar season 2020-21.

The cost of production of sugarcane for the sugar season 2021-22 is Rs. 155 per quintal. This FRP of Rs. 290 per quintal at a recovery rate of 10% is higher by 87.1% over production cost, thereby giving the farmers a return of much more than 50% over their cost. ■

PM MODI TOPS AMONG WORLD LEADERS IN GLOBAL APPROVAL RATINGS

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi's approval ratings were the highest among thirteen world leaders surveyed by US-based global leader approval tracker 'Morning Consult'. The survey data is updated on a weekly basis. Morning Consult Political Intelligence on September 2 has updated the approval rating for 13 governmental leaders in Australia, Brazil, Canada, France, Germany, India, Italy, Japan, Mexico, South Korea, Spain, the United Kingdom, and the United States. Approval ratings are based on a seven-day moving average of adult residents in each country, and samples sizes vary by country.

With 70 per cent, Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi is ahead of Mexican president Andres Manuel Lopez Obrador, Italian Prime Minister Mario Draghi, German Chancellor Angela Merkel, US President Joe Biden, Australian Prime Minister Scott Morrison, Canadian Prime Minister Justin Trudeau, UK Prime Minister Boris Johnson and Brazilian President Jair Bolsonaro.

Morning Consult conducts more than 11,000 daily interviews globally about leadership approval and 5,000 daily interviews with registered voters in the United States, about the presidential and congressional elections.

The daily global survey data is based on a 7-day moving average of all adults in a given country with a margin of error of between +/- 1-3%. All interviews are conducted online, among nationally representative samples of adults.

Surveys are weighted in each country by age, gender, region, and, in certain countries, education breakdowns based on official government sources. In the United States, surveys are also weighted by race and ethnicity. Respondents complete these surveys in languages appropriate for their

In our Country, the king may have been first recognized in antiquity but the society as a nation is considered self-born. State is only an institution.

Similarly other institutions, like the state, are created from time to time as the need is felt. Every individual is a limb of one or more of these institutions. A person is a member of his family, as well as his community; he may also be a member of some association of his fellow professionals, if he pursues a profession. Above all he is a member of the nation and society. If we consider even larger sphere he is a member of the whole mankind, and then the entire universe, Truly speaking an individual is not merely a single entity but a plural entity. He is a part of not just one, but a member of many institutions. He lives a variety of lives. The most important aspect, is that despite this multiple personality, he can and should behave in a way which does not bring different aspects of his life into mutual conflict but which is mutually sustaining, complementary and unifying. This quality is inherent in man.

A person who uses this quality properly, becomes happy and on the other hand one who does not do so, reaps unhappiness. Such a person will not have balanced development in the life. As an illustration, a man is son of his another, husband of his wife, brother of his sister and father of his son. A single individual is a father and is also a son, he is brother and also husband. he has to maintain all these relation with intelligence, understanding and tact. Where a person fails to do so, there is conflict. If he sides with one party the other feels wronged. The conflicts between his wife and his sisters, his wife and mother result from his inability to behave properly. There upon some of his relations are strained. He is pained because his duties towards his mother and towards his wife clash. When he can resolve this conflict, and fulfil all his obligations properly, it can be said that his development will be integrated.

SOCIETY AND INDIVIDUAL NOT CONFLICTING

We do not accept the view that there is any permanent inevitable conflict among the multifarious personality of an individual, and different institutions of the society. If a conflict does exist, it is a sign of decadence perversion and not of nature or culture. The error in western thinking lies in that some people

there believe that human progress is a result of this fundamental conflict. Therefore they consider the conflict between the individual and the state as a natural occurrence, on the same basis they also theorized on the class conflict.

Classes do exist in a society. Here too, there were castes, but we had never accepted, conflict between one caste and another as fundamental concept behind it. In our concept of four castes, they are thought of as analogous to the different limbs of Virat-purusha. It was suggested that from the head of the Virat-Purusha Brahmins were created, Kshatriyas from hands, Vaishyas from his abdomen and Shudras from legs. If we analyze this concept we are faced with the question whether there can arise any conflict among the head, arms, stomach and legs of the same Virat Purusha. If conflict is fundamental, the body cannot be maintained. There cannot be any conflict in the different parts of the same body. On the contrary “one man” prevails. These limbs are not only complementary to one another, but even further, there is individual unity. There is a complete identity of interest identity of belonging. The origin of the caste system was on the above basis. If this idea is not kept alive; the castes, instead of being complementary,

can produce conflict. But then this is distortion. It is not a systematic arrangement, rather it is absence of any plan, any arrangement. This is indeed the present condition of our society.

This process of deterioration can set in the various institutions of a society due to a variety of reasons. If the soul of the society weakens, then all the different limbs of the society will grow feeble and ineffective. Any particular institution may be tendered useless or even harmful. Besides the need and the usefulness of any particular institution may change with time, place and circumstances. While examining the present state of an institution we ought at the same time, to think of what it should be like; mutual complementary and a sense of unity, alone can be the standards of proper conduct. Family, Community, Trade Union, Gram Panchayat, Janapada, State and such other institutions are various limbs of the nation and even of mankind. They are interdependent, initially complementary. There should be a sense of unity through all of them. For this very reason, there should be a tendency toward mutual accommodation in them instead of conflict or opposition.

State is one of the several institutions, an important one, but it is not above all other. One of the major reasons for the problems of the present day world is that almost everyone thinks of the state to be synonymous with the society. At least in practice, they consider the state as the sole representative of the society. Other institutions have declined in their effectiveness while the state has become dominant to such an extent that all the powers are gradually being centralized in the state.

We had not considered the state to be the sole representative of the nation. Our national life continued uninterruptedly even after the state went in the hands of foreigners. The Persian nation came to an end with their loss of independence. In our country, there were foreign rules now and then in various parts of the country. At the same time the Pathans seized the throne of Delhi, and then the Turks; the Mughals and the British too established their rules. Despite all this, our national life went on, because the state was not its centre. If we had considered state as the centre, we

would have been finished as a nation long time ago. In some tale for children, it is described that an evil spirit resided in some parrot and to kill the evil spirit one had to kill that parrot. Those nations whose life centred in the state, were finished with the end of the state. On the other hand, where state was not believed central to its life, the nation survived the transfer of political power.

This had its effects also. Dr. Ambedkar had said that our Gram Panchayats were so strong that we neglected the throne of Delhi. We did not remain alert as regards the state. As much as we ought to have done, thinking that nation's life did not depend on the state. We forgot that, though it may not be central, the state is definitely an important institution

Dr. Ambedkar had said that our Gram Panchayats were so strong that we neglected the throne of Delhi. We did not remain alert as regards the state...

...serving some needs of the nation, just as a limb of the body. It is possible to pluck a hair without much harm but along with the hair, if some skin is also removed, and a little further, if the head too is cut off, then there will be great loss for the body. Therefore the body must be protected. Although the various limbs of the body are not absolutely indispensable yet each of them serves an important

purpose. From the same standpoint, state, too, should have been deemed important in the life of a nation. There were persons who attended to this aspect. It was for this reason that the great teacher of Shivaji, Samarth Ramdas Swami, directed him to establish his kingdom. Dharma wields its own power. Dharma is important in life. Shri Ramdas would as well have preached to Shivaji to become a mendicant and spread Dharma following his own example. But on the contrary, he inspired Shivaji to extend his rule, because state too, is an important institution of the society. However, to consider something important is different from saying that it is supreme. The state is not supreme. The question arises, then, that if the state is not of fundamental importance, what is that is absolutely important. Let us consider this question. ■

(Excerpts of the Speech delivered on "Integral Humanism" in Bombay on April 22nd - 25th, 1965 by Pt. Deendayal Upadhyaya in the form of four lectures.)

'IF I HAD TWO DEENDAYALS, I WOULD HAVE ALTERED THE MAP OF INDIAN POLITICS'

Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya was born on 25th September 1916 to Pt. Bhagwati Prasad Upadhyaya and Smt. Rampyari.

Deendayal or "Deena" as he was known in childhood was born at his maternal uncle's home in Dhanakia in Rajasthan, while his father belonged to Nagla Chandrabhan in Mathura, the land sanctified by Sri Krishna.

At Nagla Chandrabhan today stands a grand memorial dedicated to the life and contributions of Deendayal Upadhyaya, recounting the saga of his inspiring life.

Two years later, Deendayalji's younger brother Shivdayal was born. Bhagwati Prasad, Station Master at Jalesar Road Station, died suddenly when Deena was just two and a half years old. The family was given shelter by his maternal uncle. But the series of bereavements in Deena's life did not end with this, his mother Rampyari died when Deena was just four years old and his brother Shivdayal, struck with pneumonia, died in 1934.

Destiny however had something else, something greater in store for Deena. An exceptionally brilliant student, a keen observer with a razor sharp mind and analytical skills, Deendayalji topped examinations, received accolades and prizes and repeatedly earned scholarship through the dint of hard work.

Having passed the

intermediate examination from Rajasthan, Deendayalji completed his Bachelors from the Sanatana Dharma College in Kanpur and enrolled at the St. John's College in Agra for his Masters.

Having topped in the civil services examination, Deendayalji chose not to take up a government job and instead focused on further studies, joining a B.T. course in Prayag.

It was at this crucial and



formative period of his life that Deendayalji came in touch with the activities of the Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh (RSS). This meeting, this discovery and association altered the direction of his life and transformed it altogether.

Henceforth he was determined to dedicate his life and all his energies to the upliftment of Bharatiya samaj and became a Pracharak of the Sangh dedicating his life to national regeneration.

Very soon Deendayalji was given the responsibility of organising RSS work in Uttar Pradesh – then known as United Province – and became district Pracharak of Lakhimpur Kheri in 1942 and eventually rose up to become the Sah Prant Pracharak of entire UP in 1945.

When the Bharatiya Jana Sangh was eventually formed in 1951, Deendayalji became one of its organisational pillars. He was among those select Swayamsevaks that Guruji Sri Golwalkar sent on request from Dr. Syama Prasad Mookerjee for organising the new party.

Deeply impressed by Deendayalji's organisational skills, political acumen and leadership qualities, Dr. Syama Prasad Mookerjee selected him as General Secretary of the new party, in the historic Kanpur Conference of the Jana Sangh in December 1952.

So moved was Dr. Mookerjee by Deendayalji's performance and capacities that he famously declared once that "If I had two Deendayals, I would have altered the map of Indian politics."

Deendayalji shouldered his responsibilities as General Secretary till 1967 and built the base of the new party, spread its ideals and organisation across the country and successfully articulated a new political vision for India.

It was in the historic Calicut (Kozhikode) session of the Jana

Sangh that Deendayalji became the national president of the party.

But his grand and tireless march towards realising the dream of a great and regenerated India came to an abrupt and shocking end when he was found dead, under mysterious circumstances, on the night of 11th February 1968 near Mughalsarai railway station.

His life was cut short just at the moment when he was starting to assume the mantle of an all India leader. Thus ended an inspiring, a dedicated and profoundly committed life of a leader whose sole aim was to rebuild a great Bharat.

In his tribute, Sri Guruji described Deendayalji as an 'Ideal Swayamsevak' to whom alone the credit must for "starting from scratch and building up such an imposing organization [like Jana Sangh] from its very foundation up." He asked all to make Deendayalji "an ideal for the kind of all round perfection he had attained."

Integral Humanism recognises unity in diversity as unique expression of our cultural life, as Deendayalji said, "Unity in diversity and the expression of unity in various forms has remained the thought of Bharatiya Culture."

The vision of Integral Humanism envisages the integral well-being of the individual and seeks to achieve a balance, cohesion and harmony between the body, mind, intellect and soul. The call to action of 'Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikaas' is a direct manifestation of that vision. ■

SALIENT FEATURES OF THE AGREEMENT

- This Memorandum of Settlement will ensure greater devolution of autonomy to the Karbi Anglong Autonomous Council, protection of identity, language, culture, etc. of Karbi people and focussed development of the Council area, without affecting the territorial and administrative integrity of Assam.
- The Karbi armed groups have agreed to abjure violence and join the peaceful democratic process as established by law of the land. The Agreement also provides for rehabilitation of cadres of the armed groups.
- The Government of Assam shall set up a Karbi Welfare Council for focussed development of Karbi people living outside KAAC area.
- The Consolidated Fund of the State will be augmented to supplement the resources of KAAC.
- Overall, the present settlement proposes to give more legislative, executive, administrative and financial powers to KAAC.

Prime Minister, northeast has not only been an area of focus for Shri Narendra Modi, but all-round development of northeast, peace and prosperity there has been the top priority for the Government.

The education system in the country is evolving at a substantial pace. With a re-boot of India's education system through the National Education Policy (NEP) -2020, the Government instituted a series of far-reaching reforms to achieve a paradigm shift from traditional learning towards flexible, equitable, and inclusive education.

National Education policy- 2020 is a document that will reshape the destiny of the nation both in terms of its internal resilience and enhanced resources and its standing in the world. It is a guiding philosophy, a sacred text, if you will, for the Modi Government, a tool to transform the hopes and aspirations of millions of the youth to reality---building on the principles of quality, equity, access and affordability.

The NEP creates a knowledge economy through multiple pathways of linguistic proficiency of a three-language policy to enable mother tongue/ local language or regional language as the medium of instruction. The Government

has also taken a big step by introducing/allowing institutes to impart technical education in mother tongue/regional language from the current academic year. So that language does not become a stumbling block for talent. 14 engineering colleges of eight states will impart education in five Indian languages of Hindi, Tamil,

Telugu, Marathi and Bangla.

The NEP 2020 promotes integration of vocational education programmes into mainstream education. It foresees a bold new future in Vocational Education for skilling the future generation. Towards this, skill labs will be set up and created in the schools in a hub and spoke model which will allow other schools to use the facility. Secondary schools will collaborate with ITIs, polytechnics,

local industry, etc.

Across the globe, classroom teaching is pursued in a range of regional languages, be it in France, Germany, Russia or China, which has over 300 languages and dialects with 8 of them being major ones. Also, studies around the world have shown that children are able to learn multiple languages if they are taught from an early age. One can actively promote regional languages without compromising knowledge of the English language, which can be taught as a subject. It is important to remember that English is one of the many skills which one can equip children with for them to fully participate in and experience the world.

The NEP conflates quality education with making learning fun and prepares a child for formal schools through the new 5+3+3+4 school education system. The idea of playschools till date had been largely confined to the middle or the upper class in cities who can afford private schools. The rigid classifications between skilling and schooling (academic), curricular and extra-curricular, humanities and the sciences have been broken fostering multidisciplinary, conceptual understanding and critical thinking. This engenders

the potential for creative combinations, for instance of math with painting. To counter the numerous pressure points that a students' life has come to acquire, a holistic progress card instead of a marksheet will be provided at the end of the session, which will assess aptitude vis-à-vis skills, efficiency, competency and other talents.

Every high school child will undergo vocational education that will start from grade 6 and include internships. There will be multiple entry and exit options for an undergraduate and post graduate student with appropriate certification for each exit point.

A digital infrastructure for school education that will function independently but interoperably called NDEAR, which is a set of principles, standards and guidelines, has been created. This will energize the digital education ecosystem and is indispensable to the quality of reformative changes as envisioned by Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

For the higher education sector, an Academic Bank of Credit (ABC), will facilitate the digital storage of all academic credits earned from different higher education institutions (HEIs), including

for vocational and academic training, grades accumulated if the student has exited the system, at some point, and other such unique situations so that these can be transferred into a final degree form. Crucially, this will help twinning arrangements with foreign universities as envisaged under the NEP for students to complete a semester in a partner foreign institute.

Also, the HEIs across the country barring legal and medical institutions will have a single regulator called the Higher Education Council of India (HECI). This will ensure "light but tight" regulatory framework.

The thread tying all these initiatives will be a special emphasis given on socially and economically disadvantaged groups, setting up of a gender

inclusion fund, special education zones for disadvantaged regions and groups while states will be encouraged to establish Bal Bhavans or daytime boarding schools.

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi envisions that the NEP 2020 nurtures the highest potential of the child by breaking unproductive silos. This policy has come after one of the largest consultation processes in the history of education systems globally and reflects the resolve and vision of our leadership to situate India at the top of the knowledge economy.

As we celebrate 'Amrut Mahotsav', or 75 years of India's independence, the National Education policy- 2021 will indelibly groom children who today fall between the age of 5 and 15 years and who will be in the peak productive age of between 30 and 40 years when India hits the mark of 100 years of independence, or Azadi 100. It is my privilege that I have been given a part in this process of creating a workforce who will be the flagbearers of a global community basing on scientific thought, critical thinking and humanism. ■

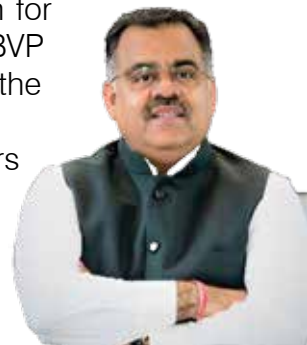
along with people to India.

Allow me at the outset to congratulate you for the massive success of the 'Jan Aashirwad Yatra' organised by BJP in various states across the country. As the National In-Charge of the Yatra can you please tell a little about the thought behind this grand programme and its objectives?

INDIA BECOMES THIRD LARGEST STARTUP ECOSYSTEM IN WORLD

The Union Government led by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi in the month of January 2016 launched 'Startup India Initiative' with aim and vision to support entrepreneurs, build a robust startup ecosystem and transform India into a country from job seekers to job creators. Earlier, the mechanism that prevailed was complex and not streamlined which discouraged several small and medium entrepreneurs to float a startup.

The government started encouraging entrepreneurship through implementation of clear compliances, easier exit process for failed startups, fast tracking of patent applications, a dedicated website to reduce information asymmetry, exemptions on Income Tax and Capital Gains Tax for eligible startups, a fund of funds to infuse more capital into the startup ecosystem and a credit guarantee scheme. Simultaneously, India's ranking in 'Ease of Doing Business' is continuously improving. The

dedicated efforts of Modi government have brought India among top 3 countries which have largest startup ecosystems in the world. According to Unicorn list 2021 published by Hurun Research institute at the end of August, India has become 3rd largest startup ecosystem in the world after US and China.

The term 'Unicorn' is used in financial world to describe a privately owned startup company with a valuation exceeding \$ 1 billion. In the last one year, India has added three unicorns every month taking the total number of the unicorns to 51, ahead of the UK(32) and Germany(18). With total 396 unicorns, US remains at top and China, with 277 unicorns, is placed 2nd position. Presently, total worth of unicorns in India is at \$168 billion. The report stated that India added

25 unicorns in 2021 alone. Apart from unicorns, the Hurun Research institute has prepared a list of future unicorns in India. It categorizes future unicorns in two group- gazelles and cheetahs. Gazelles are those startups which have potential to become unicorns within two years and cheetahs are those having potential to be unicorns within four years.

The list of future unicorns reveals that 32 future unicorns under "gazelles" category valued over 500 billion dollars can convert into unicorn in two years, while there are 54 comes under "cheetahs" category having valuation over 200 million dollars can achieve the status of unicorn within four years. Online retail store Zilingo is the most valuable Gazelle and online furniture platform Pepperfry is the most valuable Cheetah.

Gaming company Mobile Premier League based in Bengaluru takes the second rank on the Hurun. Mobile Premier League got a total investment of US\$230mn from investors such as

Sequoia Capital, Moore Strategic Ventures, SIG, Pegasus Tech Ventures, Founders Circle and others. Rebel Foods is India's first cloud kitchen start-up, ranked third in the Hurun India Future Unicorn List 2021. Cure Fit a Fitness start-up ranked fourth on the Hurun India Future Unicorn List 2021. In June 2021, Tata Digital entered into an agreement to invest up to US\$75mn in CureFit backed by global investors such as Temasek, Accel Partners, Epiq Capital, Unilever Swiss and others. Gurugram based E-commerce company Spinny gets the fourth rank on the Hurun India Future Unicorn List 2021. With 900 employees, Spinny currently operates in 9 cities and raised more than US\$120mn.

Other future unicorns which are under top 10 are

travel technology company Rate Gain, E-commerce Mamaearth (Gurugram), Gurugram based CarDekho, robotics start-up GreyOrange, Fintech company also based in Gurugram MobiKwik.

Top ten sectors which found place in future unicorns list 2021 are FinTech(18 companies), E-commerce(17 companies), SaaS(7 companies), Shared Economy(6 companies), Gaming(4 companies), Artificial Intelligence(4), Logistics(4), HealthTech(4), Media & Entertainment(3), EduTech(3), Consumer Goods(3).

A unique feature has surfaced in Hurun's research that founder of startups in future unicorn list have graduated and post graduated from either IIT or IIM. The report indicates that India is becoming able to stop brain drain problem to which it has been grappling for long time. The research also states that 11 co-founders are under the age of 30 and 15 above the age of 50.

Other unique feature of the Hurun's findings is emerging entrepreneurial skills in women. On the occasion of International Women's Day, Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi had congratulated women in a unique way. Prime Minister Narendra Modi did some special shopping on that day and bought goods prepared by women entrepreneurs, designers. In this unique way, he intends to encourage

women entrepreneurs. His government has brought various reforms and cleared roadblock to promote Nari Shakti of new India in entrepreneurship. The data released by Hurun's research institute reflects unleashing the entrepreneurial spirit of Women. 12 start-ups on Future Unicorn List 2021 are co-founded by women entrepreneurs. Women entrepreneurs co-founded five Gazelles and seven Cheetahs on the Hurun India Future Unicorn List 2021. Likewise, six women entrepreneurs co-founded Unicorn start-ups in India.

The average age of founders in the list is 39 years. It means the Government's startup India initiative is attracting young talents. The report has placed Bengaluru, Delhi NCR and Mumbai among 3 major startup hub cities. With 31 startups, Bengaluru remained first major startup hub city of India followed by Delhi NCR with 18 startups and then Mumbai with 13 startups.

These startups are attracting both domestic and foreign investment. The Modi government's initiative for making investment friendly climate in the country has increased investors faith in India. The top investors in the Gazelles and Cheetahs are Sequoia, followed by Tiger Global with 37 and 18 investments respectively. ■

UNION HOME MINISTER LAUNCHES VARIOUS DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS IN KARNATAKA

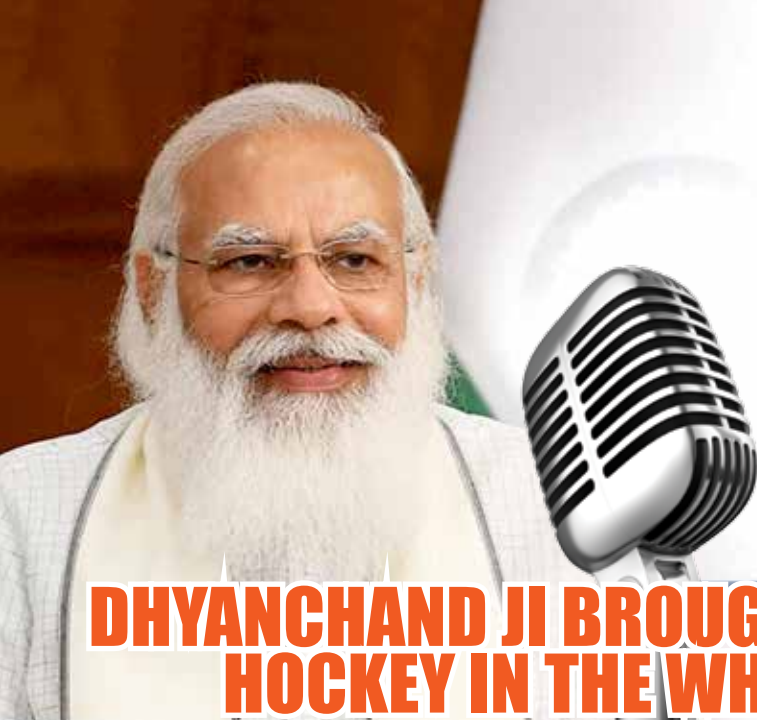

- Friends, this time, the Olympics have created a major impact. The events at the Olympics are over; the Paralympics are going on. Whatever our country earned in this world of Sports may be little in comparison with the world, but enough has happened to bolster our belief. Today, it is not that the youth is just watching sports...the youth is also looking at possibilities associated with Sports...observing the entire eco system minutely...comprehending its potential, wishing to connect with it in some way or the other. It is only through collective endeavour of all that India will attain glorious heights in Sports that she rightfully deserves. .
- My dear countrymen, during this Corona period, the myriad aspects of cleanliness that I should have touched upon; I feel, perhaps, that it saw a decrease. I also feel that we should not let the cleanliness campaign diminish even at the slightest. The examples of how efforts by everyone for nation building in turn lead to progress for all of us, also inspire us and infuse us with a new energy to do something, impart new confidence, give a meaning to our resolve. We know very well that

whenever the topic Swachh Bharat Abhiyan comes up, the name of Indore also arises because Indore has created a special identity of its own in relation to cleanliness and the people of Indore are also entitled to felicitations. And now they have decided to maintain a 'Water Plus City' and are striving for it with all their might.

- 'Water Plus City' means a city where no sewage is dumped into any public water source without treatment. The citizens here themselves have come forward and connected their drains with the sewer line. A Cleanliness campaign has also been started and due to this the polluted water draining in the Saraswati and Kanh rivers has also reduced considerably and an improvement is visible. Today, when our country is celebrating the Amrit Mahotsav of Independence, we have to remember that we should never let the resolve of the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan diminish. The greater the number of cities which are 'Water Plus City' in our country, cleanliness will increase further, our rivers will also become clean and we will be fulfilling values associated with humane responsibility of conserving water.
- Friends, before me is an example that has come from Madhubani in Bihar. Dr. Rajendra Prasad Agricultural University in Madhubani and the local Krishi Vigyan Kendra have jointly made a worthy effort. Not only farmers are accruing benefit from this scheme but it has also imparted renewed vigour to the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan. The name of this initiative of the university is - "Sukhet Model" The purpose of the Sukhet model is to reduce pollution in the villages. Under this model, dung and other household waste is collected from the farmers of the village and in return the villagers are given money for cooking gas cylinders. The work of making vermicompost from the disposed garbage collected from the village is also ongoing.
- My dear countrymen, 'Mann Ki Baat' is no longer confined to the borders of India. There is a discussion on 'Mann Ki Baat' in different corners of

the world too. And there are people from our Indian community living abroad, who keep providing me with much new information. And I also like to sometimes share with you the unique programs that are going on abroad in 'Mann Ki Baat'.

- My dear countrymen, in the next few days 'Vishwakarma Jayanti' will also be celebrated. Here, Bhagwan Vishwakarma is considered as a symbol of the creative power behind the genesis of the world. Whoever through their skill, builds an object..innovates...whether it is sewing-embroidery, software or satellite, all this is a manifestation of Bhagwan Vishwakarma. Even though skill is being recognized in a new way in the world today, our sages and seers have emphasized on skill and scale for thousands of years. They have interlinked

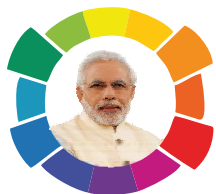

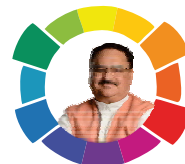
INDIA PERFORMS UNPRECEDENTED FEAT AT TOKYO PARALYMPICS

India's paralympians performed unprecedented feat at Tokyo Paralympics. They snatched 19 medals -which are largest ever, including five gold to finish 24th among 162 participating nations in the overall tally on the basis of gold medal count. India secured 20th position based on the total numbers of medals won. The medal count also included eight silver and six bronze. India had sent its largest contingent-ever with 54 para-athletes competing in nine sporting disciplines. Seventeen of them left Tokyo with medals, including multiple winners - shooters Avani Lakhera (gold-bronze) and Singhraj Adhana (silver-bronze).
