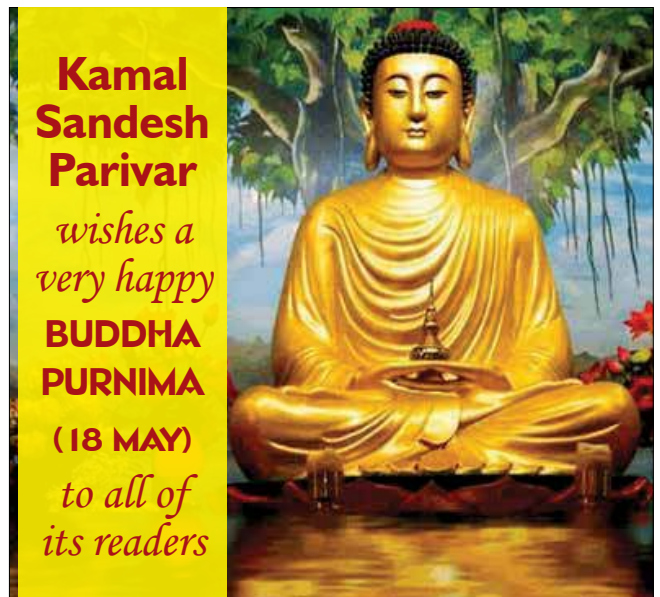

KASHI GIVES A ROARING WELCOME TO PM NARENDRA MODI'S MEGA ROADSHOW

PM FILES NOMINATION TO SEEK A SECOND TERM IN OFFICE FROM VARANASI

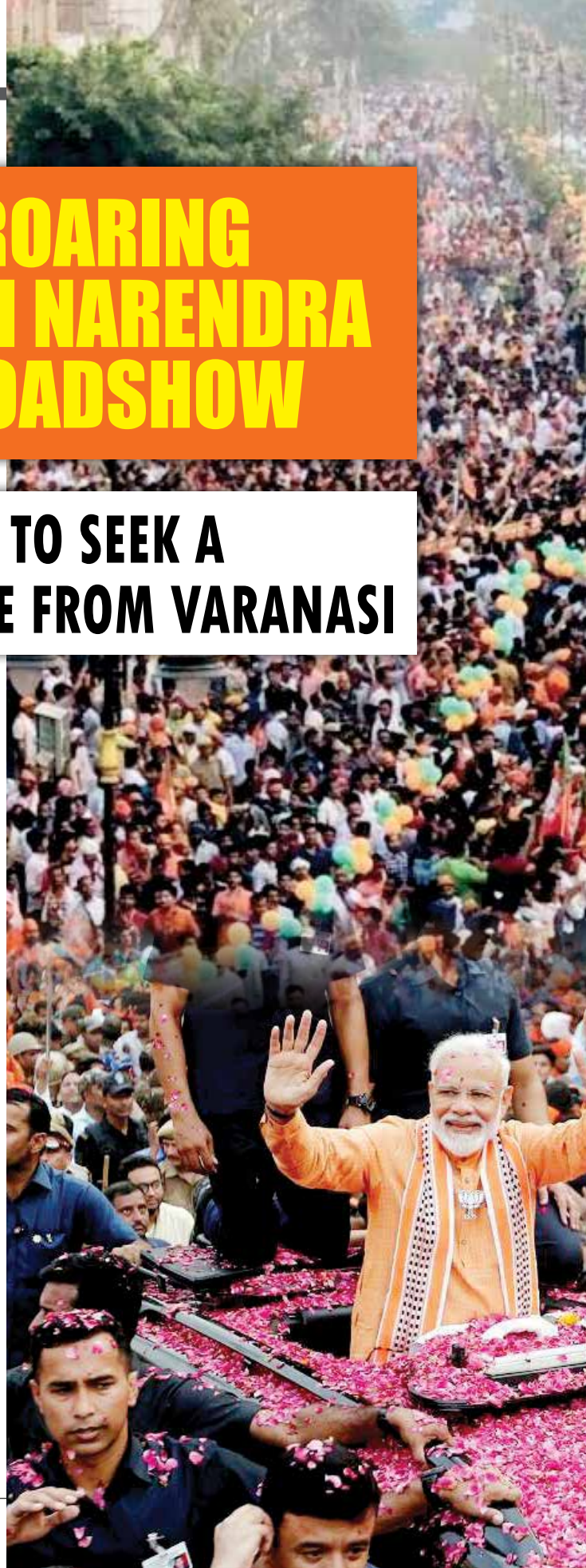
P rime Minister Shri Narendra Modi held a massive roadshow in his Lok Sabha constituency of Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh on 25 April, 2019 just a day before filing his nomination papers for the Lok Sabha elections. The Prime Minister received a roaring welcome by a sea of supporters who thronged the streets of Varanasi hours before the mega roadshow began. Soon after arriving in Varanasi, Shri Narendra Modi paid floral tributes to Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya at the gate of the Banaras Hindu University (BHU) and started his mega road show.

The massive roadshow which covered a stretch of over six kilometers, started from Lanka and passed through Assi, Bhadini and Sonarpura before culminating at the iconic Dashashwamedh Ghat, where the PM took part in the Ganga Arti.

SEA OF SAFFRON GREETS PM MODI DURING ROADSHOW

People from all walks of life joined PM Shri Modi as the roadshow progressed through the heart of Kashi and Lakhs of people welcomed him with tremendous enthusiasm.

Lakhs of people gathered on the streets, on roofs of buildings to catch a glimpse of the Prime Minister. Many were seen on rooftops waving at the PM and other BJP leaders. "Every rooftop, every road, every

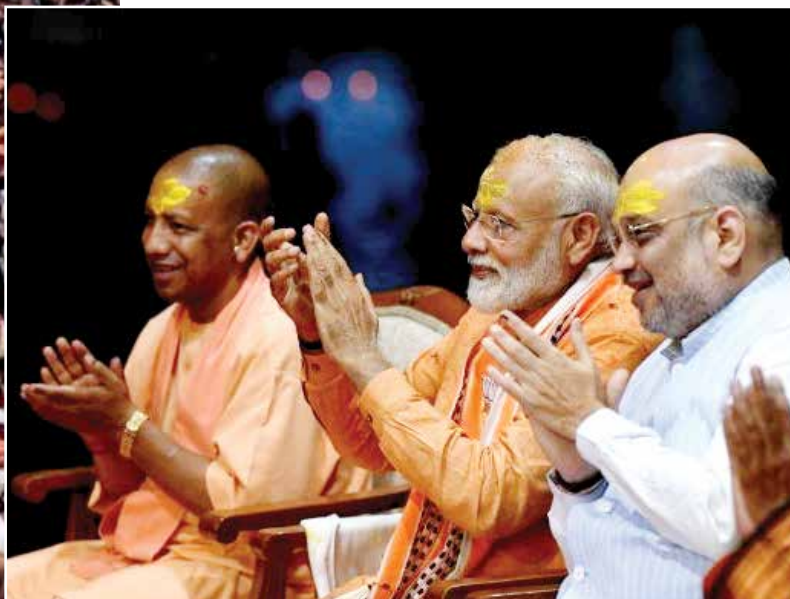




market was crammed with people. In 2014, when he came to file his nomination, the crowd was estimated at 500,000. Today it was 600,000," the Varanasi police said.

The atmosphere was euphoric in Kashi as the people waved to the Prime Minister, showered flower petals throughout the roadshow amid chants of "Modi-Modi". Touched by the people's affection, the Prime Minister too waved and greeted the people.

Several supporters were dressed as mythological characters, some others were dressed as Hindu



gods including Lord Hanuman and majority of the participants wore saffron dresses. Supporters wore t-shirts with the BJP slogan "Main bhi chowkidar" during the procession.

Among others, BJP National President Shri Amit Shah, Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath, Union Minister Shri JP Nadda, UP BJP President Shri Mahendra Nath Pandey, Delhi BJP President Shri Manoj Tiwari, and host of other senior leaders have also accompanied the Prime Minister at the event.

After his mega roadshow, Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi along with BJP National President Shri Amit Shah took part in 'Ganga Arti' at Dashashwamedh Ghat in Varanasi. Uttar Pradesh CM Yogi Adityanath, UP BJP President Shri Mahendra Nath Pandey were also present during the arti.

'NATION ABOVE EVERYTHING'

Shri Narendra Modi also thanked the people of Varanasi for their support after his mega roadshow in the city which saw Varanasi turn into a sea of saffron. Addressing the gathering after the roadshow, the PM said that he was indebted to the people of the holy city.

Talking about the developments carried out by the BJP government in Varanasi, the PM said that when he took oath on May 17, 2014, he wondered whether he will be able to live up to the expectations of the people of Kashi and said that with the collective effort of everyone and with the blessings of Baba Bholenath,



this holy city witnessed unprecedented development and the entire country is aware of it.

"Whatever happens, I will always think about the people of this country. I have lived by only one mantra all my life which is India First and I will make sure that I live up to the expectations of the people of Varanasi," the PM said.

The PM further said that Varanasi not only made him an MP but also blessed him to become the PM of India.

Talking tough on terror the PM said that fighting terrorism will remain his top priority and added that the holy city gave him the power to give a fitting reply to the terrorists in their own language. "This new India will not tolerate terrorism but will give terrorists a fitting reply in their own language. 40 of our soldiers

were martyred in Pulwama by the terrorists. After the attack, 42 militants have been slain in that very region. This is our style of working," he said.

NOMINATION FILING

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi filed his nomination papers from the Varanasi Lok Sabha seat, accompanied by a galaxy of top BJP and NDA leaders.

BJP National President Shri Amit Shah, Union Ministers Shri Rajnath Singh, Shri Nitin Gadkari, Smt. Sushma Swaraj, Smt. Nirmala Sitharaman, Shri Piyush Goyal, Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath National Democratic Alliance (NDA) leaders, including SAD President Shri Prakash Singh Badal, Bihar Chief Minister Shri Nitish Kumar, Shiv Sena chief Shri Uddhav Thackeray and All India Anna Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam (AIADMK) politicians from Tamil Nadu accompanied PM Shri Narendra Modi while he was filing nomination papers.

Before filing his nomination papers on 26 April, 2019 PM Shri Narendra Modi visited the Baba Kaal Bhairav temple and offered prayers there. The PM sought blessings from the deity who is also

known as the Kotwal of Kashi or the guard of Varanasi.

While on his way to the collector's office, Shri Narendra Modi was showered with rose petals by the public.

Earlier in the day, PM Shri Modi said, "Whether I win or not is not important. It's the democracy that should win. Forming the government is in people's hands, running it is our duty."

Shri Narendra Modi is seeking a second term in office from Varanasi, a parliamentary seat he handsomely won in 2014 by a massive margin of 3.37 lakh votes. BJP stormed to power in 2014 with the party winning 282 of the Lok Sabha's 543 constituencies. The BJP won an absolute majority in 2014, reducing the then-ruling Congress to a miserly 44 seats. ■

INDIA WILL BECOME 'SUPERPOWER' IF MODI BECOMES PM AGAIN: AMIT SHAH

With only last two phases of voting left, campaigning is reaching a hectic pitch in India. Elections are yet to be held in 118 seats, with most of them in the crucial Hindi heartland. In a whirlwind tour BJP National President Shri Amit Shah has been addressing rallies in every part of the country and several rallies are also scheduled in crucial states like West Bengal, where the BJP is going to break all records. Shri Shah's jam packed massive rallies and the responsive gathering reveals that BJP will come out with flying colors this time with more seats than 2014. We are publishing the excerpts of various speeches of BJP National President Shri Amit Shah for our readers.

BJP National President Shri Amit Shah asserted that India will emerge as a superpower in the next five years if Shri Narendra Modi becomes the Prime Minister again.

Addressing a massive gathering in Chandigarh, on 05 May, 2019 Shri Shah said the country was secure only under the Modi rule.

"I have come here to say if you make Shri Narendra Modi PM again, India will emerge as a superpower in the world in next five years," the BJP President told the gathering. He was campaigning for BJP nominee and sitting MP from Chandigarh, Smt. Kirron Kher.

Dubbing the Congress-led opposition 'Mahamilavati Mahagathbandhan', Shri Shah reiterated that only Shri Narendra Modi can keep the country secure. "On one side, BJP and its alliance partners, and on the other hand, there is 'Mahamilavati Mahagathbandhan' whose leader is Rahul Gandhi. Can they secure the country? Can they work for welfare of poor? Can they give a strong reply to terrorism? Can they give a strong reply to Pakistan?" he asked.

The BJP President said the 2019 Lok Sabha elections were being fought not only for development. "Development of poor, villages, farmers, cities will be carried out by Shri Modi. But the job of securing the country can only be done by Modi ji and one other," he said.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE SPEECH

- Shri Shah raised the issue of Balakot strikes and attacked the Congress for seeking proof of the strikes.



- Congress-led opposition is 'Mahamilavati Mahagathbandhan'.
- He also vowed to scrap Article 370 (granting special status to Jammu and Kashmir) while asserting that Kashmir will always remain an integral part of India.

BJP RALLY IN GHATAL, WEST BENGAL



‘WILL LORD RAM’S NAME BE TAKEN IN PAK, IF NOT IN INDIA’

BJP National President Shri Amit Shah said that West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee is not allowing people to chant ‘Jai Shri Ram’ in the state, and wondered if the Lord’s name cannot be taken in India, will it be uttered in Pakistan.

Speaking at an election rally in Ghatal, on 07 May, 2019 he said that polls in West Bengal are for restoring democracy in the state, where the BJP will win more than 23 seats out of the total 42 Lok Sabha seats.

“Lord Ram is a part of the culture of India... Can anybody stop people from taking his name? I want to ask Mamata didi, if Shri Ram’s name is not taken in India, will it be chanted in Pakistan?” Shri Shah said.

A video had appeared in the social media that showed Banerjee stopping her car at a place in West Midnapore district, and chasing some persons who chanted ‘Jai Shri Ram’ as her carcade was crossing the area.

“The Narendra Modi government has given Rs. 4,24,800 crore to West Bengal in its five-year tenure, but it has not reached the people, and, instead, gone to the syndicates,” Shri Shah claimed.

He said the UPA-II government under the then prime minister Manmohan Singh had granted only

around Rs. 1,32,000 crore to the state.

At another election meeting at Keshiari in Paschim Medinipur district, he said, “What wrong has PM Shri Narendra Modi done by saying that the Bofors scam happened during Rajiv Gandhi’s tenure.” The BJP President was referring to Shri Modi’s recent remarks at a rally in Uttar Pradesh, where he said that Rajiv Gandhi’s life ended as “bhrashtachari no. 1” (corrupt no.1).

“Rahul baba says his father has been insulted. Is it an insult to be reminded of what had happened?” he said.

Shri Shah also asked Rahul Gandhi whether or not the Bofors scandal, the Bhopal gas tragedy, blunder of sending peacekeeping force to Sri Lanka or the massacre of Kashmiri pandits happen during his father’s tenure as prime minister from 1984 to 1989.

He said that the Congress and its partners in the ‘Mahagathbandhan’ have abused Modi on 51 different occasions.

The BJP President reiterated BJP’s resolve to implement the National Register of Citizens (NRC) in West Bengal to flush out illegal migrants from Bangladesh. ■

UJJWALA SCHEME BOOSTS INDIA'S LPG CONSUMPTION TO A RECORD HIGH IN FY19

India's demand for liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) rose to a record in the fiscal year ended in March amid government measures to provide cleaner cooking fuel to rural households, and analysts expect consumption to keep rising. About two-thirds of India's population live in rural areas, typically using firewood, coal or dried dung cakes for cooking.

India consumed a record 24.9 million tonnes of LPG in the financial year 2018-19, 53 per cent higher than five years ago, and 6.9 per cent higher than the previous year. The boost follows a social welfare programme, known as the Ujjwala scheme, launched by the government in 2016 that has provided about 72 million new LPG connections to households in 714 districts, according to official data.

"Supported by government policies, mainly through the 'Ujjwala Scheme' and a rising middle class population, LPG penetration in Indian rural areas has been extremely robust,"



Amid the Ujjwala programme, close to 80 per cent of Indian households have access to LPG as of the end of 2018, up from 56 per cent in 2016, according to FGE.

Growing LPG consumption has kindled a surge in India's imports of the fuel, and analysts expect this trend to intensify. ■

Rahul Gandhi tenders unconditional apology for attributing 'chowkidar chor hai' remarks to SC

Congress president Rahul Gandhi on 8 May, 2019 tendered an unconditional apology in the Supreme Court for wrongfully attributing to the apex court the 'chowkidar chor hai' remark in the Rafale verdict.

He also sought closure of the criminal contempt proceedings against him on a petition filed by BJP MP Smt. Meenakshi Lekhi.

In a fresh three-page affidavit, Gandhi said he holds the apex court in the "highest esteem and respect" and that he has never sought to do anything which interferes with the process of administration of justice.

"The deponent (Rahul Gandhi) unconditionally apologises for the wrongful attributions to this court. The deponent further states that any such attributions were entirely unintentional, non-wilful and inadvertent," Gandhi said in his affidavit.

"The deponent most respectfully prays that this court may be graciously pleased to accept the instant affidavit and close the present contempt proceedings," the affidavit stated.

Gandhi also said the affidavit is made "bonafide and in the interest of justice, and nothing material has been concealed therefrom."

"At the outset the deponent herein most respectfully submits that he holds this court in the highest esteem, and respect. The deponent has never sought or intended to, directly or indirectly, commit any act that it interferes with the process of administration of justice," the Congress chief said in his affidavit.

BJP MP Smt. Meenakshi Lekhi, who filed the contempt petition against Gandhi, had alleged that he has attributed his personal remarks to the top court and tried to create prejudice. ■

MASOOD AZHAR: JAISH-E-MOHAMMED LEADER LISTED AS TERRORIST BY UN

The United Nation has declared Masood Azhar a global terrorist. It is big diplomatic win as India had been trying to declare Masood Azhar as Global terrorist for last many years. China, a permanent member of the United Nations Security Council, had been blocking India's move against Masood Azhar. Masood Azhar is the leader of Jaish-e-Mohammed (JeM), which carried out a suicide bombing in February killing 40 troops in Jammu & Kashmir recently. Masood Azhar will be subject to an assets freeze and a travel ban.

Chronology of the major events which led to the ban:

2009: India moves a proposal by itself to designate Azhar as a global terrorist, a listing that will subject him to global travel ban, asset freeze and arms embargo. China blocks the move.

2016: India again moves the proposal with the backing of the P3 - the United States, the United Kingdom and France in the UN's 1267 Sanctions Committee to ban Azhar.

2017: The P3 nations move a similar proposal again. China, a veto-wielding permanent member of the Security Council, blocks the proposal from being adopted.

February 27, 2019: The US, the UK and France move a fresh proposal in the UN Security Council to designate Azhar as a global terrorist.

March 13, 2019: China puts the hold on the proposal scuttling yet another attempt to blacklist the JeM chief. The proposal was the fourth such bid at the UN in the last 10 years to list Azhar as a global terrorist.

March 28, 2019: The US, supported by France and the UK, directly moves a draft resolution in the UN Security Council to blacklist the Pakistan-based terror group's chief.

GST COLLECTION SCALES ALL-TIME HIGH OF 1.13 TRILLION IN APRIL

GST revenue mop-up scaled a monthly record high of over Rs 1.13 trillion in April, 2019 an increase of 10 per cent over the collection in the year-ago period, on the back of anti-evasion steps taken by tax officers.

Total number of summary sales return GSTR-3B filed for the month of March up to April 30 stood at 72.13 lakh.

April 2019 is the second consecutive month when Goods and Services Tax (GST) collection exceeded Rs 1 trillion. In March, the mop-up was Rs 1.06 trillion. "The total gross GST revenue collected in April 2019 is Rs 1,13,865 crore. The revenue in April 2018 was Rs 1,03,459 crore and the revenue during April 2019 is a growth of 10.05 per cent over the revenue in the same month last year," a finance ministry statement said.

"The total revenue earned by the central government and state governments after regular



and provisional settlement in April 2019 is Rs 47,533 crore for CGST and Rs 50,776 crore for SGST," the statement added.

Also, collection in April 2019, which is the first month of the current fiscal, has been the highest since introduction of GST on July 1, 2017. Year-on-year comparison of tax collection data gives a better picture of economic activity. ■

He has been shot dead by terrorists at Nowgam, Verinag in South Kashmir. BJP state spokesman Altaf Thakur said that Gul Muhammad Mir was fired upon by suspected militants at his home this evening. Termed the killing as barbaric, Altaf Thakur said, "He received four bullets and was brought dead to the hospital." ■

BJB MANDAL PRESIDENT MANGULI JENA KILLED IN ODISHA

Bhordha Mandal BJP President Manguli Jena was shot at near Khurda BJP MLA candidate Kalucharan Khadayat's residence by unidentified gunmen in Khurda, Odisha just a day ahead of Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi's visit to the state during Lok Sabha elections. This is the second instance of poll violence in the state during the Lok Sabha election 2019 in less than three weeks.

He sustained critical bullet injuries and was admitted to the district hospital but was declared dead on arrival by doctors.

A CONVENIENT SEASON FOR BEING A 'PROUD HINDU'

In the late 1980s and the early 1990s, the VHP would distribute stickers which became a launching pad for its slogan “गर्व से कहो हम हिन्दू हैं”. Barring the BJP, a few other groups endorsed it, others denounced this slogan as symbol of communalism. I am sure those still active in the VHP from that era would have had the last laugh when the Congress leader and its candidate from Bhopal, Digvijay Singh, felt compelled to publicly announce “I too am a proud Hindu”. A fundamental disagreement with Nehruvian secularism, as practiced in the 1950s, was that Panditji believed that Hinduism was old fashioned, fundamentalist and obscurantist. He believed that it stood in the way of developing a scientific temperament.

This politics continued for decades. In a multi-cornered election, parties like the SP, the BSP, the RJD and, of late, even the TMC, went a step further of the Congress. They created fear in the minds of minorities and endeavoured

to develop a vote combination of a specific caste or a group and that of the Muslim minority. They owed their survival to this polarisation. A significant attempt to dissent from this practice was undertaken by senior BJP leader, Shri L.K. Advani, in the 1980s and the 1990s. He strongly argued against a theocratic State, equality for minorities but his larger point was that secularism can no longer become a euphemism for majority bashing. He argued his case in modern vocabulary. A large part of India started seeing a rationale in this. The majority community was liberal, tolerant but no longer apologetic about its own religious credentials. The Congress never understood the

power of this sleeping giant. Shah Bano legislation brought by Shri Rajiv Gandhi was a result of his inability to gauge the reaction. This mistake continued even

through the UPA Government where instead of treating the poor as a class, the then Prime Minister, Dr. Manmohan Singh, announced that the minorities have a first right on the national exchequer.

Meanwhile, the socio-economic profile of India changed in slowly consolidating and enlarging India's middle-class. The middle-class is aspirational. It has strong concern on national security. It is religiously inclined but not communal. At the same time, it will not accept majority bashing as the definition of secularism. The attitude of this class towards national security related issues such as terrorism and a special status of Jammu & Kashmir, is extremely strong. At the same time, its reaction on both Ayodhya and Sabarimala is self-evident. This has created fear of the backlash in the minds of those who conventionally indulged in majority bashing and were compromising on issues of national security. Let us analyse some of the recent episodes.

RAHUL GANDHI

Without getting into the larger issue of whether a person can inherit his grandmother's caste, the Congress has suddenly decided to proclaim its President as 'Janeudhari Brahmin'. He has now been

declared as 'Shiv Bhakt'. He does not miss an opportunity to visit temples and makes an event out of each such programmes. His religious orientation was not visible in either 2004, 2009 or 2014.

Is he willing to clarify his stand on the statements that Mehbooba Mufti and Omar Abdullah are regularly making literally supporting soft-separatism? He gets away by saying "I had some other views but I went by my Party's views on Sabarimala" but still not willing to spell out his stand on either Ram Temple in Ayodhya or Sabarimala.

On national security, his stand has been highly questionable. He wants the sedition laws to be withdrawn. He wants the AFSPA to be removed and the Army personnel in J&K to be diluted. He had the audacity to visit the Jawahar Lal Nehru University in support of those who raised the slogan "भारत तेरे टुकड़े होंगे, ईशाअल्लाह ईशाअल्लाह" and "अफजल हम शर्मिदा हैं, तेरे कतिल जिंदा हैं".

Union HRD Minister Shri Prakash Javadekar is also election In-charge of Rajasthan for Lok Sabha elections 2019 and he has been camping in the state overseeing the elections for last many months. As the polling completes in Rajasthan, Kamal Sandesh Associate Editor **Vikash Anand** discussed with him at length about the campaign strategy and prospects of BJP in the state. Here are the excerpts:



You were election in-charge of Rajasthan BJP in the recently held assembly elections and at present you are also in-charge of the party in the on-going Lok Sabha elections in the state. What difference you see in both these elections?

I have always experienced that people take every election differently. In the recently held legislative elections in Rajasthan BJP's loss was not big, we were away from victory by just half percent of vote share and on every booth, BJP got only three votes less than Congress. However, truth is that Congress came in power. Here, BJP government had done good work. But due to lack of communication with people about it's works, we lost the assembly elections.

is the symbol of nation's security, progress and strong leadership. Earlier, in Assembly elections it was thought that the BJP would get 30-40 seats but, BJP did well.

In Lok Sabha elections we got Hanuman Beniwal, Gurjar leader Kirori Singh Bainsla and many others join our side and have increased our strength by uniting

the social forces. Had it been done in assembly elections, the results would have been certainly different.

participation. What is the reason behind this?

Popularity of the Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi is so high that if you talk to ten people, eight want to vote for Modiji. In 2014 people have given the mandate to Shri

Narendra Modi with a hope, now they are voting with confidence.

In these five years, people saw that our Prime Minister did 24 X 7 hard work. The PM has no self interest; his every move has been dedicated to the country. While interacting, once one tribal brother told me, "Earlier, when our soldiers used to fell in the hands of enemy country, his headless body used to arrive home. But this is the first Prime Minister under whom when our soldiers who landed in enemy country had to be freed within 24 hours". What was the election campaign strategy of the party in the state this time?

BJP National General Secretary Shri Muralidhar Rao is also party in-charge of Karnataka and Tamil Nadu for Lok Sabha elections 2019. He has extensively campaigned in these states for party candidates for last several months and tried his best to ensure the victory of BJP led NDA. As the polling has completed in Karnataka and Tamil Nadu, Kamal Sandesh Associate Editor **Sanjeev Sinha** broadly discussed with Shri Muralidhar Rao about the grand campaign strategy of BJP and performance of BJP led NDA this time in these states. Shri Muralidhar Rao revealed how BJP will script another landmark in Karnataka and will get more seats in Tamilnadu this time. Excerpts:



Lok Sabha elections have already completed in Karnataka and Tamil Nadu where you are party in-charge. How did the party campaign in these states, and what were the major issues?

In Karnataka BJP is always seen as a strong force but in the last assembly elections we couldn't come to power because we fall short of few seats. However, BJP emerged as a Number one political party with 104 seats.

Following last assembly election results, both the Congress and JD(S) realized their strength and came together to form an alliance government for their existence. Congress was so scared, that it has positioned itself as a subordinating force in the alliance government and JD(S) with only 38 seats has taken the

chief ministership and playing a lead role in the government. This alliance has practically demonstrated the compulsions, vulnerabilities, weaknesses of such a coalition and shows how blackmail and internal quarrel has become the order of the day. Karnataka people are well aware of this situation and it has given a kind of advantage to BJP, that is why BJP government or Modi government is needed.

This one narrative along with the national narratives that national security, development, good governance, transparent governance and corruption free governance, welfare of the poor etc. has helped a lot to BJP.

In Karnataka the election campaign of BJP practically has gone on the way we thought of. It was of Modiji Vs the rest. So the

campaign was centered around Modiji and his performances.

Therefore, this time according to the feedbacks from various quarters I hope, we will be adding few more seats to BJP's tally in Karnataka and will script another landmark in the state. Surely, the party is going to outperform what we have done in 2014.

What kind of support BJP is getting in Tamil Nadu?

Tamil Nadu is a very big state with 39+1 (Pondicherry), 40 seats. In 2014 elections, the undercurrent in favour of Modiji helped us a lot but that time we were having a different rainbow coalition with small parties. We got significant vote share of 19.5 percent but seat conversion was not proportionate to it. So we were able to get only two Seats.

Now, in this election against DMK and Congress combination, we have been able to create a good viable and vibrant alliance along with AIDMK, PMK, DMDK and other few parties. Because of this alliance in Tamil Nadu the fight has become very intensive and in my view with the leadership of Modi ji and his Campaign, we have been able to create a chemistry which we wanted to create among the alliance partners and people. Therefore, definitely we are thinking for scripting a successful NDA story there. NDA under the leadership of Modi ji will get good numbers in Tamil Nadu this time.

What type of challenge the BJP and NDA is getting from the Mahagatbandhan of opposition parties?

There is no Mahagatbandhan all over the country. There is no opposition unity all over the country. They wanted to see the fight between BJP Vs the rest. You know rest is represented by one candidate against BJP and the opposition strategy was not to allow the division of anti-BJP votes. However, in many important states they have not been able to do this. If you take the example of Uttar Pradesh there is no united fight, in Bengal there is no united fight, in Odisha there is no united fight, in Kerala there is no united fight and in Andhra Pradesh there is nothing like that.

So, Mahagatbandhan is only now a slogan and it is a kind of utopia and in ground there is no such grand coalition and this grand coalition has not become possible because they are not agreeing on one leader, they are not agreeing on who will rule and what will be the

five constituencies having grand dreams of becoming the Prime Minister. So that was the reason, grand coalition could not get established.

People also knew it. They need a stable government, decisive government and government which can take decisions, what only Modi ji can deliver.

What will be the performance of BJP led NDA at the national level?

The narrative the general public have created about the Modi government at the centre is that, the nation is safe in the hands of Modi ji, this nation has got stable government under Modi ji, the leadership of Modi ji is decisive, it is able to negotiate with global agencies, multilateral agencies and all important countries because of strong and uncompromising leadership and the interests of our country can only be protected under the Modi government. So, people are also discussing these issues and supporting the BJP led NDA on this basis.

They are realising the importance of issues like national security, national development, welfare of the poor, good governance and corruption free governance etc. So, I think for these positive developments BJP led NDA will get more seats than what we obtained in 2014. ■

everywhere in the country, National Security is a foremost issue of this election. Apart from it good governance, corruption free government, developments, keeping the country safe from the clutches of the anti-India mindset

parties etc. are some of the other major issues of this election.

Do you think the Mahagatbandhan can play any role in this election?

Now Mahagatbandhan has become a no entry zone for many parties. In UP and Bengal Congress is out of the gathbandhan, in Bihar, SP and BSP are out of the gathbandhan, in Delhi and other states AAP is out of the gathbandhan.

In fact, the Congress-led opposition is not the Mahagathbandhan but it is 'Mahamilavati Gathbandhan'.

Thus, from the very beginning the people of this country has dismissed the anti-India agenda of the Mahagatbandhan parties and giving massive support in all the states to BJP.

How BJP will perform in this election?

See, this time we are fighting the elections in Bihar in alliance with JD(U) and LJP. I have extensively toured the state, interacting with the public and campaigning for the party. I can assure you, this time the BJP alliance will break the record of 2014, get more seats in Bihar and establish a new landmark. However, I can foresee, even all through the country BJP will perform exceptionally well and will surpass its pervious figures of 2014 general election. ■

BJP IS GOING TO WIN EVEN MORE SEATS THAN IN 2014 ELECTIONS: ARUN SINGH

BJP National General Secretary Shri Arun Singh is looking after the PM's programmes and In-charge of BJP National Headquarters and states like Odisha. He is deeply engaged in party campaign for Lok Sabha elections 2019. Kamal Sandesh Executive Editor **Dr. Shiv Shakti Bakshi** discussed with him various election related issues and his perception of the ground reality. Here are the excerpts:



You have been touring many states in the course of the Lok Sabha election campaign. What kind of atmosphere you see prevailing on the ground and why?

See, whatever I have seen at ground level, it can be said to be a "Modi wave". It is "Modi wave" everywhere. Everyone wants to make Shri Narendra Modi Prime Minister of the country in 2019 also. People are full of enthusiasm and they are filled with confidence also that Modi ji will become PM again. You will ask about the reasons. The main reason is that people consider the work done for poor, farmer, youth, women, SCs and STs by Shri Modi ji in last five years as unprecedented. Along with this he has enhanced the respect of India across the world. He has made the identity of India as a powerful nation. The 130 crore people of this country are filled with a sense of pride.

Secondly, on the organisational front also BJP has a membership of more than 11 crore and in the last

four years booth committees were continuously constituted, booth centric works and meetings at booth level have taken place. Full timers are working for last three years. The organizational work which has been done in last four years under the leadership of our party president Shri Amit Shah is unprecedented. The national president has toured every state at least three times and even spared time for night stays and also conducted meetings.

Third reason is that the character of this 'gathbandhan' has been exposed. It is a 'gathbandhan' of self interest. It is a 'mahamilavati' alliance. It is made to stop one person. These kinds of alliances never succeed.

We are contesting the elections on the agenda of development. The massive transformational work done by Modi ji in last five years and the vision under which these works will continue till 2022 to celebrate 75th anniversary of our independence is getting huge people's support. With the vision of 'New India' which

he has given, we are treading on the path to realise that vision. The leaders of the 'gathbandhan' who are fighting among themselves have only exposed their contradictions. Therefore we are not bothered about them. We are not concerned about the alliance. We as karyakartas are engaged in our works.

How do you see the last five years economic performance of the Modi government?

See, there are two things – if you compare the economic situation from what we had in 2014, then we can say inflation is under control. Similarly Current account Deficit is also under control. And thirdly, sensx is also high and interest rates have also come down. In this election price rise is not an issue. Along with this India's ranking in Ease of Doing Business has improved significantly and Transparency International and IMF are acknowledging our efforts and applauding Modi ji. Many international agencies are also upgrading our rankings. We have

become sixth largest economy in the world and on the way to become fifth very soon. It is a very huge achievement.

Modi government has taken many innovative steps. What are the results?

Through Make in India, Digital India, Start Up and Stand Up programmes entrepreneurs and youth are getting encouragement and business is increasing. For instance earlier there were only two companies in the field of mobile manufacturing but now this number has increased to 120! In the leadership of Modi ji speedy administrative reforms have taken place. Through Digital India, corruption too has been reined in. The beneficiaries are now getting money directly into their accounts through DBT. Millions of funds have been saved till date. Digital India has also become instrumental in giving instant reliefs in many cases and problems are getting solved. Even accountabilities are getting fixed.

Almost all political analysts believe that the states where BJP was not so strong earlier, this time BJP is getting massive support in them. How do you see this phenomenon?

Actually PM Modi has been saying from the beginning that he wants to see the states in the east not only doing as well as those in the west but doing even better than them. Due to various programmes and projects of PM for the eastern states people feel that Shri Narendra Modi wants to do a lot for them. For Odisha also PM has plans in his mind therefore BJP's performance in Odisha is also improving. The 19 year rule that was in Odisha, under this rule the basic facilities like electricity, water,

education, irrigation, employment have broken down and people feel that Naveen Patnaik is now not capable of developing the state. Therefore people have made up their mind in favour of BJP. In state and at center, they want to see BJP government. In this context the organisational work has also expanded. Earlier there were only 450 mandals in the entire state, the number of these mandals have now been increased to 1000. Smaller mandals were constituted and along with these districts units were also formed. Booth committees were formed. Agitations were organised upto mandal level. As a result in the local body elections BJP was able to win 10 times more than 36 seats which it held earlier.

The Odisha BJP organisation has become much stronger. The organization has reached upto booth level. In the last four years BJP national president visited Odisha several times. He himself under the programme 'Mera booth, sabse majboot' pasted posters on the walls of houses in the state. I have seen for the first time that a national president has himself pasted the posters. To extend the ideology and work of party in the state efforts were made upto the booths.

The central government's work has been carried out in West Bengal but some of the work has been stopped. Mamta Didi is hesitant in implementing centre's scheme in the state. At the organizational level, expansion work is going on continuously. Entire West Bengal is feeling oppressed by Mamta Didi. The kind of violence which Mamta Banerjee is unleashing on our activists is making the commitment of

our karyakartas firmer and people's support has been increasing. Today support for us has increased manifold. It is the history of our country that people never tolerate violence. People go with non-violence. Perhaps Mamta Banerjee is not aware of it, therefore when the results will come out on 23rd, it will be one-sided in the favour of BJP. In other states also whether in Kerala or in Tamil Nadu, BJP will make good entry and in Northeast BJP is set to get very good results.

You have been looking after the programmes of the Prime Minister and have been In-charge of the party Headquarters for last four years. How do you manage your work and what kind of response you see in PM's programmes?

There is no problem in managing the works. Everything can be done if one is well organised and knows to manage time well. Along with all other works I spend one-two days in the party Headquarters after 5-6 days of pravas and complete all the pending works.

So far PM's programme is concerned, I can say that even while personality of Shri Narendra Modi ji being so huge, he never raises any question on the programmes assigned for him by the party. All programmes are proving to be very successful.

People are coming in unprecedented numbers in the PM's programmes. The kind of people's support and response that we are witnessing in his programmes and the kind of enthusiasm these programmes are generating, I can see that BJP is going to win even more seats than in 2014 elections. ■

'EASE OF LIVING' FOR CITIZENS: A BIG ACHIEVEMENT OF MODI GOVERNMENT

Under the leadership of Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, the government has not only focused on improving the Ease of Doing Business where India witnessed a massive improvement in the past five years as its ranking improved 65 places from 142nd in 2014 to 77th in 2018. Emphasis has also been placed upon improving 'Ease of Living' for citizens across different sectors. This has been brought about by lesser government interference and simplification of cumbersome processes. The government took up certain governance reforms with innovative approaches to chronic problems while eliminating corruption and ensuring ease of living, such as :

- Interviews were abolished for all group C and D, non-gazetted group B posts leading to a shutdown of the entire system of 'recommendations', thereby reducing the menace of corruption in jobs.
- Self-attestation of documents was allowed reducing the hardship faced by citizens.
- Red beacons on VIP cars were removed ending the long-established VIP culture.
- There was a simplification of the Driving License Application Procedure and the procedure for obtaining passports was streamlined by removing unnecessary delays.
- Before 2014, there were 77 Passport SewaKendras. This number has now increased to more than 400.
- People are no longer required to repeatedly visit other cities for getting their passports.
- The PAHAL scheme for direct benefit transfers for LPG was effectively implemented. This meant the LPG subsidy arrived in bank accounts of beneficiaries directly, with no middlemen involved.
- Authenticity of online documents was ensured through the Digital Locker System for sharing e-documents through registered repositories.
- The National Scholarships Portal was set up as a one stop solution for an end to end scholarship process. Not only this, scholarship grants were transferred to students via direct benefit transfer.
- 100 accessible websites of various State

Governments/ UTs under Accessible India Campaign were launched easing their access to Divyangs.

- Long hectic queues at toll plazas are now becoming things of the past. The introduction of Electronic Toll Collection (ETC) ensures seamless movement of traffic and collection of fee as per notified rates. With a total number of 440 Toll Plazas, more than 34.3 lakh FASTags units have been issued.
- There will be further easing of transportation of goods with plans to link e-way bills with FASTags.

EASE OF LIVING FOR THE POOREST SECTIONS OF SOCIETY

- As per an estimate, healthcare costs land more than 5 crore India into poverty, with 3.8 crore fell below the poverty line due to spending on medicines alone. In this context, many steps taken show how Modi government has brought ease of living for the people:
- The launch of Ayushman Bharat is reducing expenditure of poor people, as healthcare is now affordable for all. More than 15 lakh beneficiaries have been admitted to hospitals and treated for free. Some treatments availed include Cardio-thoracic & vascular surgery, urology and neurosurgery.
- Nearly 5,000 PM BharatiyaJanaushadhiKendras are providing affordable medicines and are functional across the country. These provide medicines at vastly lesser than the market price of medicines.
- In the past five years the price of stents and knee implants have reduced greatly owing to proactive measures by the NDA government to cap their prices.

EASE OF LIVING FOR THOSE ARRIVING IN INDIA

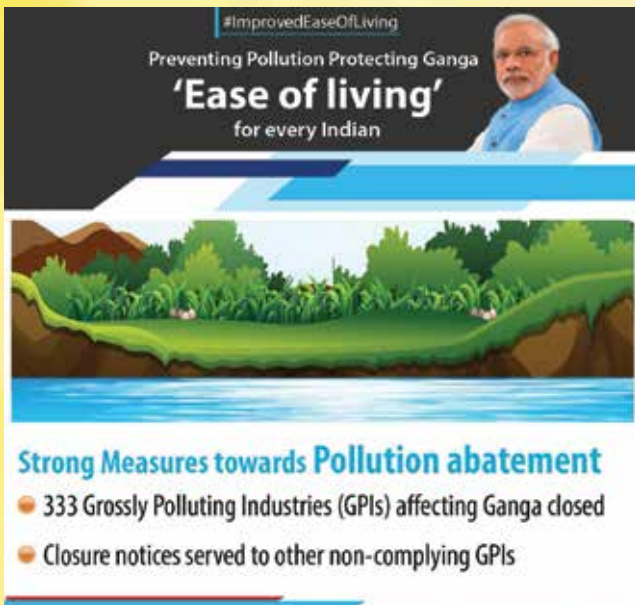
- An Online Event Clearance System has been introduced to grant security clearances to conferences, seminars or workshops organized in India. This has eased the issue of Conference Visas for foreign nationals and delegates intending to attend such events.
- The 'e-Visa' facility covers approximately all the countries of the world.
- The foreigner arriving does not have to interact with any Indian official till his arrival at the immigration counter, making it easier to reach India. With the implementation of this facility the number of foreigners who visited India on e-visa have gone up from 5.17 lakh in 2015 to 21 lakh in 2018.



- All these reforms illustrate the government's effort towards making a New India as per 21st century expectations, aspirations and hopes to bring about a qualitative improvement in lives of people.

EASE OF LIVING FOR MILLIONS OF INDIANS

- Eating out is more inexpensive under the GST regime. Taxes that used to range anywhere between 15-20% earlier are a thing of history. Today, there is only a 5% GST on eating out.
- With elimination of checkpoints, trucks carrying goods are travelling faster, reducing logistics costs and delays. Small traders benefitted with the end of multiplicity of taxes while registration filing, assessment, refund are online under GST replacing inspector raj with a transparent system. Consequently, due to the GST reforms by Modi government, overall reduction of prices has ultimately benefited the end consumer.
- The big move to ensure that people with net taxable income up to Rs. 5 lakh incur no tax liability, has benefited crores of taxpayers. Nowadays, getting an income tax refund is no longer a matter of years but of just a few days. Furthering the effort to Ease of Living, Modi government, as announced in interim budget, is working on giving refund in 24 hours. Easing the lives of taxpayers, 99.54 per cent of income-tax returns were accepted as they were filed in the current year.
- Pension provides security in second innings of the



life. The time taken for processing pension papers reduced with the simplification of pension claim procedure by Modi government. Jeevan Pramaan Aadhaar-linked Digital Life Certificates have provided Ease of Living to pensioners by doing away with requirement to be physically present before the certification authority. About 2.5 crore pensioners have availed this facility since 2014.

- Efforts like Atal Pension Yojana, PM Vaya Vandana Yojana are steps taken for benefits to old age people with minimum investment, maximum benefits for Ease of Living.
- Unlike earlier times, obtaining a passport is no more a hassle. There has been rapid increase in the number of Passport Service Kendras from 77 in 2014 to 490, which has made delivery of passport services easy and convenient.
- Apart from these, with Digital India initiative and push for digital transactions, seamless transactions have eased the process of payment of utility bills and many different kinds of payments. For the first time, as on January 2019, the volume of UPI transactions crossed 672.75 million with an amount of more than Rs. 1.09 lakh crores transacted.
- When a government caps cardiac stent prices and knee implants, slashing prices by 50-70%, it means more people can afford stents to tend to their ailing hearts and knees.
- If generic medicines are available, sometimes at far

lesser price than the market price across around 5,000 Jan Aushadhi stores, then the medicinal expenses of people vastly come down.

- Home loans became much more inexpensive than before. For example, in November 2013, the SBI home loan interest rate was around 10.30%, which, in 2019 stands at around 8.5%. If you consider a home loan of Rs. 20 lakhs over 20 years, savings due to lower interest rates would be about Rs. 26,000 per year & about Rs. 5 lakhs over full tenure.
 - Similarly, even education loans have become more affordable.
 - Many people put their life's savings into buying an apartment. Sometimes they ended up feeling cheated by builders. Some builders would delay delivery or even change plans without consent. Real Estate Regulation Act – RERA, was passed to empower homebuyers and reform the real estate sector.
 - Now, builders are required to create a separate escrow account in which significant part of the amount received from the buyers will have to be deposited, thus ensuring that the money is not diverted elsewhere. The withdrawals will depend on the extent of work completion and will only be allowed to cover the cost of construction and the cost of land.
- With aspirations of homes, education, health and an easier daily life being fulfilled, Ease of Living is becoming a reality in the lives of crores of Indians after the advent of the Modi government. ■



PAVING THE WAY FOR RURAL PROSPERITY

Rural infrastructure is cornerstone of overall development of the nation. Under the Modi government, the sector has received massive impetus so as to bridge the gap between rural and urban life.

RURAL ROAD CONSTRUCTION ON PRIORITY

Rural roads are an inextricable part of rural infrastructure, which provide connectivity to the diverse set of markets and services that aid the rural economy to grow.

Speed of rural road construction has doubled from 69 km per day in 2013-14 to 134 km per day in 2017-18. Rural road connectivity is more than 91% as of October 2018, as against 55% in March 2014, ensuring that villages do not fall behind in the development trajectory of a New India.

A massive 1.95 lakh km of road length were completed under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana since 2013-14. A significant number of unconnected habitations have already been provided connectivity. 100% connectivity is targeted by March 2019. This greatly aids goods and services reach villages, farmers reach markets and youth avail educational and employment opportunities. The targeted construction of thousands of kilometres of roads in areas affected by Left Wing Extremism is also helping development reach those areas.

SETTING RECORDS IN RURAL ELECTRIFICATION

Electricity opens up a whole new world of opportunities from children being able to study at night to farming and allied activities becoming tech-intensive. Prime Minister Narendra Modi had declared in his 2015 Independence Day speech that the government would electrify every single village in 1,000 days. This target was achieved

even before the deadline. The Modi government electrified more than 18,000 villages, many of them in extremely remote areas or across hills. When the last un-electrified village in India, Leisang, in Manipur, was electrified, the whole nation applauded in a wave of jubilation. Development truly became a mass movement, as PM Modi often exhorts the nation.

Now, electrification has moved onto powering every home and 2.5 crore households have already been powered through the SAUBHAGYA Yojana, as of February 2019. One must remember that many of these households belong to the poor and underprivileged, often residing in rural or urban clusters.

Modi government's initiative to bring light to every village in the country was recognised and praised by (IEA) International Energy Agency as well. The agency called it one of the greatest success stories in the world last year in its World Energy Outlook 2018 report.

IMPROVING CONNECTIVITY IN RURAL AREAS

Modi government is committed to equip Indian villages with modern technology. As a result, progress of Bharat Net project has been going on at a rapid speed and scale.

As of May 31, 2014, basic communication infrastructure was abysmal and only 59 Gram Panchayats were made service ready, with only 358 km optical fibre cables laid.

In contrast, as of Feb-2019, 3.13 lakh km of OFC had been laid, covering 1.24 lakh Gram Panchayats out of which 1.17 lakh GPs are connected to high-speed broadband and are service ready.

Modi government is developing rural infrastructure in its entirety, with a target leaving no village undeveloped, thus paving the way for a new India which is progressive and equipped with modern infrastructure. ■

COOCH BEHAR, WEST BENGAL

IT'S TIME TO END DIDI'S RULE IN BENGAL: MODI

P rime Minister Shri Narendra Modi said that West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee was fast losing ground in the State. At an election rally in Cooch Behar, West Bengal on 05 May, 2019 Shri Modi charged CM Ms. Banerjee with denting the image of the State and not allowing Central funds to come into the State. "The speed-breaker Didi of Bengal is unable to sleep; she is venting all her anger on her officials and the Election Commission. If someone wants to understand what shifting of political grounds feels like

they can understand from her anger and frustration," he said.

Shri Narendra Modi criticized the Trinamool Congress of being involved in the Saradha and Rose Valley chit fund scams, not utilizing the Centre's funds and not checking human trafficking and illegal infiltration in the State.

PRATAPGARH AND BASTI, UTTAR PRADESH

‘DUE TO THE CONTINUOUS EFFORTS MASOOD AZHAR DECLARED A GLOBAL TERRORIST’

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi addressed two major rallies in Pratapgarh and Basti in Uttar Pradesh on May 04, 2019. Addressing his supporters, PM Shri Modi said, “Due to the continuous efforts of our government, Pak-based terrorist Masood Azhar was declared a global terrorist by the UN. Now Pakistan must deal with him or should wait for Diwali in India because India will no longer tolerate terrorism against itself in any form.”

Highlights of the speech

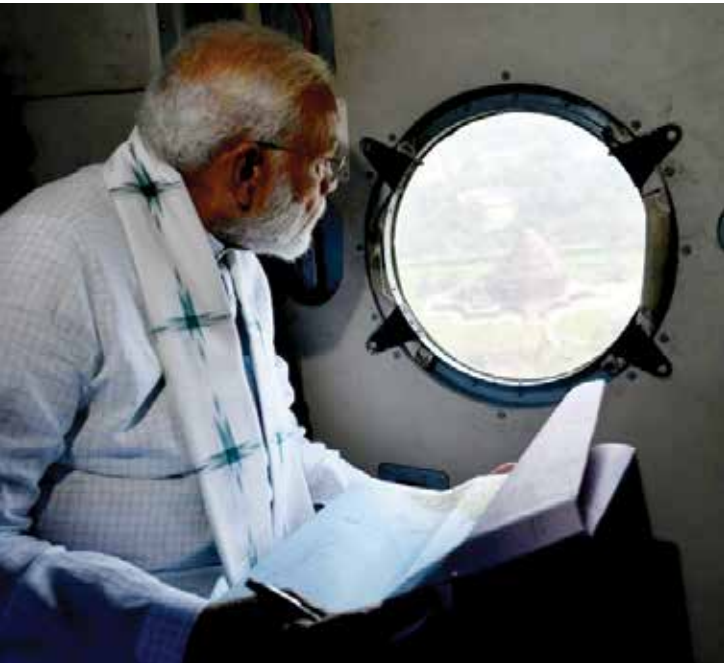
- The recent terror attacks in Sri Lanka reiterated that terrorism remains a great threat to the whole world and needs a strong approach to eliminate it.

Cyclone 'Fani' barreled through the coastal Odisha near Puri on 03 May, 2019, causing widespread destruction in the coastal areas from Ganjam to Balasore and leaving lakhs grappling with water shortage and power cuts. ■






