Under the leadership of Mahila Morcha President smt. Vannathi Srinivasan Mahila morcha has taken up this unique initiative which is called "KamalMitra" means the trained karykarta of Mahila morcha on 15 women centric scheme implemented by our honourable Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi ji.

The content on 15 schemes such as Ujjwala Yojana, Sukanya Samriddhi Yojana, Pradhanmantri Awas Yojana, Matritva Vandana Yojana have been prepared in Hindi, English, Tamil, Telugu, Malayalam, Kannada, Bengali, Assamese, Gujarati and Marathi languages.
