Salient points of the speech of BJP President Shri Amit Shah on the occasion of inaugurating Gopinath-Gadh in Beed, Maharashtra

BJP President Shri Amit Shah on Saturday inaugurated Gopinath-Gadh commemorating the birth anniversary of Late Shri Gopinath Munde and addressed a public gathering on this occasion in Beed District, Maharashtra. Addressing the birth

anniversary programme, he said that I came here to pay my tribute to Shri Gopinath Munde on the behalf of crores of BJP workers.

Addressing the gathering, Shri Shah said, "The glory days of BJP and its government in Maharashtra today are due to the foundation of organizational structure of the Party laid by Shri Gopinath Ji in his short span of life and the way he worked to ensure the party's spread among the poor and downtrodden." He said that the achievement, Shri Gopinathji got as Deputy Chief Minister and Home Minister of Maharashtra is incomparable. Shri Shah said that as Home Minister of Maharashtra, he washed out the infamies of notoriety of the state of being criminal elements dominating states. He said, when BJP came into power in the Centre in the leadership of Shri Narendra Modi Ji, Shri Gopinath Mundeji was assigned the rural development portfolio to uplift the life of the poor, the labourers, Dalits, the farmers and backwards due to his efficiency to serve them.

BJP President said, every worker of the Party is committed to fulfil the dreams and ideas of Shri Gopinath Mundeji by realizing his principles and moving on the path shown by him. Shri Shah said that the government is not for luxury but for the welfare of backward, downtrodden and poor; and I am confident of that Maharashtra will soon regain the numero uno spot in the country under the leadership of Shri Devendra Fadnavis.

Shri Shah said that the present BJP-led Maharashtra government is so clean that the Opposition hasn't been able to level allegation of a single rupee worth of corruption. He said, the previous Congress-NCP government spend more than 75 thousand crores of rupees on irrigation but even single inch of land could not get irrigated in the state while the current Devendra Fadnavis government has established a new dimension by ensuring irrigation to reach out to 6200 villages with a paltry amount of 7500 crore rupees.

Shri Shah highlighted the pro-farmers initiatives taken and the amount of welfare work done by the Narendra Modi Government in centre and the the Devendra Fadnavis Government in Maharashtra. Shri Shah said, as Shri Narendra Modi became Prime Minister, he reduced the crop damage compensation criteria from 50% to 33% for farmers and also increased 50% in the amount of the compensation. Shri Shah mentioned that Shri Narendra Modi-led central government has decided to offer Soil Health Card to every farmer by 2019 to ensure proper development of agriculture so that farmers could perform their farming activity easily. Shri Shah said, "the central government is running many public welfare schemes like Mudra Bank Yojna, Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojna, Jeevan Suraksha Bima Yojna, Jan-Dhan Yojna etc to empower poor and backwards which have begun to produce the desired results now.

BJP President Shri Amit Shah said that I pay again my courteous tribute to Shri Gopinath Ji and reassure people that our government will continue to work for the sustained welfare for oppressed, the poor, backwards, Dalits and farmers.
