





Here, Pinky Kumari is seen carrying an immunization card which serves as a critical record of the vaccinations received by her child.





Prashuram Naik of Mahboob Nagar who was a labour is now a Supervisor. **Renu Chhevra** of Ambikapur is driving Tempo after training.






Moreover, someone told me about **Mamta Sharma** of Bhopal that she got Rs. 40 thousand under MUDRA scheme.

- In Chhindwara, Bank Mitra Durgesh Soni got 1300 accounts opened in far flung villages






